- 1. The shortest wait time for a liver transplant is one week or 15 days.
- 2. Some liver organs turn out to be unqualified or have to be scrapped when they are delivered here.
- 3. The cost for a liver transplant is over 400,000 yuan.
- 4. Now there is an OPO platform. All liver sources are centrally managed by the government. They are almost all donated.
- 5. Usually all members of the division do the surgery together when a liver source is available.

Translation

Doctor: Hi. Hello!

Investigator: Is this the First Affiliated Hospital of Anhui Medical University?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: Do you do...?

Doctor: Yeah, yeah, yeah.

Investigator: Do you do liver transplants?

Doctor: Yeah, yeah, we do.

Investigator: Oh, you do? Then how long will a patient wait after he is admitted into your hospital?

Doctor: Oh, if you want to have a liver transplant...for a liver transplant, you must come and register first. Then, if there's a liver source, if it's available, you'll be notified to come. Moreover, we need to have a talk with you first.

Investigator: Need to talk?

Doctor: It's not...it's not that there is a liver source available upon your arrival. It's not the case because we have to wait for it too.

Investigator: Can you do several hundred cases per year?

Doctor: No, we can't do a few hundred, but dozens of cases per year.

Investigator: Oh, dozens of cases? Generally speaking, what's the shortest wait time?

Doctor: The shortest is one week to 15 days.

Investigator: Oh, oh, is that so? What about the fees? Could you give me an idea?

Doctor: Because, because we can certainly do it. Because the main problem is that we have to wait for the liver sources. Some of them turn out to be unqualified or have to be scrapped when they are delivered here.

Investigator: Oh, oh, I see.

Doctor: Waiting for the liver source is the key.

Investigator: Well, where do you acquire your donor sources?

Doctor: What?

Investigator: Now, how much is the fee for one, the cost for one liver transplant?

Doctor: Usually about over 400,000 yuan.

Investigator: As you just said, some of the liver sources aren't good enough. So I'm wondering whether you still have those, like those you used in the past, those from the prisoners, those from Falun Gong practitioners. Can we still use those?

Doctor: What liver sources of Falun Gong practitioners?

Investigator: That's previously...in the past what they used in the hospitals! Now...

Doctor: What were used in the past, prisoners' livers?

Investigator: Right. But now are there any of those available? Now are there...?

Doctor: No, but now...now there is a platform!

Investigator: Oh, now...

Doctor: Now there is an OPO platform. All liver sources are centrally managed by the government. They are almost all donated.

Investigator: Well, okay, I see. Well, which director does the surgeries? Are they done by the directors?

Doctor: Usually all members of the division do the surgery together when a liver source is available.

Investigator: Oh.

Doctor: The two medical divisions are...

Investigator: Oh, oh, that's okay. Thank you.
