- 1. We've done quite a lot of kidney transplants; and did over 100 cases last year.
- 2. All organs are from voluntary donors in Henan province.
- 3. Investigator: Are the organs exercised on site or brought in from elsewhere? Doctor: Regarding that, ha-ha—there's no need to know that much.
- 4. The cost is about 300,000 yuan if everything goes well.
- 5. Our director has been doing it all along.
- Investigator: May I have the director's phone number so that I can contact him directly?
 Doctor: He happens on a business trip; I can give it to you another time.

Translation

Doctor: Hello?

Investigator: Hi, how are you? Is this PLA No.153 Hospital?

Doctor: Hello, how can I help you?

Investigator: Hi, I am from Hengshui. May I ask if kidney transplant surgeries can be done at PLA No.153 Hospital?

Doctor: Hello? Please continue.

Investigator: Oh, I'd like to ask if this hospital can perform kidney transplants currently?

Doctor: Yes, we can.

Investigator: You still can? I'm from Hengshui. May I ask how long we need to wait for the surgery after the matching test is done?

Doctor: Well, I'm not sure about that.

Investigator: Not sure? So do you do a lot of surgeries—like those kidney transplants?

Doctor: We do a lot.

Investigator: You do a lot! Your hospital...I'm a doctor from Hengshui Hospital, and I'd like to send a patient over. Well, usually kidney transplants can be done in many hospitals in Henan. Then compared to other hospitals, do you do more cases?

Doctor: Not really, maybe fewer.

Investigator: Fewer? Ha, ha, how many cases, like kidney transplants, can you do each year then?

Doctor: Ah, we did about over 100 cases last year, quite a lot.

Investigator: How about this year? How many cases have you done this year?

Doctor: Ah, ah.

Investigator: Have you already started doing it this year?

Doctor: Ah, we have been doing it all this time.

Investigator: All this time?

Doctor: Oh, oh.

Investigator: Do you do it almost every day?

Doctor: Ah, it's impossible for us to do it every day, but once every several days, once every a few days.

Investigator: For that type of organ sources at your hospital, where are they from?

Doctor: They're all from voluntary donors.

Investigator: Voluntary donors? From local places?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: Locally?

Doctor: They should be from places within our Henan province, correct, yes, that is right.

Investigator: Oh, so are those organs excised on site in your hospital? Or are they brought in from other places?

Doctor: Regarding that, I would say, ha, ha-there's no need to know that much.

Investigator: I'd like to know an approximate cost?

Doctor: In general, in a normal case, with quick recovery and no rejection, it should be around 300,000 yuan if everything goes well.

Investigator: Are there a lot of patients on the waiting list? Are there many in the queue after registrations?

Doctor: There are a lot of patients on the waiting list, because they think this is a better place. The one who matches well gets the organ—it works this way.

Investigator: I see. While waiting, some may get the surgeries done soon if matched organs can be quickly found; some may need to wait a little longer for their organ sources, right?

Doctor: That all depends on the patient's chance, and sometimes his luck. The surgery can be done quickly if a well matched organ becomes available and the patient has no other symptoms.

Investigator: Which director performs the surgeries currently?

Doctor: Our director has been doing it all the time.

Investigator: All this time, ah-ah, good, good.

Doctor: Oh.

Investigator: Would you please give me his contact information? So, I can contact him for further questions?

Doctor: Right now, the director happens to be on a business trip, maybe another time, okay? I'll tell him you called.

Investigator: Can I ask you, since you are a doctor there as well?

Doctor: Oh, we are young doctors.

Investigator: Young doctors?

Doctor: You can come to visit us if you need to. Let me talk to the director first, okay?

Investigator: Sure, thank you very much, talk to you later!
