Nurse: Hi, hello! This is the Transplant Center...

Investigator: Hi, hello! Is this the Liver Transplant Center of Xijing Hospital?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Ah, hello! How are you? I'd like to know if Director Yang Chaoxu is still working here.

Nurse: Oh, who am I speaking with?

Investigator: I'm calling from Beijing. One of my relatives is sick, so a friend of mine recommended Director Yang who is very experienced and skillful. I'd like to see him. Is he still here?

Nurse: Yes. He still works here. We're to perform a transplant surgery tonight! But

now...the doctor is not here at this very moment. (She is asking other people in the room: Is Director Yang available?). He'll be back later. We'll perform a transplant surgery tonight.

Investigator: Oh, so you're going to do a liver transplant surgery tonight?

Nurse: Yes. It (the surgery) will be performed soon! I guess the director is not here yet, the patient has just arrived.

Investigator: Oh, has the patient just arrived? That is good! My relative is seeking a liver transplant as well! This is great! Do you perform many (liver transplants)?

Nurse: Yes! We are the liver transplant center.

Investigator: Ah, is there a shortage of beds at your hospital?

Nurse: That... that depends. The main thing is to find a matching liver organ. Compared to that, finding a vacant bed is secondary, right?

Investigator: My relative lives in Baoji.

Nurse: Does he have liver cancer or cirrhosis?

Investigator: He has cirrhosis.

Nurse: Ah, that's better to get the surgery done.

Investigator: Ah, he's only a little over 40, very young.

Nurse: Ah, the patient here today is only 15.

Investigator: Only 15 years old?

Nurse: Do you know our director?

Investigator: No, I don't, but I also work in the army.

Nurse: If your relative wants a liver transplant surgery, you can tell him to bring his medical records and come to the transplant center on the fifth floor of the First Division of Xijing Hospital.

Investigator: Oh, how long do we need to wait (for surgery)?

Nurse: That's hard to say. That's really hard to say! As you know, sometimes, here it comes, someone makes a donation. We may receive a phone call at midnight, saying a liver source becomes available, so we would immediately get up and perform the surgery.

Investigator: After half a month, or a month, you can hardly keep track of your number, right?

Nurse: Generally speaking, we have done many liver transplant surgeries!

Investigator: Ah.

Nurse: I suggest that you come to have a consultation at the hospital.
