Li Daobing: Hello!

Investigator: Hello, is this Li Daobing? Hi, can you hear me?

Li Daobing: Hello! How are you?

Investigator: Hello, Hi. I called Liang Guiyou the other day, the former dean from your college. He told me that he no longer worked at your hospital, and had already been relocated to Guiyang to become the president of the medical university there. But I'd like to talk to you...

Investigator: I'm from Zhejiang, but one of my employees at my company has got a health problem, which means he needs to have a kidney transplant. He said it would cost more to have that done in Zhejiang, and he'd like to return to Zunyi, your area, since he is from Zunyi as well. So he said...

Investigator: Ah (a little puzzled)?

Li Daobing: (Speaking English)

Investigator: Hello. Can you hear me?

Li Daobing: (Speaking English)

Investigator: Can you hear me?

Li Daobing: I am busy at the moment!

Investigator: Are you listening to me? I'll wait to consult with you until you're free and done talking with someone else, okay?

Li Daobing: (Still Speaking English)

Investigator: Okay, I'm going to wait for you until you become available.

Li Daobing: (Talking with someone else in English)

Investigator: Excuse me?

Li Daobing: (English)

Investigator: What's going on with you?

Li Daobing: (English)

Investigator: Are you listening to me?

Li Daobing: Ah, Now I can hear you, please go ahead.

Investigator: Okay, okay.

Li Daobing: You are asking about having a kidney transplant, aren't you?

Investigator: Are you still busy right now? If so, I can wait for you until you're available, okay?

Li Daobing: I'm available now. I have got several people(customers) from four different countries, including Netherlands and France, and I was talking with them moments ago when you called me.

Investigator: Wow, your English is so good. Well, I was just wondering, since that employee of mine wants to have a kidney transplant, what would be the price if it were done at your hospital? Would your price be lower than what he can get here in Zhejiang?

Li Daobing: Our price is very inexpensive. Our price is very cheap.

Investigator: How much approximately?

Li Daobing: About 50,000 to 60,000 yuan, in that range.

Investigator: 50,000 to 60,000 yuan? Are you sure?

Li Daobing: Ah, that's for a kidney transplant!

Investigator: Ah, kidney transplantation, yes, that's what I'm asking about.

Li Daobing: Okay, we're on the same page then.

Investigator: Well, Liang Guiyou, the former dean from your college, actually recommended that we go to Guiyang(for a kidney transplant). He told me that it would cost about 100,000 yuan there in Guiyang.

Li Daobing: Their hospital there in Guiyang is not as good as ours. Liang Guiyou now has been relocated to Guizhou Medical University and become their president there.

Investigator: Yes, you're right. He has moved there and become their president. I mean he himself is...

Li Daobing: But, their hospital is not as good as ours!

Investigator: Not as good as yours?

Li Daobing: Correct...

Investigator: Now you are...I've heard that your hospital--the Affiliated Hospital of Zunyi Medical University—is the one that basically has done relatively more, or quite a lot (organ transplants).

Li Daobing: Yes, that's true! Our hospital is absolutely better than that of Guizhou Medical University. By the way, how did you get my phone number?

Investigator: I got it from my classmate's classmate. In other words, I...

Li Daobing: I see. I thought that you were from Belgium, so I started talking in English. Sorry about that.

Investigator: No, I'm actually from Zhejiang!

Li Daobing: Because now I have a few friends in--(Interrupted and started talking with a female in English)--This foreign lady was (talking via WeChat). Sorry.

Investigator: Was she talking to you on WeChat?

Li Daobing: (She's) here in Zunyi, in our area!

Investigator: She's in Zunyi, your area. Is she one of your friends? You know, that employee of mine is from Zunyi. He doesn't have much money, and will have to borrow the money primarily from me because he works with my company.

Li Daobing: We don't charge much in Zunyi, so please rest assured, okay? (Interspersed with brief conversations with foreigner(s))

Investigator: Hey, how long would he need to wait (to have a kidney transplant)? The wait time?

Li Daobing: (in English) Hello there!

Investigator: How long will he have to wait (for a kidney transplant), if he goes to your hospital?

Li Daobing: No, he'll have to make an appointment first, as we don't have it now, and the kidney supply is very tight.

Investigator: Oh, your kidney supply is very tight?

Li Daobing: Very tight indeed. Now there's nothing much we could do, and he would have to wait at least half a year.

Investigator: Wow, he would have to wait that long. That would be way too long for him. So he, with blood type B...

Li Daobing: First of all, he'll have to come for his tissue typing. Let him come to get registered for an appointment first, you know?

Investigator: Alright then, I'll bring his medical records for your review first, so that you can decide whether his tissue typing is going to be quick and good. If it's going to be fast, I then...

Li Daobing: Can you send over his medical file to me via SMS(text message)?

Investigator: SMS, or MMS?

Li Daobing: Because I am now dealing with my guests(customers) from four countries...oaky?

Investigator: Oh, I see. I'll then try to catch you later at a better time during your business hours. Is that okay?

Li Daobing: Okay, that sounds good.

Investigator: Bye. We'll be in touch, thank you. Bye, bye.
