1. We have a shortage of beds now.

2. Doctor Lin Tao has been out for a meeting. The outpatient clinic opens all day on Thursdays.

3. An allogeneic kidney is more than 100,000 yuan.

4. We do hundreds of cases a year, and have been doing that for over a decade.

Translation

Nurse: Hello! How are you?

Investigator: Hello, how are you? Is this West China Hospital of Sichuan University?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Is this the outpatient clinic or the inpatient service?

Nurse: The inpatient service.

Investigator: Oh, I would like to inquire about Lin Tao. Is this director at work today?

Nurse: Oh, they are not working on the weekend today, as they've been out for a meeting.

Investigator: Oh, not working on weekends, is there any doctor on duty today?

Nurse: Any doctor on duty? Yes.

Investigator: Could you please ask the doctor to come over? I would like to consult about a kidney transplant.

Nurse: We don't consult here. No consultation at the inpatient service unit.

Investigator: Oh, I'll ask if we come, we can get admitted into your hospital? Will there be any vacant bed available then?

Nurse: You can't get admitted now! You need to go through all those procedures or tests, including the tissue typing first! And when the operation is confirmed, then you can come for admission.

Investigator: Oh, you have a shortage of beds now, right?

Nurse: Right! You have to come to the outpatient clinic first.

Investigator: Oh, anyway, you're nearly at full capacity, with no vacant beds available, right?

Nurse: No, no vacant beds now. I just want to tell you that you have to complete all the procedures at the outpatient clinic before you come over here for admission.

Investigator: Oh, When does Doctor Lin Tao come to work?

Nurse: I'm not sure about that.

Investigator: Oh, we actually come for him, as my classmate recommended him, saying that his technical skills are pretty good.

Nurse: Ah, yes. Anyways they work at the outpatient clinic on Thursdays. Every Thursday they come to the clinic.

Investigator: Oh, in the morning or afternoon?

Nurse: The entire day.

Investigator: Oh, all day, Ah?

Nurse: Ah, right.

Investigator: Oh, I see. We need to come over to get the tissue typing done first before what can be decided next?

Nurse: Is it from your relative, or another kidney source?

Investigator: He is an employee of my company. He is from Sichuan, and wants to go back to your place. He said it's cheaper in your place, and more expensive in Zhejiang.

Nurse: yes, our rate is cheaper.

Investigator: How much does a kidney cost in your place?

Nurse: Is the kidney from a relative, or from a different source?

Investigator: Not from any of our relatives.

Nurse: Do you have any kidney source?

Investigator: He has no kidney source.

Nurse: Then, he needs to wait. We don't know when it can be done.

Investigator: Oh, How much for that?

Nurse: Over 100,000 yuan.

Investigator: Over 100,000 yuan! Oh, that's cheaper at your place than in our province Zhejiang.

Investigator: Oh, as my classmate said, the wait time could be just half a month, or two weeks a few years ago.

Nurse: It depends. If the timing is right, there's one that shows up and is suitable for him. It depends on the circumstances.

Investigator: Oh, well, you should be very experienced with fairly mature skills, as you have done it for many years. So about how many cases can you do each year?

Nurse: Hundreds.

Investigator: Ah! How many years have you been doing it, at your hospital?

Nurse: More than ten years.

Investigator: Oh, that's pretty good, and your technical skills are definitely not a problem.

Nurse: Oh, well, if you want to consult, go to the clinic, because this is a work phone and I can't talk for too long.

Investigator: Oh, okay, got it. Thank you!
