- 1. This is Doctor Wang. We are in Laoshan Division. The outpatient clinic opens on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
- 2. We have many patients, and do more than 200 cases in a year.
- 3. There's a shortage of the beds now at our hospital.

Translation

Doctor: (This is) Kidney Transplant.

Investigator: Hello, is this Kidney Transplant in the Laoshan Division of the Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University?

Doctor: Who are you looking for? Which center are you looking for?

Investigator: I am looking for Kidney Transplant. Because a friend of mine referred your hospital to me...my husband needs a kidney transplant, so my friend told me to come to your place.

Doctor: This is Kidney Transplant.

Investigator: I am from Zhejiang. My husband is now in the No. 401 Hospital.

Doctor: In the No. 401 Hospital in Qingdao?

Investigator: Yes, yes.

Doctor: What do you do there?

Investigator: We do our own business here, but he's got a kidney problem.

Doctor: Is he on dialysis?

Investigator: His doctor there suggested that he get a kidney transplant. We've been waiting there for more than half a month. In other words, his case is fairly urgent now! So his doctor told us to try other hospitals and get registered on their waiting lists.

Doctor: If the No. 401 Hospital doesn't do it, why did you go there?

Investigator: Right, they don't do it, but they said that you do it here!

Doctor: Yes, the No. 401 Hospital does not do kidney transplantation any more.

Investigator: Yes, they said that you do it. They told me that you do it at Qingdao University. Which doctor should I come to look for?

Doctor: We have an outpatient clinic, which opens on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Investigator: Who are you, Doctor?

Doctor: Doctor Wang. We're in Laoshan Division. We open every Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Investigator: Oh. Doctor Wang, right? Are you Wang Jingyu?

Doctor: No, I am not.

Investigator: Oh, what's your first name?

Doctor: You just come to get registered.

Investigator: So you are the doctor on duty at the outpatient clinic today, right?

Doctor: We're open on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Investigator: You're open every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Okay, then I will bring his files to you for your review. How soon can it be done if he meets all the requirements for the surgery?

Doctor: It depends on such things as your blood type.

Investigator: Blood type B. My husband is 48 years old.

Dr. Wang: He has to wait, waiting for a suitable one.

Investigator: He has to wait? But we want to get it sooner.

Doctor: We also want to get you one quickly. But that depends on the donors' side, the situation of the kidney sources. It's not easy to find one. It's not so easy to find it. He's got to wait.

Investigator: How long is the wait time, in general?

Doctor: That's hard to say.

Investigator: Oh...

Doctor: You just come here, and get registered on our waiting list first.

Investigator: Have to wait in line, then how about your bed availability? If he can't be admitted into your hospital, he has to go outside to find a place to stay. Can he get admitted in your hospital? Is there a bed available for him?

Doctor: No, there's no bed available.

Investigator: There is no bed available either, oh, that means he can only stay and wait outside?

Doctor: Yes, we have many patients and do more than 200 cases a year.

Investigator: More than 200 cases in a year, that's not too many. I heard from someone that they did more than 300 cases at another hospital.

Doctor: Fine, then you can decide what to do yourself, okay?
