Nurse: Who is this?

Investigator: I'm at the Provincial Hospital. As my classmate told me, the military hospitals are fairly good. As a military hospital yourself, do you do that? If so, I would like to get the patient transferred over, because the Provincial Hospital...yes, we would like to get transferred to your hospital. Do you do it?

Nurse: Ah, yes, we do!

Investigator: Ah, then how do we get transferred? Should I bring you the files by myself, or along with the patient?

Nurse: Depending on the patient's own situation, you can get him admitted into our hospital directly if you want to. But I would suggest you do a consultation first, consult with our director about his case first.

Investigator: Oh...

Nurse: Because our director's gone to an operation now, you can just come to our Hepatobiliary Surgery Clinic on Monday.

Investigator: First consult about the transfer? Then which doctor or director should I go to?

Nurse: Chen Zhong, Director Chen.

Investigator: Chen Zhong?

Nurse: Yes

Investigator: Zhong, as in "Zhongguo"?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Chen, the one with "Er" and "Dong"?

Nurse: Right.

Investigator: It's Chen Zhong, right? But my classmate recommended Director Ni, Ni Jialian.

Nurse: Director Ni is now retired.

Investigator: Ni is retired, and Director Chen is in charge now?

Nurse: Right, that's right. Come see Director Chen on Monday. Consult with him at the clinic on Monday.

Investigator: My case is urgent. We want to have the surgery done as soon as possible. By your normal procedures, can it be done in half a month? Can the surgery be arranged by then?

Nurse: That's hard to say, because that involves the liver sources.

Investigator: Ah, according to your experience, is there any chance to get it done in half a month?

Nursing: Uh, some cases were really fast! The previous two surgeries were performed the next day after the patients arrived. But in your case, what can I tell you? I can't tell you any details!

Investigator: Eh, you are at the nurses' station, right? I would like to confirm again about the skills of Chen Zhong, Director Chen. Are his skills good?

Nurse: Yes, yes, yes, we are at the nurses' station.

Investigator: I would like to confirm Director Chen's skill. Are his skills good?

Nurse: How can I tell you about that? Ha, ha, ha... Our doctors do liver transplants pretty well, and they do a very good job!

Investigator: How many years has he been doing that? How many years?

Nurse: We've been doing that for over a dozen years.

Investigator: It's been more than ten years, then the technology should be quite mature.

Nurse: You could ask our director when you see him. Please ask him for details. I can't explain it to you clearly, as I don't understand all those specifics. It would be better if you ask our director, okay?
