Investigator: Hello?

Doctor A: Hello!

Investigator: Hey, hello! How are you, Doctor? Is this the First Affiliated Hospital of Chongqing Medical University? My relative wants to go to your hospital for a kidney transplant.

Doctor A: Wait a minute!

Investigator: Okay, thank you.

Doctor B: For such things as the kidney sources, sometimes it depends on luck. In fast cases, they may become available tomorrow, but in slow cases, they may not show up even after the patients have waited for half a year or a year.

Investigator: Got it, so, we'll have to bring all the files to get on your waiting list, and make an appointment with Director Liang, right?

Doctor B: You have to contact us first. You can get hospitalized when a match is found.
