Investigator: I'd like to ask you something. Yours, Renji Hospital of Shanghai Jiaotong University, is also ranked fairly high in Shanghai, and is considered among the best in the field, right?

Nurse: Regarding that...what should I say? Anyway... if you've been looking everywhere, as I already told you, Director Zhang goes to the outpatient clinic on Thursday morning. You may tell him to come to the director's outpatient clinic, so the doctor can learn about his case.

Investigator: Sure! Doctor Zhang Ming, as you just mentioned, is the authoritative kidney transplant surgeon, isn't he?

Nurse: Yes. He's our director.

Investigator: Then how many cases can he do in a month? There is absolutely no problem with his skills. How many years has he been doing transplants?

Nurse: I'm not sure about those things. I can't answer what you just asked. Anyways, your purpose is to find an authoritative doctor, and get it done fast?

Investigator: That's right!

Nurse: You let him go to the East Division. Anyways, as I told you, every Thursday morning, a kidney transplant expert is available. Okay?

Investigator: Okay, thank you! Does he do it every day? Does he?

Nurse: Cases are performed whenever there are kidney sources available! It's not like that if you want to do 10 cases today then you can actually do 10 cases! It also depends on if the kidney sources are available!

Investigator: I'm sorry. It's not easy for me to get through when I make a phone call. I'd like to ask again, if he's admitted into your hospital, will there be a bed available for him? Will there be any bed shortage at your hospital then?

Nurse: He'll have to go to the outpatient clinic first...just go see a doctor at the clinic. The doctor will then assess his case after some further treatments. If a suitable kidney source becomes available, the doctor will notify you. After you're informed, there must be a bed available for your patient by then.

Investigator: Oh, that sounds good. So, what is your relationship with the East Division? Is the same one hospital divided into two locations?

Nurse: It's one hospital, the same one hospital! It's just that the doctors have to have an outpatient clinic on the East Division.

Investigator: Ah, that's fine! I don't quite understand, so just would like to ask about it. Okay, so, tomorrow is Thursday. Well, how many cases can be done at your hospital in a year?

Nurse: I can't answer this question for you, okay? Let me tell you now, your main purpose now is to find a doctor, to go see a doctor at the hospital you choose. I've already told you the most authoritative director in our hospital. If you have any further questions, you can write them down and go ask Director Zhang directly then. Besides, let him also go himself, because, otherwise, it would be useless even if he's been through all those tests! Right?

Investigator: That's right. Well, as for the cell phone number to contact Dr. Zhang Ming, do you have that by any chance?

Nurse: Such a number cannot be given to you! I've already told you the time and date when the outpatient clinic opens. His cell number cannot be given to you, okay?

Investigator: Ah, that's fine, thank you. Is this the nurses' station or the inpatient service?

Nurse: This is the inpatient service. I'm here at the inpatient service.

Investigator: Good, that's good.

Nurse: Thank you, bye!

Investigator: Thank you, bye!
