Summary

- 1. Dong Jiahong comes to the outpatient clinic on Tuesday mornings and Thursday afternoons.
- 2. The beds are in tight supply. It may not be possible to have a vacant bed available upon arrival.
- 3. There are about 50 beds here in the hepatobiliary surgery inpatient service section.
- 4. In addition to Dong Jiahong, there are other doctors who do liver transplants in the team.
- 5. Consultation at the outpatient clinic only; no consultation over the phone.

Translation

Nurse: Beijing Qinghua Changgeng. How are you?

Investigator: Hello, is this Beijing Tsinghua Changgung Hospital?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Could you please transfer me to Liver Transplant?

Nurse: Sorry, how can I help you? We can't transfer you to the inpatient service.

Investigator: Well, how about the doctors' office?

Nurse: Our office cannot be accessed to the public by phone, and we can't transfer you there either.

Investigator: Oh, no access to the public, and no transfer service.

Nurse: No.

Investigator: How could I get transferred?

Nurse: Would you like to consult on your case or anything else?

Investigator: I'd like to come for a liver transplant.

Nurse: Then you need to go to the outpatient clinic to consult with a doctor. But we cannot transfer you over there, as the doctors do not consult over the phone.

Investigator: I cannot consult the clinic over the phone, either? Because I live very far.

Nurse: No, No consultation over the phone.

Investigator: Oh, the patient himself has to come, right?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: My friend recommended your hospital to me. Do you do liver transplants?

Nurse: We do.

Investigator: You do. As I was told, a doctor named Dong Jiahong does it at your hospital. Is that so?

Nurse: Yes, he works at the outpatient clinic here at this hospital.

Investigator: He is at the outpatient clinic there. What is Dong Jiahong's schedule at the clinic?

Nurse: Hold on, let me check for you.

Investigator: Thank you.

Nursing: Well, he comes to the outpatient clinic here on Tuesday mornings and Thursday afternoons.

Investigator: Anyway, a liver transplant must be done. Doctor Dong Jiahong does that at your hospital, correct?

Nurse: Yes, he offers consultation at the outpatient clinic of the hospital.

Investigator: How about the inpatient service unit? If we come for an immediate admission into your hospital, is there any shortage of beds now? Can we get admitted right away?

Nursing: The beds are in tight supply. It may not be possible to have a vacant bed available when you come.

Investigator: Oh, in that case, as the beds are in tight supply, we may not get admitted if we come, right? Are there many liver transplant beds in your hospital?

Nurse: There are about 40 to 50 beds here in the hepatobiliary surgery inpatient service section.

Investigator: Oh, almost 50 beds, right?

Nurse: Correct.

Investigator: Oh, I see. May I ask who else does the surgeries well other than Doctor Dong Jiahong? Who else can do them?

Nurse: Doctor Dong Jiahong and his team. You will find more information on our hospital's online appointment website.

Investigator: So, there are several teams conducting the liver transplantation, right?

Nursing: Yes, Doctor Dong Jiahong's team are at the outpatient clinic. For the detailed information, you'll have to make an appointment and consult at the clinic.

Investigator: Oh, besides Dong Jiahong's team, are there any other doctors' teams?

Nurse: Yes, there are other doctors in the team at the clinic.

Investigator: What're the other doctors' names? Could you let me know? In case I couldn't find him, I could go to one of the other doctors.

Nurse: You log in to our hospital's official website for making appointments, and you will see the doctors of his team are marked as such.

Investigator: Oh, I see.

Nurse: Right.

Investigator: Okay, thank you.

Nurse: Not at all, goodbye.

Investigator: Okay, bye!

Nurse: Bye.
