Nurse: We can't do that many.

Investigator: How many then? Approximately, how many can you do? Do you do a lot, as compared with other hospitals?

Nurse: I'm not sure how many cases other hospitals do. We've just done more than one hundred cases this year.

Investigator: One hundred cases. Huh.

Investigator: So how long usually do your patients need to stay in hospital until they get discharged, like after their operations are done?

Nurse: It all depends. You'd better go to the clinic. This phone number is for ER here.

Investigator: Oh, I'm calling the ER number. Alright, bye now!
