## **Summary:**

- 1. Investigator: Liver donors are allocated to our hospital with priority, so many patients are waiting here, and their surgeries are also done quickly. Is that so? Nurse Liu: Yes.
- 2. Our transplant program has four professors. On Tuesdays, we have Lin Jianhua, Professor Lin. On Wednesdays, we have Yang Dinghua, Professor Yang. On Fridays, we have Li Jiang, Professor Li. Then our Director Zhou Jie only comes to the overseas Chinese clinic. He does not come to the regular clinic. He only comes to the overseas Chinese clinic, or Huiqiao Clinic.
- 3. The Price? It depends on the patient's physical condition and the postoperative rejection situation. If the rejection is severe, if the drugs are expensive, the cost will increase.
- 4. The duration of the postoperative hospitalization? If the patient recovers quickly, sometimes it takes about two weeks, and we had such cases.
- 5. Falun Gong donors? I'm not sure about that. We don't know about those things. Ask the doctor.

## Translation

Nurse Liu: Hello!

Investigator: Hello, hello, greetings. Is this the Hepatobiliary Inpatient Service of Southern Medical University? Nanfang Hospital?

Nurse Liu: Ah, yes, yes.

Investigator: Yes, then in Hepatobiliary Surgery, in a fast case, can you get it done in a month or half a month? You have had such cases, right?

Nurse Liu: Yes, we had such patients. But those things are hard to say.

Investigator: As everyone said, your hospital is given priority in the liver source allocation, so there are many patients on your waiting list, and it can be quickly done here. Is that so?

Nurse Liu: Yes.

Nurse Liu: Let me tell you first, yes. We have four professors doing it in our center. On Tuesdays, we have Lin Jianhua, Professor Lin. On Wednesdays, we have Yang Dinghua, Professor Yang. On Fridays, we have Li Chuanjiang, Professor Li. Then our director only comes to the clinic for those overseas Chinese patients. He does not come to the regular clinic. These four people are all...

Investigator: What are the names of your professors?

Nurse Liu: You just look for that...

Investigator: The fourth one, as you just said, the fourth one, I could not find him just now.

Nurse Liu: He, he, he does not come to the regular clinic, but the one for overseas Chinese only.

Investigator: Ah, so, the overseas clinic for foreigners?

Nurse Liu: Ah, yes, he only comes to that clinic.

Investigator: Well, let me ask you a question. My sister's neighbor, she is in Guangzhou. So in the past, her father had his surgery done by Zhou...Zhou Jie, Director Zhou Jie. Is he still around?

Nurse Liu: Yes, that's our director. He is our director.

Investigator: Ah, Zhou Jie now does not see regular patients from Mainland China. He only sees foreigners. Ah, so now I...

Nurse Liu: No, he still does it, he still does it. He only comes to the overseas Chinese clinic, not the regular clinic.

Investigator: Ah, I see. He can still do the operations, right?

Nurse Liu: Right, our director still does transplants.

Investigator: Ah, Zhou Jie is still there. Then, let me ask, do you know how much it costs to have a transplant done here at your hospital? How long is the hospitalization? How much Renminbi does it cost in total?

Nurse Liu: This thing depends on the patient's physical condition, and the patient's postoperative rejection. It depends...

Investigator: Just a ballpark number.

Nurse Liu: I can only say, based on our four patients recently, you are looking at around 400,000 to 500,000 yuan.

Investigator: 400,000 to 500,000 yuan? That's fine. 400,000 to 500,000 yuan is acceptable to us.

Nurse Liu: No, that's not the final number, and it really depends. I only gave you that figure, which was paid by a few of our recent patients, as reference. Mainly because there is an issue with postoperative rejection, if the rejection is severe, the cost will go up, since those drugs, the anti-rejection drugs are expensive.

Investigator: So how long is the hospitalization usually? Around a month? Or around 20 days, if things are normal?

Nurse Liu: Ah, here's the thing in general. If the patient recovers quickly, sometimes it takes about two weeks, and we had cases like that. Because after the operation, the anti-rejection drug dosage must be adjusted. The anti-rejection drug must be taken for the rest of the life.

Investigator: Postoperative monitoring is needed, right? So, if the postoperative recovery is good, usually how long can the patient survive?

Nurse Liu: En, in our transplant program, we often have patients returning for reassessment after more than 10 years. But, but, I'm only...only talking about the best cases. I have not mentioned the bad ones.

Investigator: Not a problem.

Nurse Liu: You got to understand it well, okay?

Investigator: Because my sister's neighbor's father had Professor Zhou Jie as his transplant surgeon. She said that it has been working well since it was done almost seven or eight years ago. According to her, her father's organ donor was found through the connections. It was a Falun Gong practitioner. Now we also want that kind of donors. Can we get that?

Nurse Liu: I am not sure about that. We don't know about those things.

Investigator: To request something like that, we have to get registered and talk to the director, or the doctor, right?

Nurse Liu: Right, ask the doctor.

Investigator: Ask the doctor? Nurse Liu: Yes, yes, yes. We are not sure about those things.

Investigator: Is that so? Okay...

Nurse Liu: You can just follow the official account of Nanfang Hospital of Southern Medical University. Okay?

Nurse Liu: Okay, our director only comes to the overseas Chinese clinic, and you can find him there.

Investigator: Zhou Jie at the overseas Chinese clinic. Okay.

Nurse Liu: It is called Huiqiao Building Clinic. Okay?

Investigator: Good, good. Okay, thank you!

Nurse Liu: Good, no problem.

Investigator: Ah, how should I address you?

Nurse Liu: My last name is Liu.

Investigator: Good. Thank you then!

Nurse Liu: Ah, no problem, no problem.

Investigator: Okay, bye!

Nurse Liu: Okay.
