Nursing: You can bring 15,000 or 20,000 yuan first, and then let the doctor assess the patient's condition to see whether it can be done, you know?

Investigator: If it can be done, it would cost hundreds of thousands or tens of thousands. I have to prepare the money. Otherwise when it can be done but I don't have enough money.
