Summary

1. Investigator: Hasn't the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University done especially many cases, and especially fast. Can it be done in a week?

Nurse: Yes, if a matched organ is found, as long as a matched organ is found.

Investigator: It can be done?

Nurse: Usually it can be done, and quite fast.

- 2. The chief surgeon for liver transplants is Lyu Yi, Professor Lyu.
- 3. It seems that we did over a hundred cases last year.
- 4. 400,000 yuan is required as the first payment, but that also depends, because some patients could have complications.
- 5. Investigator: We want those donors such as Falun Gong practitioners. Is that possible? Nurse: Regarding such a request, I cannot...how can I tell you? As for all the liver sources...we have the personnel dedicated to that, regarding the organs.
- 6. Investigator: If I want the Falun Gong donors, I can discuss with the doctor. Is that so?

Nurse: Eh, when the time comes, you can discuss that with the doctor.

Investigator: Hi there, I have a question. If we go to your place for a liver transplant, do we need to wait in line?

Nurse: Hi, greetings! It's like this, you have to come for an assessment first, if it can be done, then you can wait in line.

Investigator: Oh, then usually how long do I have to wait in your hospital? Can it be done

very soon?

Nurse: That depends on the tissue typing. They need to do the tissue typing.

Investigator: Yes. Is your place, the First Affiliated Hospital at Xi'an Jiaotong University, the largest one there? According to my sister's neighbor, your hospital handles a lot of cases, and very quickly. So, if I come over, can it be done in a week if the tissue typing works out successfully?

Nurse: As long as the tissue typing can be done successfully, well, in any case, as long as it works out fine, then, well...you'll have to wait in the queue anyway.

Investigator: It works like that?

Nurse: Yes, usually it works like that, very fast!

Investigator: Some got it done in a week or a few days. Is that so?

Nurse: Eh, sometimes there were such cases.

Investigator: Is the chief surgeon the director, or the president?

Nurse: Lyu Yi, Professor Lyu.

Investigator: Ah, Lyu as with double "kou". Lyu Yi.

Nurse: Eh, yes.

Investigator: Ah, Professor Lyu is the chief surgeon. How many cases can you do in a year at your hospital?

Nurse: For those specifics, you can ask in person when you come here!

Investigator: So Professor Lyu has done it for many years? Are his skills good?

Nurse: En.

Investigator: How many operations can you do in a year?

Nurse: Eh, it seems that we did over a hundred cases last year.

Investigator: You did over a hundred cases last year! My neighbor told me someone named Yu Liang. Is he still around?

Nurse: En, yes.

Investigator: Yu Liang is still around?

Nurse: They are a team. It is not done by someone alone. They are a team.

Investigator: Ah, so they do it together, right?

Nurse: Yes, yes.

Investigator: Oh, oh. Roughly how much money shall I prepare?

Nurse: En, regarding that cost, it seems that 400,000 yuan must be paid initially.

Investigator: 400,000 yuan. Does that include hospitalization fees?

Nurse: Is 400,000 yuan enough? That depends, because some patients could have complications.

Investigator: Oh, so the basic operation fee is 400,000 yuan. If things happen later during hospitalization, if other things happen, does more money need to be prepared?

Nurse: En, yes, yes.

Investigator: Oh, is that so? Then I have another question. So in our place, my sister's neighbor's father had his done in your hospital, about a few years ago, at least five or six years back. He said his father got his liver transplant done, using that kind of livers taken from Falun Gong practitioners. Now we also want that kind of donors. Is that possible?

Nurse: As for such a request, I cannot...how can I tell you? All the liver sources are...we have the personnel dedicated to that, regarding the organs.

Investigator: You have dedicated organ personnel, in charge of organ matching?

Nurse: Yes, yes, yes. We have a dedicated team, in charge of organ transplants, including all the procedures...

Investigator: Ah.

Nurse: It requires all the people.

Investigator: Ah, so who can I talk to about the details?

Nurse: We have the clinic open on Mondays and Thursdays. You can go to Hepatobiliary Surgery.

Investigator: Hepatobiliary Surgery opens on Mondays and Thursdays...

Nurse: Then you go there to get registered. Then you tell them you need a transplant, then they will make an appointment for you.

Investigator: Ah, on Mondays or on Thursdays I go to the clinic. That is the team responsible for liver transplantation.

Nurse: Yes, yes!

Investigator: Do they have a phone number for them over there?

Nurse: Ah, we don't know the number for the clinic over there.

Investigator: You don't have it?

Nurse: We are the Inpatient Service Unit. When you go there, you talk to one of the nurses, who are at 000?

Investigator: So I look for Yu Liang or Lyu Yi? So I go there and directly look for them on Mondays or Thursdays?

Nurse: En, as I told you, it is a team. It could be another doctor there. They do the assessment together as a team, so you don't need to look for anyone specific.

Investigator: Ah.

Nurse: You tell them that you want to do...perhaps get a transplant done, then let the doctor take a look at your records. They will make an appointment for you if you want to see the doctor.

Investigator: Oh, so if I, for example, I want that kind of Falun Gong practitioners, the one as the neighbor's father got, I can discuss with the doctor. Is that so?

Nurse: En, regarding that request, you can talk to the doctor when the time comes.

Investigator: Talk to the doctor?

Nurse: For now you don't need to. Anyway, regarding the liver source, you'll need to discuss with the doctor!

Investigator: Oh, this is what we're most worried about—we've spent the money now only to find troubles later in life. That's why we want a good donor, just like that.

Nurse: By then you can discuss that with the doctor.

Investigator: Discuss with the doctor?

Nurse: En, yes.

Investigator: But you don't have their number? Cell phone?

Nurse: You can just go to the clinic by then.

Investigator: I can just go to the clinic, right? That's fine.

Nurse: Okay, okay.

Investigator: What's your name? May I ask, how should I address you? Then if I go

there...

Nurse: This is the phone number for the nurse station.

Investigator: So each shift is a different person. In case I go there, maybe I will need your

help. How should I address you?

Nurse: No problem. Our phone number is 383900. Whenever you come, this is our nurse

station's phone number.

Investigator: Oh, okay.

Nurse: You can just call this number then.

Investigator: Oh, okay, okay. Then thank you very much. I will let you go. Sorry to bother

you. Thank you. Bye!

Nurse: Bye!
