Summary

1. We now do as many as five to six, or six to seven cases here!

2. One year we can do a few hundred cases of kidney transplants.

3. Director Liu Dong is still doing it.

4. Now not just the one (Liu Dong), many other doctors can do it.

5. Doctor Zhou indicated: If we (the patient) can spend more money, we can discuss

shifting it closer.

Translation

Investigator: Hey, hello!

Doctor Zhou: Hey, who is this?

Investigator: Hello! This is Guangdong Second Provincial General Hospital, right? My surname is Li. Someone suggested that I go to your place, as my family member wants to have a kidney transplant there.

Doctor Zhou: You can come over first.

Investigator: Sorry for asking, because it's my sister's child, she wants to ask about the situation. Usually after going there, do we have to get the tissue typing done first? After that, then we'll get in the queue, right?

Doctor Zhou: Yes, correct.

Investigator: So how long would the wait time be?

Doctor Zhou: That depends, it depends on the blood type. Okay?

Investigator: He is blood type B. He had his tissue typing done in another hospital. Yes.

Doctor Zhou: Type B, then you can come over first, okay? Come and have a look, then we can discuss it in person. You come first and have a look, okay?

Investigator: So for him, if his tissue typing is performed successfully, how long would he need to wait before he can get it done?

Doctor Zhou: No, you have to see, it depends if there is suitable one available, okay?

Investigator: But, right now isn't there the virus (issue)? Is there a need to be quarantined? No such a need is required, right?

Doctor Zhou: No, no. If you are not an inpatient, no need to get checked. But if you'd like to get admitted into the hospital, you have to be checked immediately when you arrive. You must be checked for admission, that's it...okay?

Investigator: So for this year, how many has your hospital done? Have you done a lot? According to my sister, if you do a lot now, then you must be able to do well.

Doctor Zhou: This is not about doing more or less. We now do as many as five to six, or six to seven cases here!

Investigator: I also want to ask, if we go there...because I used to have a friend whose father had it done by that Director called Liu, Director Liu Dong, at your hospital. Is he still doing it? What is your surname?

Doctor Zhou: My surname is Zhou, okay. You can come over and have a look.

Investigator: Is Director Liu still there?

Doctor Zhou: Yes.

Investigator: Still there, is he the lead surgeon?

Doctor Zhou: Ah, that depends. If you want him to be the lead surgeon, it is also okay. You can get any other one. Now not just one, but many doctors can do it. Anyone is fine.

Investigator: Because our financial situation is fine, it is okay to spend more money. (We) just wanted to get it done fast. That's it.

Doctor Zhou: That's not so. I have to say, your patient needs (to get) a suitable, suitable one that matches him. There must be some sequence to be followed in the process. But if you want to proceed, we can make adjustments then. We can talk about it then, okay? Come and have a look.

Investigator: Yes. We can spend more money. So you can make the adjustments to get it done sooner, right?

Doctor Zhou: We can discuss that later, after you come over and take a look, okay?

Investigator: Yes, my sister was just asking me, "Can you ask him how many cases can be done a year?" I said to her, "I don't know." I have to ask you, how many cases do you do in a year? So that she can feel assured.

Doctor Zhou: A few hundred cases. Those are for kidney transplants...quite high volume

of cases performed. After you decide to get it done here, he will discuss with you. Okay? Now you are not yet at the matching stage, it's still early, okay?

Investigator: It's still early, but we have to ask about it first. At least we need to know, as this is not a small operation, right? It concerns the patient's life and death, right? We have to ask you to be well informed!

Doctor Zhou: Yes, yes, okay, if you wish, you can come and take a look, okay?

Investigator: So if I go there, can I look for you?

Doctor Zhou: Yes.

Investigator: So what is your full name?

Doctor Zhou: My surname is Zhou, Doctor Zhou. You can call me Doctor Zhou. There is only one surnamed Zhou here.

Investigator: So what is your full name? That's Doctor Zhou?

Doctor Zhou: Ah, yes, you can look for Doctor Zhou. They all know.

Investigator: So what is your full name?

Doctor Zhou: My surname is Zhou, Zhou Jiexue. You can call me Doctor Zhou.

Investigator: Ah, Zhou Jiexue, okay, got it.

Doctor Zhou: En.
