1. The liver transplants are done by Zheng Shusen himself here. He's been doing it all year round, with no holidays.
2. Regarding liver transplants, "many, many, there were already a lot of cases performed in the beginning of this year. There were many done by then!"
3. Our wait time is shorter than usual.
4. Compared within the whole province, "Now we are doing the largest volume."

Translation

Investigator: Hello, hello, hello.

Nurse: Hello.

Investigator: Is this Zhejiang Shulan Hospital, the International Hospital?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: I'd like to ask you something. As you do liver transplants, how are things going? Can you do that (for us)? Liver transplantation.

Nurse: Ah, this requires the doctor's assessment. You can bring the relevant materials, make an appointment with one of the doctors at the Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Surgery, and then let the doctor take a look.

Investigator: President Zheng, President Zheng Shusheng, is he still in this hospital?

Nurse: Yes, yes, every Wednesday, he comes to the outpatient clinic every Wednesday.

Investigator: Oh, the liver transplants are done by him?

Nurse: Ah, yes, yes.

Investigator: Yes. So that means President Zheng is doing them alone. How many cases can he do? How many cases has he done? The liver transplants in our place now...?

Nurse: Many, many. A lot of cases were performed in the beginning of this year. Many cases were done by then!

Investigator: A lot of cases were already done in the beginning of this year?

Nurse: Right.

Investigator: Oh. All the surgeries were done by him himself?

Nurse: Right, right, right.

Investigator: Oh, say this year, just after the New Year's holidays, just after the 15th of the first month, you already started doing a lot?

Nurse: Yes, he, in one year, throughout the year, he can do as many cases as the patients are suitable. It does not matter which one ...

Investigator: Oh, in that case, then you have done a lot, and the wait time is definitely shorter than that of the hospital of Zhejiang University?

Nurse: Yes, that is shorter than the average, but that also depends on each person's own situation.

Investigator: Ah, ah. Then, at such a big hospital, an international hospital, as yours, can you do hundreds of liver transplants per year?

Nurse: Right, right, now we are doing the largest volume.

Investigator: How many can you do at most? Because I inquired about those hospitals in Shanghai, eh, Renji seems to be doing eight hundred a year according to the information on its website. So you guys do more than they do?

Nurse: We don't compare ourselves with those in Shanghai, but only with those within the province.

Investigator: Oh, you only do the comparisons within the province, oh, only do so within the province.

Nurse: Ah, compared with those provincial ones within the province. As for other provinces, you may...but, this thing...

Investigator: As I checked on the internet, I saw what Renji has been doing there, but I still think, eh, it's more convenient to get it done within the province here. Do you think you can do four or five hundred transplants a year?

Nurse: Ah, I really don't know how many cases we do here, because that data doesn't get shared with our division.

Investigator: Alright.

Nurse: We've done a lot.

Investigator: Okay, that's it, thank you. Let me talk to him. If I have any further questions or issues that I need your help with, I will let you know.

Nurse: If you need something, please call us again,

Investigator: Okay, thank you, oh, goodbye.

Nurse: Oh, not at all.
