Summary

1. We're a designated COVID-19 hospital.
2. We have done it within a few days, and it all depends on the liver donation.
3. Just come to the hospital to find me, and make an appointment with Zhou Huinian at the outpatient clinic.
4. I tell you the phone number: 177 9767 7783.
5. The cost of the surgery and hospitalization is about 200,000 yuan, and other costs are more than 200,000 yuan, so 400,000 yuan.
6. (For a liver transplant,) we have done it in just a few days.

Translation

Nurse: Hey, hello! General (Surgery) at Lanzhou University Second Hospital.

Investigator: Hey, is this...is this the liver transplant program of Lanzhou University Second Hospital?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Then I'd like to ask, at your hospital now...are you a liver transplant doctor? I'd like to consult a doctor, as I am in an urgent situation.

Nurse: Wait a bit.

Investigator: Okay, thank you!

Nurse: Wait a second, let me go get a doctor for you. Wait a second.

Investigator: He does liver transplants, right?

(Waiting...)

Zhou Huinian: Hello.

Investigator: Hello, hello! Are you a doctor who does liver transplants?

Zhou Huinian: Right, that's right.

Investigator: Hello! It's like this. My husband needs to have a liver transplant. My relatives just recommended your hospital to me, saying that your hospital is doing it relatively better.

Zhou Huinian: Ah, what's his illness?

Investigator: It's the liver, alcoholic cirrhosis.

Investigator: Right.

Zhou Huinian: What's his blood type?

Investigator: Type B.

Zhou Huinian: Type B, right?

Investigator: Yes.

Zhou Huinian: In that case, you have to come over first and get him registered in our system first.

Investigator: Ah, I want to ask you another thing, here during the pandemic, there are

designated COVID-19 hospitals, are you such a designated hospital?

Zhou Huinian: Yes, yes.

Investigator: As you're a designated hospital, is there any danger there if we come?

Zhou Huinian: No.

Investigator: Do we need to be quarantined?

Zhou Huinian: No need.

Investigator: If we come, we can get it done right away, right?

Zhou Huinian: It's not that you can get it done as soon as you come here. You come first, you have to get registered on the waiting list in our system, then you have to wait for the liver source, and finally you will be notified to get it done here, okay?

Investigator: Ah, if we're to...if we're to wait to acquire the liver source, is the donor who might be, can you tell...regarding the pandemic?

Zhou Huinian: Yes.

Investigator: You can. So if it is...if everything falls in place, then how long will it take to... if he meets all the requirements, how long will it take to get the liver source?

Zhou Huinian: That's hard to say, hard to say. There is no specific time.

Investigator: Ah, then I will in January...I want to bring him to get registered first, get registered on the computer. After that, I'm...

Zhou Huinian: Yes.

Investigator: Then I'll get registered on the waiting lists at several more hospitals, will that work?

Zhou Huinian: Ah, yes, right, yes. That's how it works.

Investigator: Well, I'd like to ask another thing, if at a hospital such as yours, according to your experience, in general, how long does it take for you to do it, in the fastest case?

Zhou Huinian: We have done it within a few days.

Investigator: Ah, some just took a few days?

Zhou Huinian: Yes, that's right. It all depends on the liver donation, liver donors, okay?
It's not decided by us, okay.

Investigator: Ah, which doctor should we go to if we come?

Zhou Huinian: Just look for me.

Investigator: What is your last name?

Zhou Huinian: My last name is Zhou, mine is Zhou.

Investigator: Zhou, what is your full name?

Zhou Huinian: Next week..., if you want to come, Wednesday next week.

Investigator: Come on Wednesday?

Zhou Huinian: Make an appointment for Wednesday morning, make an appointment for Wednesday morning, at the outpatient clinic.

Investigator: Make an appointment for Wednesday morning with Doctor Zhou directly.
Your full name, please?

Zhou Huinian: It's Zhou, Zhou Huinian, Hui as in "Guanghui", Nian as in "Guonian".

Investigator: Zhou, Zhou Huinian, right?

Zhou Huinian: Yes, I'll give you the phone number.

Investigator: Ah, you have a number to tell me, thank you!

Investigator: Morning, Wednesday morning, right?

Zhou Huinian: Hey, yes, yes, okay? Come here after the appointment is made, yeah.

Investigator: Okay, let me ask another thing. If we have to put together enough for this, how much will the cost be approximately? In terms of the expenses?

Zhou Huinian: In terms of the expenses..., as for our, our entire transplant process, the expenses for the surgery, the surgery and the hospitalization together are basically at about 200,000 yuan, and then..., other costs are estimated to be more than 200,000 yuan, so 400,000 yuan.

Investigator: Oh, adding all these, adding all these together will be about 400,000 yuan, right?

Zhou Huinian: Yes, yes, yes, basically that's it, if things go well.

Investigator: Ah, then generally this...

Zhou Huinian: Okay?

Investigator: Oh, good, that means if he comes and is suitable (for the surgery), well, there won't be any problem with vacant beds in your hospital or other things, right?

Zhou Huinian: Right, right.

Investigator: Ah.

Zhou Huinian: Okay? That's it for now, I am going to answer another phone call.

Investigator: Oh, okay, thank you, Dr. Zhou!
