4. It's about 500,000 yuan for a liver transplant. You can reimburse part of it.
5. You'd have to pay 800,000 to 1,000,000 yuan up front if you go to Beijing.

#### Translation

Investigator: Hi, hello!

Doctor Ye Chengjie: Hi!

Investigator: Hi, hello! Is this Doctor Ye Chengjie?

Doctor Ye Chengjie: How can I help you?

Investigator: Ah, that's good. I hope it can be done in a month. (Doctor: Ah.) That will be great.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: No, you have to...it's like this. We have to look for...surely we must look for a good liver for transplantation.

Investigator: Ah.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: We cannot just do it casually, and make you spend the money to suffer, without fixing your problem. How could we let that happen?

Investigator: Yes, that's right. We are the most concerned about the quality.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: Now you got it. Please come over!

Investigator: Ah. This is my first time dealing with this. I just want to ask, about those livers, where do they come from? If we want the healthiest one, how can we find it?

Doctor Ye Chengjie: We can look for it in our ICU.

Investigator: Ah.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: Additionally, well, we can go to Sichuan, and Nanjing, to look for it as well.

Investigator: Ah, look for it in Sichuan or Nanjing. Ah.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: You see, ah, yeah, that's right. Ah.

Investigator: Yes. A friend of mine got it done not in your province but in another province. As he told me, he found one from one of those who practice qigong, practice Falun Gong. They don't smoke or drink. Can you help find one like that? I also want it, no matter how much money to spend.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: He was lying to you. Now there is no (such a thing)... That is illegal!

Investigator: How much money do I have to prepare?

Doctor Ye Chengjie: Well, about, about 500,000 yuan. You can reimburse part of it.

Investigator: He can get the medical insurance. He has the medical insurance.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: Ah, yes, that's right. Medical insurance can reimburse part of it.

Investigator: Okay, okay.

Doctor Ye Chengjie: If you go to Beijing, you'd have to pay 800,000 to 1,000,000 yuan up front.
