He Xiaoshun: Hello?

Investigator: Hello. Is that President He Xiaoshun of the First Affiliated Hospital, Sun Yat-sen University?

He Xiaoshun: Yes, that's correct!

Investigator: Oh, I'm calling you from Chengdu, Sichuan. I am the deputy director of the Office for Maintaining Stability at the Sichuan Provincial Political and Legal Affairs Commission. I'm calling...

He Xiaoshun: Hmm, hello!

Investigator: Hello! Hello! I'm calling to seek your help. I have a relative in Tianhe district, Guangzhou. He has hepatitis B and late-stage liver cirrhosis, and he needs to have a liver transplant. My relative really wants to have the surgery at your hospital...

He Xiaoshun: Sure, sure, sure. Have him contact me, okay?

Investigator: Ok, that's great. If he goes to your hospital, how long will it take to schedule an operation? I want to know, so in this way, I can arrange a time to come and visit him.

He Xiaoshun: Oh, it's hard to say. There must be a (matching) organ here. Anyway, we have a lot available here, because we are a big center. We do more than 200 cases a year!

Investigator: Oh.

He Xiaoshun: Then, what's his blood type? It's hard to say if we will have a match, you know what I mean?

Investigator: Uh, you said you're...

He Xiaoshun: One month. Should be able to have [the surgery] in one month!

Investigator: Within one month, great.

He Xiaoshun: Yes, in general [it] would take one or two weeks. But in general, the [wait time] wouldn't exceed one month.

Investigator: So, it usually takes one or two weeks, but sometimes [it would take] one month, right?

He Xiaoshun: In general, our own hospital [operates] like that.

Investigator: They [the “donor” and organ recipient] are together, so [the organ] is extracted and then directly transplanted at the same time, right?

Investigator: Ah, okay, okay. I'll let him contact you. Yeah, ok. Uh, ok, that's all. Thank you.
