**Investigation Recording 2**, **Wang Jianli:** Associate Chief Physician of the of Organ Transplant Institute, Beijing Armed Police General Hospital **Investigation Time:** November 2, 2018 (13911723417):

Associate Chief Physician of the of Organ Transplant Institute, Beijing Armed Police General Hospital. He is currently the leader of the Liver Transplant and Kidney Transplantation Team at the Liver Transplant Institute of the Armed Police General Hospital. From May 2002 to May 2005, he participated in 437 cases of rapid donor liver excision. There were 429 male donors and 8 female donors with an average age of 34.6 years. The longest warm ischemia time was 8 minutes and the shortest was 1 minute, with an average of 4.8 minutes.

6. (A liver transplant) can be done with 200,000 or 300,000 (yuan).

## **Phone Investigation Recording**

Wang Jianli: Hello!

Investigator: Hello! Is that the Armed Police General Hospital, oh, Wang Jianli, Director Wang of Organ Research Institute?

Wang Jianli: Right.

Investigator: Hi, hello, I am calling from Chengdu, Sichuan Province. I am Sichuan Provincial (Wang Jianli: Hello) Political and Legal Affairs Commission's deputy director. Hello! Wang Jianli: Hello!

Investigator: I am calling you today to ask for help. I have a relative in Fengtai. he has liver cirrhosis and needs to do a liver transplant. I heard that you had done a lot, and very fast, so I just call you to ask for help. Wang Jianli: Oh~ Where is he now?

Investigator: He is now in Fengtai. Wang Jianli: Ah, Fengtai.

Investigator: In Fengtai. Wang Jianli: What is his blood type?



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Investigator: His blood is type B, 45 years old this year. Wang Jianli: His situation is not very serious now, right?

- Investigator: The situation is okay for now! His current situation is not bad. We have done the checkups in No. 307 Hospital, the doctor said, the situation is relatively good now, if we do it early, the effect will be better, so we want to do it early, they have no organs there.
- Wang Jianli: So, you can come on Monday, if you are not in a hurry, just come on Monday morning, ah~ you bring the patient here around 9:00 with his information, and I will take a look at it, okay?

Investigator: That's great. Where can I find you on Monday, when I come? Wang Jianli: Ah  $\sim$  come to the transplant division, transplant ward.

Investigator: Come to the transplant ward to find you, that's great! So after we come to you, how long do you expect to arrange the surgery?

Wang Jianli: There are various situations, it's not up to me. I have to see when there are organs available!

Investigator: Right, that is to see if there is any heart (available for transplant), right, that is, please check the situation. Roughly, I just ask, roughly, my family can arrange it, do you know?

Wang Jianli: Okay, not sure when that can be ready, but we have a lot of organs here!

Investigator: A lot of organs? Wang Jianli: Right.

Investigator: Maybe you can arrange it in a week or two? Wang Jianli: **Almost**, but I can't guarantee it 100%.

Investigator: Okay, can you arrange it in a week or two, right? Wang Jianli: Right!

Investigator: About the organ you have... how about the condition of the organ? I mean the condition of the donor organ. Wang Jianli: What do you mean?

Investigator: What about the health condition? Wang Jianli: They are all healthy, how can we give you unhealthy organs?

Investigator: Oh, you are now, **the organs you are using now are all healthy organs of Falun Gong** (practitioners), healthy donors, right? Wang Jianli: Yes, yes, yes.

Investigator: That is very good. Would the donor be taken to the hospital to take their organs directly for a simultaneous transplant? Or would you go outside the hospital to get the organs back for transplant?

Wang Jianli: (The organs) are all taken at the hospital.



## Investigator: So donors will be taken to the hospital to get the organs directly for transplant, right? Wang Jianli: Right.

Investigator: That is better. Ah~ I have another question, do you use anesthesia when taking organs? Wang Jianli: What do you mean by taking the organs under anesthesia?

Investigator: That is, I just want to ask, don't some people say that if anesthesia is used, it would affect the quality of the organs? The anesthetics would stay in the tissues after organs are taken, right? Wang Jianli: **Why use anesthesia on a brain-dead person?** 

Investigator: That's good, I just want to confirm, I can come to find you directly at the ward on Monday, right? Wang Jianli: Right.

Investigator: Oh, yes, the organ, probably, you see, because, that is to say that we want to do it earlier. You see if the family members want to come to accompany (the patient), there's the issue of planning the schedule. That is, if the situation is good, when we come on Monday, he can directly become hospitalized, right?

Wang Jianli: It depends.

Investigator: It depends, oh, alright, then, if he is able to be hospitalized, then we will bring everything with us, anyway. How much do you think the cost of the liver transplant will be?

Wang Jianli: The cost is not much.

Investigator: Oh, you see, if there is a rough, rough amount, we, ah~? Wang Jianli: Not much, 200,000 or 300,000 yuan will be okay.

Investigator: How much? Wang Jianli: 200,000 or 300,000 yuan will be fine.

Investigator: How much, I didn't hear it. Wang Jianli: 300,000.

Investigator: Okay. Wang Jianli: About 300,000.

Investigator: OK, OK, it will decide after we come, right? Yes, anyway, ah~, then please help us. Wang Jianli: All right.

Investigator: This, the quality of this organ, please make sure, because this, you know this organ is a key (factor). OK! Director Wang, OK. Wang Jianli: Okay, okay, okay.

Investigator: See you on Monday, see you on Monday. Okay, okay, okay.
