2. Investigator: OK, the donors, are the type of normal healthy donors of Falun Gong (practitioners), right? Lang Ren: Right, right, that's right, you're right.

Phone Investigation Recording:

Investigator: Hello! Is that Director Lang Ren of the Department of Liver Transplantation, Beijing Chaoyang

Hospital

Lang Ren: How can I help you?

Investigator: Director Lang, you are Director Lang, how are you! I am the deputy director of the Office for Maintaining Stability at the Sichuan Provincial Political and Legal Affairs Commission, and I am calling today

to ask for your help.

Lang Ren: Alright, I am listening.

Investigator: Can you hear me clearly?

Lang Ren: Go ahead.

Investigator: Okay, this is the situation, I have a relative living in Fengtai, Beijing. He is in the late stage of liver

cirrhosis and thinking about doing a liver transplant at your hospital.

Lang Ren: Ah.

Investigator: Yeah, do you think it's possible?

Lang Ren: I am listening. Liver cirrhosis, right? Ah, I am listening!

Investigator: Yeah, liver cirrhosis, that's right, liver cirrhosis. This person has type B blood, 45 years old this

year.

Lang Ren: Well, are you in Beijing right now or at somewhere else?

Investigator: I am in Chengdu, calling you (from Chengdu). The patient is in Fengtai, Beijing.

Lang Ren: I see. Can you ask the patient's family members to contact me? Or can you ask the patient to contact me?

Investigator: Yes, I will! I am helping him to make contact right now, and then I will ask them to come directly to find you.

Lang Ren: Right, right, let him contact me, OK? Would you give them my phone number, okay?

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Investigator: Oh, yes. I just want to ask, if they come to your place, if the surgery can be arranged, how long it will take?

Lang Ren: If there is nothing unexpected, it probably takes two or three weeks, more or less.

Investigator: Oh, two to three weeks, that's good. Another question is about your current liver sources...

Lang Ren: The phone signal here is not very good, please keep talking.

Investigator: Ah, are the liver sources you are using now still those from Falun Gong (practitioners), this type of healthy donors, right?

Lang Ren: Yes, yes, they are all from donation.

Investigator: Healthy and normal! May I ask another question? Regarding the liver sources, do you take the donors directly to the hospital for onsite excisions and simultaneous transplantation? Or do you take the organs from outside of the hospital and take them back for transplantation?

Lang Ren: Both cases would take place. Some are produced within our hospital, some are from other hospitals.

Investigator: Ah, all right, that's OK. That's fine. So, when is relatively convenient to contact you? Lang Ren: I usually have a lot of operations. You ask him to call or text me in advance, because I'm afraid that I won't be able to answer the phone during operations. I am afraid that he won't find me without appointment.

Investigator: When would be a relatively convenient time for you in general?

Lang Ren: You tell him, tell your relative to make an appointment with me directly, call me or send me a text message, okay? I will give him a time by then.

Investigator: Okay, that's good, that's good. Since your phone signal is not very good, let me repeat, he has liver cirrhosis...

Lang Ren: Got it, 45 years old, liver cirrhosis. I got it. How did you get to know me?

Investigator: A friend recommended you to me. He told me to come to your hospital. In addition, I heard that you have a green channel, which may be even faster, so we hope to come to your place.

Lang Ren: You let your patient contact me, okay?

Investigator: Ok, that's fine. You mean that surgery can be arranged in about two weeks, right?

Lang Ren: More or less, more or less, more or less.

Investigator: OK, the donors, are the type of normal healthy donors of Falun Gong (practitioners), right? Lang Ren: Right, right, that's right, you're right.

Investigator: All right, alright, that's fine. We will end our conversation here, thank you.

Lang Ren: All right.

Investigator: Good, good, goodbye!
