Investigator: But because I am so far away, I want to get a rough idea before going there.

Doctor: Umm...then...

Investigator: It's too far! Please tell me whether we've done a lot of liver transplants, as our doctor said?

Doctor: Yes indeed. Even in the whole country, we rank fairly well.

Investigator: According to my doctor, your hospital does over 300 liver transplants per year, that's why he recommended you. Is that true?

Doctor: Oh, not that many. But lately, we've done...What's wrong with your relative?

Investigator: He has hepatitis B, alcoholic cirrhosis.

Doctor: Oh, they are for sure.

Investigator: Will they be affected if the donors are sick or something?

Doctor: No.

Investigator: No?

Investigator: Have we done any liver transplants this year? Have we done a lot this year?

Doctor: Uh...? This year, we're doing okay. All right, I am being busy now, okay? Come if you'd like to. Bye!
