Investigator: Hello? Hello! How are you! Is this...

Doctor Li: Hello!

Investigator: Hello, hello! I'm contacting you for something urgent, Doctor Li. Is this Doctor Li at the First Affiliated Hospital of Kunming Medical University?

Doctor Li: Who is this?

Investigator: I'm...I'm calling from Zhejiang province. But my elder brother is in your local area in Kunming. He's now in Kunming Municipal Hospital of Traditional Chinese Medicine. He told me that his doctor advised him to have a liver transplant. I learned online that you're a doctor of liver transplants. My friend heard that you're good at that. So, I'd like to ask: do you still do that?

Doctor Li: Yes, I do. Ask him to come over for a consultation. No phone consultation is accepted for any treatment.

Investigator: I'm not seeking any treatment. He's been in the hospital of traditional Chinese medicine for some days. Now he needs a liver transplant. So, we're looking for a good hospital for him. Does it make sense? Since we're businessmen, money is not a problem. But we'd like to change for a better place for him, which boasts mature and good skills. Roughly speaking, how soon can such an operation be done?

Doctor Li: Where is the patient, your elder brother?

Investigator: At Kunming Municipal Hospital of Traditional Chinese Medicine.

Doctor Li: Oh, at Kunming Municipal Hospital of Traditional Chinese Medicine. Then your phone number...why does your phone number look kind of odd?

Investigator: Well, I'm calling from Zhejiang province. I'm making an online call. Because...the high security sensitive nature of my business, generally, we never use our cell phones to call strangers. Besides, through this phone, I'd also like to consult a secret thing that, hopefully, is kept as such for other people! That is, while I was there, someone told me that a patient could get a better organ if he receives treatment from you! In other words, it would be the best to use a (Falun Gong) practitioner's organ. That's why I'm calling you with this phone. If you can find such an organ, we'll come over to you.

Doctor Li: Listen, listen. For your specific situation...you may let that...for your specific situation...let the patient in Kunming come over to our hospital tomorrow morning, come to our program to find me. Okay? We don't...right now I'm taking a break. That...I can't explain clearly to you at this moment. Let's talk about it tomorrow while at work. All right?

Investigator: Then, where's your work location? Where can I find you, in the Inpatient Service Section or in the Outpatient Clinic?

Doctor Li: You can come to either the Outpatient Clinic or the Inpatient Service Section. I'll be in the Inpatient Service Section tomorrow. Just come over there and find me.

Investigator: Sure. I mean, as I just told you, I'll have to arrange a few things at home before I get ready for coming over.

Doctor Li: How did you get my phone number?

Investigator: A friend of mine recommended you at the beginning. He said that you performed an operation for him. Very successful. He said he used a practitioner's—a Falun Gong practitioner's organ. Very good quality. So, right now, is that kind of organ still available?

Doctor Li: How strange your remarks are! Let's talk tomorrow after you're here. If you want to see a doctor, come to the Inpatient Service Section and find me. Okay?

Investigator: He told me that he got it from you, and that it wasn't called illegal. He meant that...anyway many, many people used that. He got extremely good results. So, we went out of the way to reach out to you. So, in that case, we'll come over tomorrow and talk to you in person. Alright?
