Summary

1. I work at the Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University.
2. Now no longer performing transplant operations at the Armed Police General Hospital, I've already left that Hospital.
3. You can't make calls (to us) from overseas. (Investigator: you didn't pick up the phone when I called you?) Yes!
4. We won't answer any calls from the Internet, Falun Gong, or abroad.
5. You can only find me on Mondays.
6. When you come over here, we will help you get it resolved as quickly as possible (referring to a liver donor).
7. Well, I'm not sure about its timing, which is by no means certain. It may be very fast.

Translation

Investigator: Hello! Is this Dr. Zang? Dr. Zang Yunjin?

Zang Yunjin: Hello!

Investigator: Hi, Hello! I've been looking for you for so long, because my husband's got a liver tumor and his current condition is very urgent. Doctor, we're now at Tianjin People's Hospital, and our doctor recommended that the sooner he gets his liver transplant done, the better. Then one of our former classmates told me to contact you, saying that you're very good at it (liver transplantation). Where are you now?

Zang Yunjin: I'm in Qingdao right now. Where are you? What's your situation?

Investigator: My husband has a liver tumor (Zang Yunjin: ah), (is hospitalized) at Tianjin People's Hospital. Since he (our former classmate) said that you were in Beijing, we actually went to Beijing for you, only to find that you no longer worked there. You don't do it in Beijing any more now, do you?

Zang Yunjin: No, I don't.

Investigator: Oh, could you be invited to come to Beijing to do it (the transplant surgery)?

Zang Yunjin: Invite me to Beijing to do it?

Investigator: Ah?

Zang Yunjin: Ask me to come to Beijing to do it?

Investigator: Yes, is that okay?

Zang Yunjin: Which hospital are you in?

Investigator: We're still in Tianjin People's Hospital, where I was already told that we could transfer to either Chaoyang Hospital or Youan Hospital in Beijing. My former classmate also said that both hospitals are good at it (, but it would be best to ask you to do it there for us.

Zang Yunjin: Ask me to do it there? Who said that? Hahaha...

Investigator: Because my former classmate...

Zang Yunjin: You'd like to transfer to (Beijing) You'an Hospital?

Investigator: As my former classmate just told me today, you had previously done it for the father of one of his former classmates.

Zang Yunjin: Really! Where's that patient now? Let's see if it can be done, and...

Investigator: The patient (my husband) is suitable for the surgery. My former classmate said that you can get it (done very quickly because of your good connections, so I've been anxiously looking for you. I've searched online for your phone number, and called you several times.

Zang Yunjin: You can't get through by calling from abroad!

Investigator: Oh, one cannot get through? Well, when I did get through, you didn't pick it up.

Zang Yunjin: You're right.

Investigator: Now what I'm saying is, regarding my current situation, how can I meet with you in person?

Zang Yunjin: You can come see me in Qingdao on Monday.

Investigator: Qingdao? Well, which hospital is it in Qingdao?

Zang Yunjin: It's the Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University.

Investigator: Oh, the affiliated hospital of Qingdao University. So what time would be good to see you when I come over? Where can I find you, at your outpatient clinic or your inpatient services unit?

Zang Yunjin: Send me a text, and I'll send you back the address.

Investigator: Oh, just use this (number)?

Zang Yunjin: Yeah, text me using this number, and I'll send the address back to you.

Investigator: Oh, It sounds good. So, approximately how much time would be needed before you could help get it done for my husband?

Zang Yunjin: Come over here, so I'll have to see if it's doable.

Investigator: I'd like to get it done quickly. I'm afraid he cannot afford having it delayed any further. Do you understand?

Zang Yunjin: Okay, that's fine.

Investigator: But how long do you think it would take to find an organ for his blood type A, based on your experience? Can it be found in three or four days?

Zang Yunjin: How long?

Investigator: In three to four days, or within a week, can a liver source be found? Can the surgery be arranged within that time frame?

Zang Yunjin: It would be too tight to have just three or four days, wouldn't it? We could even hardly get all the tests done by then!

Investigator: We've got the whole set of the tests done already. I bring over his files, and you'll see what I mean when you take a look at them. He is done with all the tests, and only needs a liver source from you.

Zang Yunjin: Well, it won't be that fast, since we've got nothing prepared for him now. He'll have to have an organ donor. He must wait for it.

Investigator: If you can get it done fast, if you really have the time available, I certainly would like you to be his surgeon, since your skills are well recognized, you know?

Zang Yunjin: Well, I'm not sure about its timing, which is by no means certain. It may be fast, or it may require waiting. Anyway, you'll have to pick a suitable one.

Investigator: (We) must pick an appropriate one, a better one, right?

Zang Yunjin: Let's talk about that when you come over here on Monday!

Investigator: Let's wait till Monday! You'll be there available in Qingdao all day on Monday, right?

Zang Yunjin: Yes, I'll be here all day on Monday.

Investigator: On Monday--today is Wednesday, well, we still have several days left.

Zang Yunjin: Today is Friday already. (Checking his calendar: Friday, June 28, 2019)

Investigator: Friday, so it's Friday, and we still have Saturday, Sunday, with three more days, right?

Zang Yunjin: Yes, but you won't be able to find it in one day today, will you?

Investigator: So, do you do (organ transplants) basically every day?

Zang Yunjin: Just on Mondays. (I'm not sure whether I'll be in Qingdao for other week days)

Investigator: It's only on Mondays for you to do it, right? You do it once a week on Mondays, right?

Zang Yunjin: I'm available all day on Mondays, yes, you (always) can find me on Mondays.

Investigator: You're there in Qingdao on Mondays, but not on Tuesdays, right?

Zang Yunjin: That's right, you'll have to contact me first if it's for Tuesdays, okay?

Investigator: So by then, you can be reached only by phone, your cell phone. Well, please do answer the phone call from us then!

Zang Yunjin: Where are you calling from?

Investigator: I'm calling from online, so to save money! At 80 yuan a month, I can call any place, from anywhere, and at any time.

Zang Yunjin: Are you calling domestically or from abroad?

Investigator: Zhejiang...Zhejiang...I'm from Zhejiang. You can tell from my accent that I'm from Zhejiang.

Zang Yunjin: (You're) from Zhejiang, I see.

Investigator: Yes! My husband's been doing his business in Tianjin! That is, he stays in Tianjin himself. But my own company and business are in Zhejiang, so after I got my own things taken care of back there, I've come over here, you know?

Zang Yunjin: Okay. But you're calling using the Internet today. We won't answer Internet calls because such calls now are all from overseas Falun Gong people and whatnot. We won't answer any calls from abroad.

Investigator: Oh, is that so?

Zang Yunjin: Yes, exactly. Upon getting through, those people just keep on talking and talking to us for a long time.

Investigator: Oh, I see. All in all, we just hope that you can help him to get it done. Let me tell you now, before we come over on Monday, please keep an eye on your liver sources for blood type A for him, okay? Then...

Zang Yunjin: When you come over here, we will try to find a solution for you as quickly as possible!

Investigator: Okay, you'll help us figure it out, won't you? That's great! I'll leave it all up to you to take care of him. Well, regarding his surgery, how's your liver sources look like? Can you get a good one for him? What kind of organs will it be? How much will it cost approximately?

Zang Yunjin: Let's wait till you come over, (we'll) see what's his situation then.

Investigator: Good! I'll leave it all to you. Okay?

Zang Yunjin: Send me a text message and tell him not to use this phone from online!

Investigator: Instead of calling from online, (we'll) use the cell phone, right?

Zang Yunjin: Yes, yes. I thought you were (calling) from abroad.

Investigator: Oh, it appeared that way, didn't it? It showed as if it came from abroad, right?

Zang Yunjin: Yes, because we won't answer any calls from overseas.

Investigator: Okay, now I know. I'll contact you via cell phone then, and thank you for all your help in advance.

Zang Yunjin: Okay, alright. You send me a text message, and we'll help you figure it out.

Investigator: Well, according to my former classmate, you generally work at the Beijing Armed Police General Hospital, right? You usually work at the Beijing Armed Police General Hospital, don't you?

Zang Yunjin: No, I no longer do that at the Armed Police General Hospital now, and I've already left that Hospital.

Investigator: Oh! You're no longer with the Armed Police General Hospital. You're basically in Qingdao now, right?

Zang Yunjin: Right, that's right.

Investigator: Oh, okay, okay. Thank you, Dr. Zang. I will contact you again then.

Zang Yunjin: Okay, okay.

Investigator: Okay, alright, thank you. Bye.
