#### Summary

1. Tomorrow morning, you may bring his file to see me at our hospital outpatient clinic—the 10th clinic, in the surgical section on the 4th floor.
2. If he's lucky, he can have it done upon his admission here.
3. We did over 100 cases last year.
4. We have a shortage of beds sometimes.

#### Translation

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Hello?

Investigator: Hey, hello! Is this Dr. Yuan Wenyong? Hello, Dr. Yuan! I'd like to ask you about that...

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Who is this?

Investigator: Oh, this is Ms. Zhao. My brother-in-law, he needs a liver transplant. I'd like to ask you a question: how soon would it (a liver donor) become available if we get registered on your waiting list at Zhongnan Hospital of Wuhan University?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: I cannot guarantee you when there will be a donor available.

Investigator: Is that so?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: What's your relative's... What's his blood type?

Investigator: He has advanced cirrhosis. His blood type is B.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Blood type B.

Investigator: Yes.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Is he suffering from very serious anemia now?

Investigator: Well, all his tests are done with his case, and as to what our doctor over there should provide us...I don't quite understand.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Does he have any (liver) exhaustion?

Investigator: I don't know what's meant by that, but was only told that it's late stage cirrhosis.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Well, here's what you can do: you can bring his files to the outpatient clinic tomorrow morning, and come see me here on the 4th floor.

Investigator: Uh, let me write it down—I need to bring his files, right? It's okay to just bring his files, and he as a patient doesn't need to come first, correct?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Yes, that's right. Bring his files, the files, and come to the outpatient clinic on the 4th floor.

Investigator: At the outpatient clinic?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: At the surgical clinic section.

Investigator: What section at the clinic on the 4th floor?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: It's the surgical clinic section.

Investigator: The surgical section.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Clinic No. 10.

Investigator: Clinic No. 10.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: In the clinic room.

Investigator: So, it would be okay to just come look for you, Doctor Yuan.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Yes.

Investigator: Okay, I'd like to ask...

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Come see me at the outpatient clinic.

Investigator: Based on your experience, for example, if all matching tests go well, what does it mean that we have to wait for that so-called tissue typing?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Sometimes the wait is very short, but sometimes it's very long, okay?

Investigator: Some (cases) are very quick, while some other cases are very slow, right?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Right, that's right.

Investigator: If it's fast, can it (the surgery) be done in a week or two? If so, I would have to come all the way from Shenyang, along with the folks from my hometown.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Well, I can't guarantee that.

Investigator: Ah, so, how long would it take in the fastest case at your hospital? If one gets lucky...with good luck?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: He could get it done as soon as he's admitted here.

Investigator: Ah, he can have it done upon his admission. Ah, so you've experienced no issues, right?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Ah, right, we're fairly experienced!

Investigator: Ah, about how many cases can you do in a year, say, in the range of 100 or 200? So, that's no problem?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: We did over 100 cases last year.

Investigator: Ah, you did more than 100 cases last year.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Yes, more than 100 cases, okay?

Investigator: Ah, that's fine, fine.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Come over here tomorrow morning.

Investigator: If he needs to get admitted into the hospital, it would be all okay to find a bed. He doesn't need to get in the queue, then, there would be no need...

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: But sometimes...sometimes there's a shortage of beds here as well.

Investigator: Sometimes you have a shortage of beds. When that happens, do I still need to go about it through any connections myself?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: That's not necessary, not at all.

Investigator: So, just let your hospital make all the arrangements?

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: Yes, ah, ah.

Investigator: Okay, thank you Doctor Yuan, and I will come look for you then.

Doctor Yuan Wenyong: No problem.

Investigator: Alright, thank you, bye.
