**Subject(s):** Doctor Xu, Kidney Transplant, the First People's Hospital, Changde, Hunan Province

#### Summary

1. The patient himself/herself needs to come to the hospital for the registration and a face-to-face meeting with the transplant doctors.
2. "Some (patients) waited for a week to have their surgeries done, and it's possible for some to wait for a year or two."
3. "You should prepare about 300,000 yuan (for the surgery), if everything goes smoothly."
4. The hospital does 60 to 70 kidney transplants each year.
5. Director Zhu Huachen is one of the surgeons.
6. Investigator: "So, are they young (kidney sources) or what? I want a good one!"  
Dr. Xu: "All kinds are available. But I can't tell you. Ah, we will talk later. Don't talk too much, okay?"
7. When being asked whether there were any Falun Gong practitioners' organs, Dr. Xu first answered no, but then he agreed to "talk about it" when the patient comes.

#### Translation

Investigator: Hello?

Nurse: Hello.

Investigator: Hi, how are you?

Nurse: Hey, how are you?

Investigator: Hello, greetings. Is this Kidney Transplant at the First People's Hospital of Changde City?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Hi. Here's my situation. My husband wants to do a kidney transplant. My friend recommended your doctors Zhu Huachen and Zheng Zhimin to us and said that both could perform surgeries well. I want to ask that if I come over to your hospital for the surgery, when can I find these two doctors?

Nurse: Okay, I see that you are looking for these two doctors. But we don't have (the specific time for you).

Investigator: The other doctors are okay, too. I want to ask and consult with them first.

Dr. Xu: Hello?

Investigator: Yes, hello, doctor. Here's my case. My friend recommended That I come here. My husband is in a very critical condition, and he needs a kidney transplant. We have been waiting (for a kidney source) for more than half a month, but nothing showed up. Since my friend told me that your hospital could do it much sooner, I want to get onto your waiting list. In that case, shall I bring the patient, my husband, to you first, or shall I bring his files for you to take a look?

Dr. Xu: Where are you from?

Investigator: I'm from Zhejiang Province, but my husband now stays in a hospital close to your hospital. I think the name is Yiyang Hospital.

Dr. Xu: What hospital? What hospital? Yiyang?

Investigator: Yiyang, Yiyang Hospital. Yes, that's the name.

Dr. Xu: Then you can tell your husband to come over by himself, when he's ready.

Investigator: Oh, is that so? I want to know about something first. Should I arrange the surgery for him first? Because I don't know how long it takes you to arrange it. How about within half a month?

Dr. Xu: That depends. We are talking about fortune here. Some waited for a week to have their surgeries done, and it's possible for some to wait for a year or two.

Investigator: Right, I know. I just want it to be fast.

Dr. Xu: If your husband is still healthy enough, he can come over by himself. You don't

need to come here.

Investigator: So, I want to know how long approximately the wait time is.

Dr Xu: I cannot guarantee anything for that kind of things.

Investigator: Oh, you mean that it's purely by chance. And it will only take a few days, if we are lucky, correct?

Dr. Xu: Yeah. If I have a kidney that matches with that of your husband right now, then it would be us waiting for you. If I don't have it, then you have to keep waiting. Just tell your husband to come over and register, okay?

Investigator: Also, since my friend mentioned that your hospital does a good job, I wonder how many transplants you do each year.

Dr. Xu: About 60 to 70 cases.

Investigator: 60 to 70 cases, right? So, which doctor should I look for? My friend told me to look for Zhu Huachen.

Dr. Xu: Look for Director Zhu then.

Investigator: Shall I look for Director Zhu Huachen?

Dr. Xu: Right, right.

Investigator: Okay then, thank you. So, if there is an organ available, how much do I need to prepare? I just want to confirm again. Roughly how much in total?

Dr. Xu: You should prepare about 300,000 yuan.

Investigator: About 300,000 yuan. Are the medical fees included?

Dr. Xu: Yes, if everything goes smoothly.

Investigator: Money is not an issue, since we have a business. I also want to ask that if I pay a bit more, am I able to select a kidney source and quality? How about young ones? Can I make a selection?

Dr. Xu: There's nothing to choose, okay?

Investigator: Nothing to choose?

Dr. Xu: What we can give you are all qualified (for organ transplant), do you hear me?

Investigator: So, are they young or what? I want a good one!

Dr. Xu: All kinds are available. But I can't tell you. Ah, we will talk later. Don't talk too much, okay?

Investigator: One more thing. My friend told me about another key point. Does the kidney donor's (kidney excision) take place at the same time as the kidney transplant surgery, or do you excise the external kidney source first and then bring it into your hospital for the surgery? I think that simultaneous surgeries would be better. How do you operate there?

Dr. Xu: I don't understand what you mean. Let's talk about that when you come, okay? Bring the files for registration, then I'll tell you, alright?

Investigator: I see. My friend mentioned that his father got (an organ) from a sort of practitioner. He said that the organs from Falun Gong practitioners are of good quality. Do you have such organs?

Dr. Xu: No, no, no, no!

Investigator: I see. So, we'll talk about that when I come, okay?

Dr. Xu: Yeah, yeah, yeah.

Investigator: Oh, thank you then. What's your surname, please? It'd be better if I can find you!

Dr. Xu: My last name is Xu. But don't mind me. You don't need to find me. Any doctor can help you, okay?

Investigator: Okay, thanks. X-U, Xu, right? Thank you!
