Summery

1. There is always a shortage of beds here at our inpatient service.
2. We have a dedicated secretary in charge of kidney transplants.
3. If there are donors like this, then you can make a contact, and see if a matching organ can be found.
4. We do three or four cases of kidney transplants in one month.
5. If you want a kidney transplant, you can make an appointment and consult with our Director Yang Li at his kidney transplant specialist outpatient clinic, on Wednesday afternoons.

Translation

Nurse: How are you? Urology Section One.

Investigator: Hi, how are you? Is this Kidney Transplant, Lanzhou University Second Hospital?

Nurse: Ah, right.

Investigator: Here's the situation. One of our relatives is suffering from advanced diabetes. So his doctor suggested that he get a kidney transplant as soon as possible, but their hospital does not have the qualifications. So the doctor recommended your hospital since you have done quite a lot with a lot of experience. So, I'd like to ask, is there a shortage of beds now at your hospital?

Nurse: Well, there is always a shortage of beds here at our inpatient service. Are you...are you asking a relative to donate the kidney?

Investigator: Um, no, none of our relatives would donate it.

Nurse: You might have to go to the clinic to consult the director who specializes in kidney transplantation (Investigator: Ah). We have a dedicated secretary in charge of kidney transplants. You can go ask him for a consultation.

Investigator: Oh, then I...

Nurse: There are cases where people are willing to donate. If there are donors like this, then you can make a contact, and see if a matching organ can be found. Only with a matching organ can the surgery be done. If you want to consult in detail, you just go to the outpatient clinic and ask for our director. We have an outpatient clinic specializing in kidney transplantation. Director Yang will be there every Wednesday afternoon, and you can make an appointment to consult with him.

Investigator: So what's the last name of the director who does the surgeries? Could you tell me his name?

Nurse: Yang Li, Director Yang, Yang Li. He comes to the outpatient clinic every Wednesday afternoon, okay?

Investigator: Wednesday afternoon, let me take a note. An appointment for Wednesday afternoon...

Nurse: You can come to the kidney transplant clinic on Wednesdays. He works at the specialist kidney transplant clinic on Wednesdays.

Investigator: I'm wondering...let's say, for example, you do three or five cases a month, and how many patients are on the waiting list? I will have a general idea, for example, how long does the relative have to wait, you know? So on average fewer than five cases are done in a month?

Nurse: Um.

Investigator: That's to say, three or five cases in a month?

Nurse: Ah.

Investigator: Well, then I will keep looking for more information, let me think about it, okay?

Nurse: Ah, if you want a kidney transplant, you can make an appointment and consult with our Director Yang Li at his kidney transplant specialist outpatient clinic, on Wednesday afternoons.

Investigator: Ah, okay. Thank you!

Nurse: Okay, good bye!
