Summary

1. Usually it cannot be done within one or half a month. The longest wait time is half a year to a year.
2. Now there are no longer those organs taken from the executed, and they are all from donations.
3. Here in our center, the surgeries are all done by Director Dong. He comes to his clinic on Wednesdays.
4. We did over 200 cases the year before last, and did over 200 cases last year. The transplant volumes are about the same every year.

Translation

Nurse: Hey, hello! This is Kidney Transplant.

Investigator: Hey, hello! Is this Kidney Transplant at the Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University? This is Ms. Zhao. One of my relatives needs to have a kidney transplant. I'd like to ask, should the patient come directly, or shall I bring over his medical records or his files first? He's now done with his tissue typing and everything else...that is, we've been queueing... queueing in several hospitals. This is our situation. How would you like us to come?

Nurse: Let me ask. Hold on.

Investigator: Okay, thank you!

(Waiting for the nurse to get back)

Nurse: Hello? Our doctor requires that the patient come over, with all his test reports. We'll have to take a look at them.

Investigator: Ah, sure. Then I'd like to ask again, let's say, if it goes well, can it be done within one month or half a month?

Nurse: Usually it cannot be done that soon.

Investigator: Approximately how long will it take if it goes well?

Nurse: Now all patients have to wait half a year to a year.

Investigator: Ah, okay. Can you refer a doctor to me? That is, one with better skills?

Nurse: The surgeries here are all done by Director Dong.

Investigator: Ah, they're all done by Director Dong.

Nurse: Right. Director Dong is available at the outpatient clinic every Wednesday afternoon.

Investigator: So Director Dong's skills are the best. Well, how many cases can he do in a month?

Nurse: We did more than 200 cases two years ago.

Investigator: Ah, more than 200 the year before last. What about last year then?

Nurse: Over 200 last year.

Investigator: Ah, it's over 200 every year. What about this year? So, it's increasing every year, isn't it?

Nurse: No. It's about the same every year. This year we haven't quite done 200 cases yet...until now.

Investigator: Oh, oh. It's always Director Dong who does the surgeries as the lead surgeon, isn't it?

Nurse: Yes, yes, yes.

Investigator: That's good. So what's the name of Director Dong?

Nurse: Dong Zhen.

Investigator: Ah, which Zhen?

Nurse: It is the one as in “DiZhen” (for earthquake).

Investigator: Then I’d like to ask, approximately, how much does it cost to have a kidney transplant?

Nurse: Regarding that...you should discuss it face-to-face when the time comes, okay? When you come, you’ll talk with Director Dong in person.

Investigator: Oh. I just want a healthy one, that is, because some are from those that had car accidents, or got executed. Anyway, I only heard those things.

Nurse: No, no. Now they are all from donations, and none from those that got executed. If you come to register, you just come to make an appointment with Director Dong at the outpatient clinic. First get registered to get on the waiting list, that’s it. Right now there are hundreds of patients having been waiting here in the queue.

Investigator: Ah, okay. Thank you!

Nurse: Yeah, you’re welcome. Bye!

Investigator: Bye!
