#### Translation

Investigator: Hi, hello! Excuse me, is this Doctor Hu at the Hepatobiliary Surgery of Anhui Provincial Hospital? Is this Doctor Hu Hejie?

Director Hu: Ah.

Investigator: Oh?

Director Hu: Yes, this is he.

Investigator: Hello, good evening! Here is my situation. As one of my relatives is here with us, he lately was diagnosed with...

Director Hu: He needs to get a transplant, right?

Investigator: Right, but how did you know?

Director Hu: Ah.

Investigator: I haven't explained yet.

Director Hu: I knew as you called. I stopped doing that a long time ago.

Investigator: Oh, but why?

Director Hu: I quit it a long time ago, as I switched to a different field.

Investigator: Oh, you are no longer in Hepatobiliary Surgery?

Director Hu: Right, I stopped that job a long time back! I moved out of the transplant center a long time ago!

Investigator: Now you?

Director Hu: You're calling a wrong person.

Investigator: Well, may I ask you to recommend a doctor for me?

Director Hu: Now...?

Investigator: Who is doing it?

Director Hu: His name is Nashan.

Investigator: Nashan?

Director Hu: He's a German professor, one from Germany.

Investigator: He's from Germany. When is he in the hospital?

Director Hu: He is in every day! In the hospital every day.

Investigator: He is in the hospital. He works at the Main Division or the South Division?

Director Hu: At South Division.

Investigator: At South Division...?

Director Hu: Yes.

Investigator: He is there at South Division every day, so one can come to make an appointment with him at the clinic, right?

Director Hu: Yes, that's right.

Investigator: When I called earlier today, the person at the office told me to talk to Doctor Liu, President Liu Lianxing at the South Division.

Director Hu: That will do too.

Investigator: That will work too?

Director Hu: Ah, yes.

Investigator: Well...

Director Hu: Bring the patient to the clinic.

Investigator: Okay, well, could you do me a favor, Doctor Hu? Could you tell me President Liu's phone number? My case is urgent.

Director Hu: I don't have his number.

Investigator: Yeah, I called the South Division, but nobody answered the call. I'm tied up and can't go there in person. I would like to ask some questions first.

Director Hu: I...

Investigator: Afterwards I will go there directly.

Director Hu: Okay. As he is new in our hospital, I don't have his phone number.

Investigator: President Liu is new there? Only he and Nanshan, the German? Nobody else can do it? Only these two can do liver transplants? Anyone else?

Director Hu: Right, right.

Investigator: Just two of them.

Director Hu: Nobody else.

Investigator: Oh.

Director Hu: Right.

Investigator: How many cases can be done a year at your hospital? How many per year?

Director Hu: That I don't know. How would I know?

Investigator: You're not sure about that?

Director Hu: I'm no longer involved in it, so I don't know any more.

Investigator: You used to do it? I am very grateful that we can speak over the phone.

Director Hu: I'm no longer with them. I quit doing it a long time ago, at least ten years ago!

Investigator: Oh...you changed your career and started your own business, right?

Director Hu: No, I'm still a doctor, but not as a transplant surgeon.

Investigator: Oh, you no longer do transplants, but you did them at your hospital back then, right?

Director Hu: Exactly!

Investigator: Oh, as my neighbor told me, there was a doctor named Xu Geliang back then.

Director Hu: Oh?

Investigator: Oh?

Director Hu: He is retired, a retiree now.

Investigator: Okay, okay, because my neighbor's father got it done by Xu Geliang, but he is gone.

Director Hu: Oh, I see.

Investigator: When you were there...let me ask...when you were doing that in the hospital, was a liver transplant performed with both sides done at the same time—the patient was on one side and on the other side...could you tell me about that?

Director Hu: If you...if you want to get a liver transplant, just go to either of them, okay? Stop asking about those other things. I cannot...I cannot tell you so many things, alright?

Investigator: If you could tell me, I would understand it a lot better. Because I...

Director Hu: I no longer keep up with it.

Investigator: Got through this call...

Director Hu: Because I haven't been doing that for a long time, I no longer have the information. Alright?

Investigator: Could you give me a phone number? Do you have the phone number for someone at the South Division?
