4. Investigator: Does Wen Hao do the surgeries every day?  
Nurse: Yes.

**Translation**

Nurse: Hello.

Investigator: Hello, hi!

Nurse: Hello, hi!

Investigator: Hey. Hello there. Is this the Nurses' Station of Liver Transplant at the First Affiliated Hospital of Xinjiang Medical University?

Nurse: Yes, yes.

Investigator: Hey. Hello there. I'm from Shenyang, Liaoning Province. One of my relatives needs a liver transplant.

Nurse: Umm, you'll have to wait, depending on your luck. It only works when you could get the tissue typing done successfully. Or you may want to call the Doctors' Office, where there are doctors specifically in charge of this area. I give you the phone number and you can call that number to ask.

Investigator: Ah, go ahead.

Nurse: Umm, 436, and the area code is 0991. Ah, it's 436.

Investigator: 436.

Nurse: 4529.

Investigator: It's 4364529.

Nurse: Umm, our program is called Liver Transplant Endoscopic Surgery.

Investigator: Ah.

Nurse: We have a dedicated team of doctors in charge of this area over here. Except for this team of doctors, other doctors won't accept you.

Investigator: Umm, which team? You call it a team, right?

Nurse: Ah, right, it's called a team. Yes, you got it.

Investigator: Ah, is the president in charge of that team? Is the team led by President Wen Hao?

Nurse: Ah, yes.

Investigator: Ah, so, that....

Nurse: Then mainly it's our director in charge, okay?

Investigator: Well, let's say, is there a shortage of your beds now?

Nurse: Ah, let's talk about that later when the time comes. If it's really urgent, umm, if a surgery is needed, we'll definitely resolve these issues.

Investigator: So you're a tertiary level-A hospital, right?

Nurse: Ah, yes. We're the largest hospital in Xinjiang.

Investigator: That, that person...does Wen Hao go to that...does he go to his clinic every day? Does he do that every day?

Nurse: Umm, you mean performing the surgeries, right?

Investigator: Ah, right, that's what I mean.

Nurse: Ah, yes.

Investigator: So, he can do it everyday. That's good.

Nurse: Umm.

Investigator: As we're in trading business, money is no problem, no issue. What matters is the surgeon's skills.

Nurse: Ah.

Investigator: If he does that every day or based on the number of cases he does annually, we can tell if there are any issues with his technical skills.

Nurse: Hey. That is right.

Investigator: Anyway I've seen that he has a pretty good profile on the website. He daily can do...

Nurse: Ah, yes. Our technique here is pretty matured as well.

Investigator: Ah, the wait time won't be too long, right? Is the liver organ supply sufficient?

Nurse: Hum. You still need to ask the doctor about that.

Investigator: Ah. Ah. Ah. All right....

Nurse: Okay, call that number to check that out.

Investigator: All right. Thank you very much.

Nurse: Ah, not at all. Okay, bye!

Investigator: Good bye!
