Investigator: Could you please find me a doctor? My husband needs a kidney transplant, and he is currently at the Chinese Medical Hospital---the local one. I think your hospital is better, so I would like to get him transferred, could you please recommend a doctor?

Director Wu: Please call the operator at 2870303 and ask for transplants.

Investigator: Then what is the specialty of your office?

Director Wu: We are medical management and are not involved in these matters.

Investigator: Oh, medical management. So, you don't know transplants and aren't involved in that, is that right?

Director Wu: doctors from that division are providing the consultations. we handle matters in the hospital.

Investigator: Oh, my classmate told me to go to medical office, saying that I may get helped there...

Director Wu: You may come to the hospital directly, then make an appointment for a transplant and ask for consultation at the Transplant Outpatient Clinic.

Investigator: One of my friends recommended this hospital to me. He works at the Chinese People's Liberation Army No. 303 Hospital.

Director Wu: A reorganization is going on and it's now called Hospital #923 Hospital.

Investigator: Uh, Hospital #923?

Director Wu: There is a new, unified naming system, so it was renamed Hospital #923.

Investigator: Oh, I see, could you please recommend a good doctor for me, who is better for kidney transplant?

Director Wu: Please go see a doctor and he can explain to you, mhm.

Investigator: My classmate told me that kidney sources in Liberation Army are quite plentiful, so it should be relatively quite quick, so...

Director Wu: Not exactly, we can only say that we have done relatively a little bit more, the entire donation system here is more sophisticated.

Investigator: Oh.

Director Wu: Just a little more individual surgery, you know?

Investigator: Alright, my classmate said so, you have more experience and have a longer history. you have done these over a dozen of years and much more each year as well, he also...

Director Wu: Much more. Specifically, for your case, which doctor in transplant in Hospital 303 you need to talk to, could you please ask a doctor-on-duty to explain to you?

Investigator: Uh, no, I know you are the director.

Director Wu: I can give some suggestions. It mainly depends on your luck. I would suggest you to visit more hospitals and get registered in line.

Investigator: Mhm.

Director Wu: This way you can have a better chance.

Investigator: I was told that his father got the surgery done in a month. It is quicker in your hospital, so...

Director Wu: That is his luck, he was just very lucky! It's just that.

Investigator: Is that right? Do you do surgeries every day?

Director Wu: Oh, we have done less recently.

Investigator: Ah these surgeries usually are carried on daily, right?

Director Wu: It cannot be done every day. These things (organs), were donated, you can have surgery once you have a donation. The key issue here is the kidney source, am I making myself clear?

Investigator: Ah, that kidney source?

Director Wu: You got it? Good, alright.

Investigator: Is there a shortage of kidney sources?

Director Wu: No, there isn't. But we don't have any currently.
