



Dr. Song Jiyong With Liver Transplantation, 309 Hospital of PLA (Part I)

Highlights

1. We are still doing it. The policy has been adjusted and there are fewer liver sources. Where it takes longer, the wait time could be quite a few months.
2. We've just done a type-B patient, who had waited for one month.

In cases where the wait time was short, it could be done on the same day as the patient arrived. There were many such cases. But now it's different...

Content of Investigative Recording

Song Jiyong: Donor sources.

Investigator: Donor sources. There's also the General Hospital of the Armed Police. It did it pretty well too, pretty good and fast. I used to have an acquaintance there. It could be completed in just four days.



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Song Jiyong: In the past, like I said, in the past~

Investigator: It was different in the past, right? It doesn't work now.

Song Jiyong: It was pretty much the same with us here before. In cases where it took longer, the wait time were two to three weeks. Three weeks would be the most.
