Summary

There were 167 kidney transplants, 35 liver transplants and more than 200 liver and kidney cases together.

We did the most the year before last year with over 200 cases and less than 200 in other years.

The bed capacity is very tight and the patient can only stay at corridor. There are over 200 beds. Is that too few?
There are 50 beds to accommodate 70 to 80 inpatients.

Donors were brain dead.

The general brain death center is jointly managed by Henan Provincial Red Cross Society and Henan Provincial Department of Health.

The donors are mainly up to the hospitals. It is operated by each hospital.

Translation

Investigator: Hi, hello. Is this Zhengzhou...?

Physician: Hello.

Investigator: Hi. Is this Zhengzhou People's Hospital? Is this Outpatient Clinic? This is my second phone call . I am a physician at Handan hospital in Hebei. I have a patient that needs the kidney transplant. But the beds have been short all the time. Is there any bed available here now? Can the patient get hospitalized?

Physician: You will stay at corridor if you are hospitalized now.

Investigator: Uh. Stay at corridor?

Physician: Yes.

Investigator: So it means there is no bed available in the room, right?

Physician: There should be beds available at corridor.

Investigator: Corridor?

Physician: Yeah.

Investigator: It's going to be Chinese New year. Are there still many patients?

Physician: Uh, there are still quite a lot now.

Investigator: There're still a lot. So about our..

Physician: Uh.



Investigator: The kidney transplants have been done a lot. How many cases did you do last year?

Physician: There were 167 cases last year.

Investigator: It sounds not right. When I called last October, physician Li told me there have been almost 200 cases. How come are there only over one hundred now?

Physician: He might also count liver transplants.

Investigator: Oh. He said there could be 200 to 300 cases a year. Since I am also a physician, he didn't keep secrets from me and told me those stuff.

Physician: It's impossible doing that, impossible.

Investigator: Impossible?

Physician: It's impossible doing that. We did the most the year before last year with over 200 cases and less than 200 in other years.

Investigator: Not over that. So as you said, were the kidney transplants not over 200 last year?

Physician: No. 167 cases were done last year.

Investigator: How about liver?

Physician: 35 liver cases.

Investigator: 35?

Physician: Hum.

Investigator: That sounds too few. Since you are here, many people admire the fame and keep calling to get it done here. How could you do so few?

Physician: Too many people are waiting. So it is done less.

Investigator: So are there too few beds here? Beds should be increased.

Physician: There are more than 200 beds. Is that too few?

Investigator: Oh. 200, it's not few. It's just there're too many patients. Then you have so many patients and capacity is always full. This is my third phone call and can't get in. So you should have done a lot. This...

Physician: It's not done a lot. It's done just a few with too many people waiting. There's no way...

Investigator: But you...

Physician: The longest wait time has been more than one year. As you see, the patients occupied the beds. What else can you do?

Investigator: As you have so many beds and it's always full, there should be a lot of operations. Let's say, all the 200 beds are occupied per month, you can still conduct 200 cases each month...

Physician: It's less than 200, less than 200. Not that many. There are more than 50 bends at that side of the hospital. It probably could accommodate 70 to 80 inpatients.

Investigator: 70 to 80? Not many inpatients.

Physician: Uh.



Investigator: So the liver and kidney (transplants) are in the same inpatient service? Are you a transplant center?

Physician: Yes, it's together.

Investigator: For our operation, where are the donors from? Are they healthy? Or...I don't know your current donors. Where is the primary source of our donors?

Physician: Brain death, brain dead patients.

Investigator: So you said there's a brain death center in Henan, right?

Physician: Yes.

Investigator: I've called several hospitals for my patient. Basically these hospitals in Zhengzhou have done hundreds, hundreds of cases. For so many cases to be done, there may be a brain death center in your area. Did everyone take the organs there?

Physician: It's like this. Henan is divided into several districts. Our hospital is assigned to some districts. The First Affiliated Hospital of Zhengzhou University is assigned to some districts. The First Affiliated Hospital of Henan University of Chinese Medicine is also assigned to some districts. Whenever there're brain dead patients in that district, it will be allocated to the specific hospital in that district. It's like this.

Investigator: Oh. So there is not a general brain death center, right?

Physician: There is a general one. But it's all divided down.

Investigator: Oh, I see. So there's a general brain death center. Is it under Henan Province or under...

Physician: Of course. Henan Provincial Red Cross Society and Henan Provincial Department of Health jointly managed.

Investigator: Oh, there's a brain death center of joint management. So were all brain dead patients concentrated there?

Physician: Oh, no, no. There's just a general brain death center. But the practical operation were handed to the lower level to handle.

Investigator: Oh, handed to lower level. This brain death center, Since you have so many donors and so many operations in each hospital., I felt there must be something like a brain death center or donor bank here. The donors are surely more than other provinces.

Physician: No, no, no. It's not. It is mainly operated by each hospital.

Investigator: Operated by each hospital?

Physician: Uh.

Investigator: Oh, so the Red Cross..

Physician: They allocate some hospitals to you. Then your Henan hospitals touch base and then go to take it whenever there's such a patient. It's just keep more contact.

Investigator: Well, sounds good. Then my patient just keeps waiting.

Physician: All right.

Investigator: I will see if he's willing to stay at the corridor.



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Physician: All right.

Investigator: All right.

Physician: All right then. Take care.
