Phone Investigation Recording:

Doctor: Hello.

Investigator: Hi, hello, is that the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhengzhou University? Hey! Is Dr. Yang there? Is

Dr. Yang Han there?

Doctor: Dr. Yang Han is not here today.

Investigator: Not available?

Doctor: Ah, are you looking for him?

Investigator: Yes, I want to ask him something, about how long (a patient) needs to wait for a liver transplant.

Doctor: Ah~ this, this needs to have a liver source.

Investigator: Like in your hospital, did you do over 1,000 such liver transplants last year?

Doctor: Ah~ might not have reached 1,000, but several hundreds. This technology (of ours) is mature.

Investigator: Technology?

Doctor: The technology has absolutely no problem. The key is the liver source, you know.

Investigator: Which doctor or director usually does it?

Doctor: Ah, Dr. Yang is very clear about that. You can ask Dr. Yang, he knows it very well. He is in charge of this.

Investigator: Oh, you said that you could do 1,000 cases, do 700 or 800 (cases)? Can be done, right?

Doctor: If you can, you call him again, when you have time. He may be busy right now, with no time to answer

the phone, or what else?

Investigator: He is not in the hospital.

Doctor: Anyway, ask him again.

Investigator: Oh, you are just on duty, right?

Doctor: Yes, yes, yes.

Investigator: Oh, can you tell me about the price of liver transplantation now?

Doctor: Ah, how old is he?

Investigator: He is over 40 years old.

Doctor: Ah, in general, depending on the individual, about 500,000 or 600,000 (yuan) 600,000 or 700,000

Doctor: Generally speaking, we have (donors) aged around 40 or 50. About 40 years old. They are mainly young people.

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Doctor: Right, we don't want those, who are very old, either.

Investigator: You don't want them. Like these 20-something ones, they are very good, they all said that they could find the ones in their 20s.

Doctor: If we can find them, then it's okay. But if not, you won't be able to do (the surgery).

Investigator: Oh, I also want to ask, doctor, since others have told me that there are people who are willing to sell their kidneys and livers. They're relatively young, but they have difficulties at home. In this kind of situation, can your hospital find such donors?

Doctor: This, I have to check. For this specific question, we need to ask Dr. Yang Han.

Investigator: Oh, yes, I just want to ask him if he knows this kind of situation. That is, they personally want to sell their organs.

Doctor: Um, I don't know about this.

Investigator: In your opinion, does your hospital have situations like this?

Doctor: This ~ I really don't know.

Investigator: I have heard from my friend that if there is this situation, he'd like to contact you doctors. He can

pay more money. So if we make such a request, you can do that, right?

Doctor: Oh~ I really don't know about this.

Investigator: Ok.

Doctor: You can keep calling, because sometimes they will not pick up calls from unknown callers, while being

busy. Well, you can call again afternoon or tomorrow. OK, ok?

Investigator: But, is this Dr. Yang the director? Or...

Doctor: No.

Investigator: No?

Doctor: He is responsible for this. The director does your surgery.

Investigator: Oh, thank you, goodbye.
