Recording content:

Investigator: Hello?

Nurse: Hello.

Investigator: Hey, hello, are you the information office of the PLA No. 302 Hospital?

Nurse: Hello, who is this?

Investigator: I am a doctor from the Handan City Hospital in Hebei Province. I have a patient who wants to do liver transplantation. I would like to ask if your hospital still does it? Because your hospital is doing very well! so I...

Nurse: Ah, you~

Investigator: Go ahead, go ahead.

Nurse: Do you have any questions? Could you wait a moment? I'm busy here.

Investigator: Oh!

Nurse: Or, you...?

Investigator: Oh, I'll be brief, that is, your hospital is still doing liver transplant, right?

Nurse: Yes, yes!



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Investigator: So you still do it! I wanted to know, roughly how long does a patient have to wait before he can have the surgery?

Nurse: Two to three months.

Investigator: Uh, are there many people waiting now?

Nurse: Well, it's okay, not too many.

Investigator: Not too many.

Nurse: Because we've been doing a lot recently, right.

Investigator: Oh. Because I have contacted Ma Xiao before, but... I still try to do it through the doctor. She is very busy, and she often goes out, I mean, Ma Xiao.

Nurse: Uh, uh, uh.

Investigator: Are there many liver transplants performed now? This year.

Nurse: Yes, there are many, we have done seven cases a week.

Investigator: Oh, seven cases a week, so this year, you must have done 100 or 200 cases, right?

Nurse: One hundred cases, one hundred.

Investigator: This year, you've done 100! Because last year I called Ma Xiao...

Nurse: Right.

Investigator: In July...at that time...last year and this year...maybe you did more than last year. When I called Ma Xiao last year, he said you did 60 or so cases. You have done more than 100 this year, which is better than last year, right? Is that Professor Liu Zhenwen still in your hospital?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: He's still there, that's good. Is he doing it himself now, I've contacted him, and then I'll tell the patient, and we can go soon. Anyway, you said that it takes one to two months at most. right?

Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Oh. Okay, hello? Your voice is very low, I can't hear you clearly!

Nurse: Go ahead, I'm using the speakerphone because I'm busy, but go on and I'm listening.

Investigator: Well, okay, okay! How many liver transplants did you do last year?



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Nurse: This year?

Investigator: Last year?

Nurse: Last year, not so many last year. But the year before, there should have been about 100 cases.

Investigator: Oh, that's about right, about right. Because Ma Xiao told me in July that there were more than 60 cases done. You said that you have done 100 cases, then you will do more this year. You have already done 100 cases, so this year you will definitely do more.

Nurse: Well, are you calling today to ask about this?

Investigator: I'm not. I'm asking you for some information, and then I'll tell the patient and ask him to come over quickly, so that he'll be waiting on line and be able to do the surgery soon.

Nurse: Oh, just come to this clinic to register, and you can register with the transplant clinic.

Investigator: Did you mean to call Director Liu Zhenwen? What day is he on duty and in the clinic?

Nurse: Tuesday morning.

Investigator: Every day...Tuesday morning, right?

Nurses: Monday and Tuesday mornings.

Investigator: Oh, okay, okay, okay, then thank you, ah, goodbye, ah, okay, goodbye.
