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Content Summary

1. Last year performed 310 cases of liver transplant, this year 14 cases;
2. Live half-liver transplant is possible, but the requirement is strict, don't do many of them;
3. Pretty much is the case with adults with large volume liver, who donates to their own young child;
4. It's not permitted for live organ donation between non-relatives;
5. Chief Guo WenZhi is doing it;
6. Donor organ provided by Red Cross.

Phone Recording

Investigator: Hello! Is this ZhenZhou University 1st Affiliated Hospital?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: I am a doctor from HanDang Hospital. I called at end of last year to send over a patient for liver transplant. I was told you bed space was tight. Is the bed space improved now? Can I send one over to the hospital?

Doctor: Doctor, are you referring to the patient requiring a liver transplant, or patient after transplant already?

Investigator: transplant patient, patient who is needing transplant.

Doctor: Planning for transplant?

Investigator: yes.

Doctor: What's the status of ability for self-care?

Investigator: Eh, self-care ability is OK. He is at the late-stage cirrhosis of liver.

Doctor: Doctor, could you tell which doctor you contacted before? Do you remember the name?

Investigator: I talked on the phone originally with Doctor Shen. Doctor, I would like to ask you, have you started (transplants) this year? In 2018?

Doctor: Yes, we have started.

Investigator: Oh, it has started. Already started in January.

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: Ah, because you have done quite a few last year. It seems according to Doctor Shen from last year phone call, you did more than 200 cases last year.

Doctor: Last year we did more than 310 cases.

Investigator: Three Hundred and ten. I guess when I called it was not quite end of the last year, possibly by then it was over two hundred. Wow, three hundred cases is a lot. Can you say how many cases have been done in January?

Doctor: Did fourteen cases.



Investigator: Oh. That's pretty good. I will talk to the patient. If, OK, I'll ask him to go over there. Because I think maybe last year maybe there were fewer patients at the ward. This way, if there is an opportunity, I'll ask him to go look for Doctor Shen. Is Doctor Shen at work today?

Doctor: No, he is off now.

Investigator: Off now? But he was working today?

Doctor: Oh, yes.

Investigator: Have you done half-liver transplant?

Doctor: Yes, we have.

Investigator: You have? Probably not many for such live donor type? The quantity is few and far in between, right?

Doctor: Because the requirement is quite strict. So very few indeed.

Investigator: Yes, but you still do it, but just few.

Doctor: That's right. Normally it is by the adults with larger liver, who donates to his own young child.

Investigator: Do you have allogeneic donor?

Doctor: If it is between adults, the audit is even more strict.

Investigator: Oh yeah? Then have you done the live donor transplant between adults? For Liver transplant?

Doctor: We have.

Investigator: Oh. You are saying, if the two people not knowing each other?

Doctor: Firmly not allowed. Not allowed between two people of none relationship for live donation.

Investigator: Oh, it's such situation. It's not allowed for two people not knowing each other?

Doctor: That's correct.

Investigator: Ah. So, in case of the whole donation, how is the donor condition in general?

Doctor: Oh. Generally, we provide opportunity for Red Cross to make an inspection of the donated organ, once it passes the condition of the organ donation, then it can be used.

Investigator: I see.

Doctor: So as far as donor organ is concerned, don't worry.

Investigator: I see, not to worry about it. So, the donor organ is provided by the Red Cross, right?

Doctor: Right.

Investigator: OK, ok. How about the operation? Who is performing it?

Doctor: Guo WenZhi.

Investigator: Guo WenZhi. I see, I know about Guo WenZhi. He is pretty famous. Pretty much he is the one doing it then?

Doctor: Yes.



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Investigator: Oh, then we look for you? What's your name?

Doctor: When you come, just come over to our office.

Investigator: OK, alright then.

Doctor: Do you want to know where the office is at?

Investigator: Sure, please let me know.

Doctor: OK. After you enter the Medical School Station, then look for No.2 Patient Ward building, Building 12 north area.

Investigator: No.2, No.2 building, right.

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: Or Building 12?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: OK. Building 12, right?

Doctor: North Area.

Investigator: Oh, North area. How many areas are there? For the liver transplant?

Doctor: Oh, two areas. South area is the Hepatobiliary Type B Surgery Department.

Investigator: Ah. South area is for Hepatobiliary. Is this just for transplants?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: Ah. So, is the 300+ cases for both areas? Or is just for your area only.

Doctor: Only our area does transplants. On the other side is general hepatobiliary problems.

Investigator: Oh, I see. I understand. OK, I will tell him. The phone # is this one, right?

Doctor: Yes.

Investigator: OK, thank you. Sorry for disturbing you.
