China's Organ Transplant Organizations are the Executing Entities for the Communist Party's State Crime of Live Organ Harvesting

Since 1999, led by its then-leader Jiang Zemin, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) criminal group has been manipulating China's entire state apparatus, including the Party, government, military, armed police, judicial system, and medical institutions, through the Political and Legal Affairs Commission and the "610" system, to commit nationwide mass extermination of Falun Dafa practitioners by means of live organ harvesting for transplantation. The CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a crime against humanity and a crime of genocide initiated on the orders of Jiang Zemin.

Since the CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a state genocidal crime conducted as a political campaign, organ transplant institutions in all provinces, central government-controlled municipalities, and autonomous regions of mainland China, including all military, armed police, and local hospitals (medical centers) are suspected to have participated in this crime, even including a considerable number of hospitals unqualified to perform organ transplants, such as small and medium-sized hospitals and specialized hospitals. Similar to how all Chinese hospitals were involved in forced abortions during the CCP's implementation of the "one-child policy", all transplant facilities in China today have participated in live organ harvesting.

In view of the broader context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, those in charge of organ transplant hospitals/centers and similar institutions in China are suspected of having been involved in the crime of live organ harvesting from groups such as Falun Gong practitioners.

Evidence Collection Methods

1. Direct and indirect comprehensive telephone investigation and on-site investigation of the people suspected of involvement in the live organ harvesting

The subjects of our investigations include government officials, policemen, doctors and other medical personnel.

Geographical Distribution of the Subjects of Investigation, and the Duration of Investigations:

The WOIPFG's subjects of investigation are people in different positions, who are located across the entire country of China. Our investigations have been ongoing for nearly two decades, and our investigation results have always been consistent. The evidence gathered by us verifies that live organ harvesting is a systematic arrangement by the CCP.

- 1) Subjects of investigation: Presidents, directors, doctors, nurses, and security guards of organ transplant hospitals.
- 2) Hospitals involved: A considerable amount of recorded evidence has been obtained from many provincial, military, armed police, and local organ transplant hospitals (centers) across China.
- 3) Time span: Our investigations on the live organ harvesting started in 1999, and they're ongoing to this day.

- 1) We have been collecting data from the hospitals' websites and press releases.
- 2) We have been searching for and analyzing medical papers on transplantation.
- 3) We have been using the website www.archive.org to view the hospitals' previously archived information.
- 4) We have been collecting reports from the official Chinese media outlets.
- 5) We have organized all the information obtained from our investigations to create a database of the hospitals.

All the facts have shown us that the CCP is by no means a rational or normal organization or political party; but instead, it is a supra-state criminal syndicate controlled by a group of criminals who have committed crimes against humanity. The CCP's logic of thinking and principles of action are anti-human, and the crimes it has committed are forms of evil that humanity had never seen previously.

WOIPFG's investigative report series contains nearly 70 investigation reports on the alleged organ harvesting of living Falun Gong Practitioners at major Chinese military and civilian hospitals and on their staff members suspected of participation in this crime. This volume contains three such investigation reports.

ForewordThe First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University is a large Grade-A Tertiary General Hospital. Among the various medical programs in the Hospital, organ transplantation is of the foremost importance. President Zheng Shusen and President Wang Weilin, who succeeded him in 2014, are both engaged in organ transplantation. The Hospital carries out multiple types of organ transplantation. The number of organ transplants ranks in the first tier of the nation. The multi-organ combined transplantation project led by Zheng Shusen was listed as a promotional project by the Ministry of Health, and it is also the most

implemented since the launch of combined pancreas-kidney transplantation and liver-kidney transplantation. Zheng Shusen has successively assisted many hospitals in carrying out liver transplantation, including Peking Union Medical College Hospital, Huashan Hospital of Fudan University, Shanghai Xinhua Hospital, and the First Affiliated Hospital of Xinjiang Medical University, radiating more than 20 provinces and cities across the country, and vigorously promoting the development of organ transplantation in China. The laboratory led by Zheng Shusen has become one of the largest organ transplant centers in China and the largest organ transplant center in East China.

From 2007 to 2017, while working in the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University, he also served as a deputy chairman and chairman of the Anti-Cult Society of Zhejiang. Anti-Cult Society of Zhejiang was a government body established specifically for persecuting Falun Gong.

What kind of organization is the "China Anti-cult Association" (CACA)? Under the command of the Political and Legal Committee of the Chinese Communist Party and the "610 Office", it was established and operated exclusively for the persecution of Falun Gong. It is a real "cult association." Established on November 13, 2000, CACA is composed of so-called experts, scholars, and religious figures who serve the CCP. It is an official organization operating in the name of "civilian organizations" or "non-governmental organizations." Its office is attached to the government agency China Science and Technology Museum. On the one hand, it creates the theoretical basis for the persecution of Falun Gong and uses members' religious or technological identities to publicize the CCP's reasons for persecuting Falun Gong to the domestic and international community. On the other hand, it researches the theories and methods of brainwashing and "transforming" Falun Gong practitioners, provides guidance to various detention centers, labor camps, and brainwashing centers, and directly participates in the persecution of Falun Gong practitioners. The "cult association" has established affiliated "cult associations" at all levels in all provinces, cities, districts, counties, streets, enterprises, universities, middle schools, and primary schools throughout China, forming a persecution system covering every corner of the country.

I. Hospital Profile:

The First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University School of Medicine, referred to as the First Hospital, Zhejiang University for short, is a Class A tertiary general hospital affiliated with the Department of Medicine of Zhejiang University.

The hospital has six major campuses, with almost 5,000 beds. Currently, there are more than 6,500 employees, including 364 individuals with senior titles, 545 with associate senior titles, two academicians of the Chinese Academy of Engineering, three national-level outstanding youths, three "Chang Jiang Scholars" and specially-appointed professors, two national winners of the National Talent Project, six people from the "Ten Thousand Talents Program" and four national-level young and middle-aged experts with outstanding contributions.

Over the years, the hospital has been well-known for organ transplantation and its treatment of pancreatic diseases, infectious diseases, hematological diseases, kidney diseases and urinary system diseases, clinical pharmacy and other disciplines. It has successfully carried out multiple organ transplant operations, such as liver, pancreas, lung, kidney, small intestine and heart transplantation.¹

The hospital has established cooperative relations with more than 30 universities and medical institutions, including Stanford University, Johns Hopkins Hospital, University of Pittsburgh, Charité Medical Center in Germany and Kyoto University in Japan. And it is a national-level liver disease and liver transplant research base and an international scientific and technological cooperation demonstration base. The hospital has responded to the national "One Belt One Road" initiative, joined the China-CEEC Hospital Cooperation Alliance, and promoted exchanges and cooperation with Hungary and other Central and Eastern European

countries. And it has provided technologies and talents to Indonesia, Malaysia and other Southeast Asian countries.² (The above information comes from the hospital's official website, and the information was updated on May 1, 2020)

According to Wikipedia, the original contents of the hospital profile archived on November 8, 2012 are no longer available.

II. Organ Transplantation Department:

The First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University performs various organ transplants. It claims to be the national leader in liver transplantation, kidney transplantation, heart transplantation and lung transplantation, and that the number and quality of its organ transplantation both rank within the first echelon in China. Liver and kidney transplants have been included in the medical insurance coverage of Zhejiang Province.

As the chief scientist, Zheng Shusen has presided over a major national basic research program (i.e. the National 973 Program) in the field of organ transplantation for two consecutive times.³ As an organ transplant expert, he served as the president of the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University for many years. Wang Weilin, who succeeded him as president in 2014, is also a liver transplant expert.⁴ It can be seen that in the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University, which has a number of medical disciplines, organ transplantation enjoys an especially important position.

1. Two key laboratories for organ transplantation: In the hospital, there are two laboratories ranking first and third among 13 provincial and ministerial-level key laboratories: the Key Laboratory of Multi-Organ Transplantation Research under the Ministry of Health, and Zhejiang Provincial Organ Transplantation Key Research Laboratory.⁵

The multi-organ joint transplantation project led by Zheng Shusen has been listed as a promotion project by the Ministry of Health, and it has performed the largest number of joint pancreas-kidney transplantation and liver-kidney joint transplantation cases since these operations were first carried out. Zheng Shusen successively assisted many hospitals, including Peking Union Medical College Hospital, Huashan Hospital (affiliated with Fudan University), Xinhua Hospital in Shanghai and the First Affiliated Hospital of Xinjiang Medical University, to carry out liver transplantation in more than 20 provinces and cities across China. And he has vigorously promoted the development of organ transplantation in China.⁶

The hospital's official webpage archived by World Organization to Investigate the Persecution of Falun Gong (WOIPFG) has a more detailed disclosure of the Key Laboratory of Multi-Organ Transplantation Research under the Ministry of Health. The information shows that the laboratory has become one of the largest organ transplant centers in China and the largest in Eastern China.

The key laboratory has become the largest organ transplant center in Eastern China

The Key Laboratory of Multi-Organ Transplantation Research under the Ministry of Health was established in March 2001. The laboratory is located in the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University School of Medicine. Special clinical bases have been established for liver transplantation, kidney transplantation, bone marrow transplantation, and heart and lung transplantation. This lab has become one of the largest organ transplant centers in China and the largest in Eastern China. It has first implemented the clinical practice of liver transplantation, pancreas transplantation and multiple organ transplantation in the province and in China.⁷

This key laboratory is an open research base established by the Ministry of Health in the field of organ transplantation. It has 10,000 square meters, with equipment worth more than 50 million yuan. And it was

designated a national key clinical specialty in 2013. There are ten research technology platforms in the key laboratory, including a large-scale biological sample platform, a proteome research platform, an epigenetic research platform, a molecular cancer and immunity research platform, a graft protection research platform, an organ transplantation immunology research platform and an organ transplant technology innovation platform.⁸

2. Liver and Kidney Transplant Center:

The Department of Hepatopancreas Transplantation: The person in charge is Zheng Shusen. The Hepatopancreatobiliary Surgery Department (aka. the Liver Transplant Center) has more than 340 beds in its in-patient service area. Its medical team has 13 professors with senior titles, 26 individuals with associate senior titles and a total of 134 doctors, of whom 60 percent have a doctorate.⁹ The hospital's Hepatopancreas Transplant Center performs whole-liver transplantation, living donor liver transplantation, pediatric liver transplantation, reduced-size liver transplantation, split liver transplantation, re-liver transplantation, multiple organ transplantation and other difficult transplantation procedures. The number of combined liver-kidney transplantation and combined pancreas-kidney transplantation cases performed by this center ranks among the top in China.¹⁰

The Kidney Disease Center: The person in charge is Chen Jianghua. It has 120 beds. The Kidney Transplant ward area (the seventh floor in District B of Building No. 6) has 40 beds, among which there are 16 beds in 10,000-level laminar flow wards. This center is one of the largest kidney transplant centers in China.¹¹ According to statistics, as of November 2008, the center had performed 2,519 kidney transplants in total, with an annual average of 200 to 250 kidney transplants.¹² (The information is from the hospital's official website).

In addition, the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University and the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) Medical Center have jointly established an international top liver disease center.¹³ In October 2010, Professor Tom Rosenthal, chief medical officer of UCLA, and Professor Ren Sun, Vice President of UCLA Medical School and International Cooperation Assistant, visited the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang

University. They signed the cooperation agreement and established a joint liver disease center with the hospital.¹⁴

3. There are many professionals in the hospital's liver and kidney transplantation departments, indicating that the organ transplant volume would also be large

Zheng Shusen is an academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering, chairman of the Chinese Society of Organ Transplantation and the only mainland Chinese member of the International Liver Transplantation Society (ILTS). The majority of the 134 professors, specialists and doctors under him can perform liver transplantation and are able to form more than ten liver transplant teams. According to the hospital's official website, as of July 10, 2015, Zheng Shusen had successfully performed 1,741 liver transplants. Zheng Shusen has personally stated in public that he had completed more than 3,300 liver transplants.¹⁵

In the List of Medical Personnel Suspected of Extracting Organs from Living Falun Gong Practitioners released by WOIPFG in 2014, there were many organ transplant surgeons from the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University.¹⁶ There have been 44 kidney transplant surgeons discovered from medical papers and the hospital's official website, including five chief surgeons, eight associate professors and deputy chief surgeons, who can form multiple renal transplant teams.

III. Investigation calls: donor source, transplant volume, waiting time, donation, buying and selling...

1. Kidney transplantation resources:

“If you want to wait for the kidney sources to show up in the hospital, it will be very slow. At least 5 years! We do a lot (of kidney transplants), between 30 and 40 cases a month on average.” When a WOIPFG investigator asked, “If your hospital does between 30 and 40 cases a month on average, can you do between 400 and 500 cases a year?”, the nurse confirmed, “Yes.”¹⁸

2. Large amount of liver transplantation

“Every year our hospital performs several thousand transplants.”

On May 4, 2016, a nurse at the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University revealed to a WOIPFG investigator, “Every year our hospital performs several thousand transplants.” This figure is more than 10 times of the hospital’s publicly released annual organ transplant volume, but it is in line with the hospital’s several hundred ward beds dedicated to organ transplants.¹⁹

IV. The liver donors in Zheng Shusen's medical paper were very likely Falun Gong practitioners

1. Forty-six donors for emergency liver transplant operations were Falun Gong practitioners

Zheng Shusen's research paper published in 2005 shows that the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University School of Medicine performed 46 emergency liver transplant operations from January 2000 to December 2004.²⁸

An emergency liver transplant is an urgent liver transplant operation performed on patients with acute liver diseases and less than 72 hours to live. Due to the difficulty of urgent tissue typing and long wait times for compatible organs, emergency liver transplants are rarely seen in other countries. Were Zheng Shusen's emergency liver sources from donated organs? Zhejiang Province didn't participate in the organ donation pilot project until August 26, 2010,²⁹ while the 46 emergency liver transplants listed in the paper by Zheng Shusen in 2005 were performed from January 2000 to December 2004. So, it is obvious that these 46 organs could not have come from voluntary organ donations. Moreover, random donor organs are also unlikely to be a regular source for emergency liver transplantation.

They shouldn't have come from executed prisoners, either. The Chinese Communist Party's (CCP) organ resources from executed prisoners are limited, and hospitals fiercely compete with one another to obtain them. Therefore, it is impossible for these organs to become a regular organ source. In addition, executions take place according to their scheduled times and locations, and it is almost impossible to satisfy the needs of emergency liver transplants, which occur ad hoc. In order to complete a large number of emergency organ transplants, there must be a large number of people, who are not ordinary death-row inmates, who have already completed tissue typing in advance, who have lost their freedom, and whose organs can be harvested at any time according to transplantation needs. That is, there must be a living donor bank. In China, only the massive number of illegally detained Falun Gong practitioners meet these requirements. In the 46 emergency liver transplant cases performed by Zheng Shusen during the four-year peak period of organ transplantation, the donors could only be Falun Gong practitioners.

2. Five hundred and sixty-four livers lack credible evidence of ethical organ sourcing

In October 2016, Zheng Shusen's paper was revoked by the authoritative international academic journal *Liver International* because of the transplant donor. According to *Science* magazine, the international authoritative academic journal *Liver International* decided to retract one medical paper authored by Zheng et al., which was published on this magazine's website in October 2016, due to "absence of credible evidence of ethical sourcing of organs".³⁰ And Zheng Shusen has been forbidden to publish medical papers on this magazine for life.

V. Official media reported organ transplantation cases by the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University

On January 28, 2005, according to the mainland Chinese website Jksoso, Zheng Shusen at the organ transplant center of the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University completed five liver transplants consecutively on the same day. And Zheng Shusen once performed 11 orthotropic liver transplants in a week.³¹

On March 24, 2014, Sohu's homepage published a report titled "Awesome! The First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University Completed 14 Major Organ Transplants within 48 Hours". The article stated that President Wang Weilin, who was in charge of liver transplantation, led the surgical team to perform 14 major organ transplants at the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University in less than 48 hours. These operations included a heart transplant, one lung transplant, four liver transplants and eight kidney transplants, setting a new record since the hospital started performing organ transplants. "The operating room was like the rain outside the windows, as the operations lasted two days."³²

Preface

The actual number of organ transplants at the Transplant Center of West China Hospital, Sichuan University is huge, far exceeding the official figures. This was also confirmed in WOIPFG's telephone investigations. At the same time, the source of their organs is unknown, and they claimed that "the practitioners' are not allowed to be used any longer", which inadvertently admitted they used the organs of practitioners. Given the background of the CCP's national crime of live organ harvesting, this hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

Hospital Overview:

West China Hospital, Sichuan University is a large Grade-A Tertiary General Hospital in southwest China. According to the hospital's official website in December 2015, the hospital covers an area of more than 500 acres, with more than 600,000 square meters of business premises. The hospital has 4,100 ward beds on its Main Campus, mainly for the diagnosis and treatment of difficult and critical diseases, and 200 ward beds on its Wenjiang Campus⁸³.

I. The hospital is home to the Key Laboratory of Transplant Engineering and Immunology, Ministry of Health and the Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Research Laboratory, Ministry of Health. It is a national organ transplantation diagnosis, treatment and research center.

In 2002, it was approved as the Key Laboratory of Transplant Engineering and Immunology, Ministry of Health⁸⁴.

The Department of Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Surgery is home to the Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Research Laboratory, Ministry of Health, which is a key national discipline⁸⁵. Its liver transplantation ranks among the best both domestically and internationally. It is also one of the few pancreas transplant centers in China and has carried out combined pancreas-kidney transplants.

II. The actual number of organ transplants at the Transplant Center far exceeds the official figures.

1. The numbers of organ transplants in single days are surprisingly high.

The Liver Transplant Center once performed seven liver transplants in a single day, and it is one of the hospitals in China that can carry out multiple liver transplants in one day⁸⁶. In 2006, in a telephone investigation carried out by a reporter from Voice of Hope, a nurse from the Kidney Transplant Center, West China Hospital, said they once performed six kidney transplants in one day, with abundant kidney sources⁸⁷.

2. The annual volume of the hospital's liver and kidney transplants is large.

Relying on the key disciplines of the Ministry of Education - the General Surgery Department of West China Hospital and the Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Research Laboratory of the Ministry of Health, the

The Kidney Transplant Center of the hospital is one of the earliest hospitals in China to carry out kidney transplants. It is a key discipline of Sichuan Province, Chengdu City, and Sichuan University⁹⁰. As of 2015, the number of ward beds in the Urology Department is the largest in China⁹¹.

Under normal circumstances, the patient is treated by a urologist surgeon for two weeks before and after a kidney transplant. If there are no surgical complications two weeks after surgery, the patient will be referred to a nephrologist for treatment and will be discharged from the hospital after the ureteral stent is removed. So, patients usually need to be hospitalized for more than thirty days⁹². While, the hospital improved the third comprehensive ward and shortened the average hospital stay of kidney transplant patients. The medical and surgical treatment times after kidney transplant were shortened to ten days, respectively, to improve the bed turnover rate⁹³.

If we assume that there are 103 transplant beds (liver transplant beds 72 + kidney transplant beds 31 = 103), based on the conservatively estimated average hospitalization time of 20 days and 100% bed turnover rate, the number of liver and kidney transplants in this hospital in one year can reach 1879

3. The hospital has a strong team of liver and kidney transplant surgeons.

As early as 2004, it was reported on the hospital's official website that the transplant team in the Liver Transplant Center was quite large. Led by liver transplant expert Yan Lvnan, the team has eight professors and chief surgeons, sixteen associate chief surgeons, and more than thirty postdoctoral fellows and doctors⁹⁴.

The Kidney Transplant Center now has three professors and chief surgeons, two associate professors and associate chief surgeons, and two attending surgeons. The Center is a Ph.D. conferral unit and a postdoctoral research station⁹⁵. Multiple liver and kidney transplant teams can be formed.

III. The number of kidney transplants ranks first in China. "Kidney transplants are being done every day."

1. The kidney transplant surgeries in 2017 set multiple national records.

According to a report on sina.com in 2018, the kidney transplant surgeries of West China Hospital, Sichuan University set multiple national records in 2017⁹⁶.

In 2017, the kidney transplants of West China Hospital ranked first in China in:

- The total number was No.1 in China, which was 481.
- The number of living donor kidney transplants was No. 1 in China, which was 280.
- The number of blood group incompatible kidney transplants was No. 1 in China, which was 12.
- Besides, Prof. Lin Tao ranked first in China in laparoscopic minimally invasive kidney extraction and has completed more than 1,000 cases in total.

2. The official website of the Kidney Transplant Center has tampered with data, and the number of kidney transplants displayed has shrunk severely.

According to an Introduction to the Kidney Transplant Center of West China Hospital, Sichuan University, issued in February 2005, from September 1978, when the first kidney transplant was done till then, the Center performed more than 4,000 kidney transplant surgeries⁹⁷. Yet, in September 2014, the number of kidney transplants shown on its official website was severely shrunk⁹⁸: "...the Center has performed more than 2,500 kidney transplants till now. Starting from 2011, the number of kidney transplants performed by the Center has exceeded 200 annually."

IV. The actual number of organ transplants performed in the hospital far exceeds the number of organ donations in Sichuan Province.

From 2012 to the end of March 2016, in Sichuan Province, there were about 150 organ donations through the Red Cross system, including 63 donations distributed to West China Hospital. “Only two donations were received in 2012 and ten in 2013. From January to March this year (in 2016), there were twenty donations.”⁹⁹

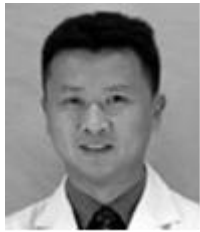

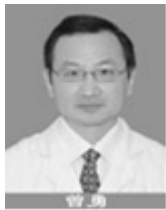

He became an associate chief surgeon in 2001, master student supervisor in 2002, and chief surgeon in 2006. In 2006, he was named the academic leader of the Sichuan Provincial Health Department. In 2004 and 2006, he went to Australia twice to study minimally invasive techniques and lung transplantation. He was the first to independently perform lung transplantation in southwest China, and the first case was a double lung transplant.¹⁴³

Preface

The hospital is the largest multi-organ transplant center in Northeastern China. With a sufficient organ sources and short waiting time, it is capable of performing a large number of transplanta surgeries, as many as 2000 cases in 2005 alone. The hospital has access to special service from the China International Transplantation Network Support Center, and is given the priority to select donors for the second surgery, which is performed within a week. It runs commercials on Internet featuring the use of organs from living donors¹⁴⁷. Telephone investigations indicate that there have been abnormal sources of organs such as "judicial" one. From 2003 to 2008, it was one of the partners of the Living-Donor Organ Transplant Project of "On-site Psychological Research Center" led by Wang Lijun, the Director of Public Security Bureau of Jinzhou City, Liaoning Province¹⁴⁸. There is evidence that experimental subjects in the project are suspected using Falun Gong practitioners.

I. Hospital Overview

It is a large comprehensive tertiary Level-A hospital with a building area of 260,000 square meters and 2249 beds. There are more than 3560 employees, more than 420 specialists at professor or associate professor levels, four National key disciplines and seven National key clinical specialties of the Ministry of Health¹⁴⁹.

The Department of Hepatobiliary Surgery and Organ Transplantation is an M.D. and M.S. degree granting institution, with 70 medical and nursing staff, including 4 professors, 8 associate professors, 11 lecturers and 5 teaching assistants. The department has undertaken 2 industry funds of the Ministry of Health, 9 national natural funds, 3 doctoral funds of the Ministry of Education, and more than 40 provincial and ministerial funds¹⁵⁰.

II. The hospital has become the largest multi-organ transplant center in Northeastern China

In 1992, Professor Liu Yongfeng established the Department of Organ Transplantation on the basis of the Department of General Surgery I, and carried out transplant operations such as kidney transplantation, liver transplantation, combined liver-kidney transplantation, and combined pancreas-kidney transplantation. Now the Department of Organ Transplantation, which was originally established from general surgery, has developed into one of the large-scale comprehensive organ transplant centers in China. In 2002, the Organ Transplant Institute of China Medical University was established, and it was designated as the Shenyang Multi-Organ Transplantation Technology Research Center by the Shenyang Science and Technology Committee. In 2003, it was designated as Liaoning Provincial Key Laboratory of Organ Transplantation by the Office of Science and Technology of Liaoning Province, and became the largest multi-organ transplant center in Northeastern China¹⁵¹.

1. 2,000 cases of organ transplants in 2005 alone

The hospital is believed to be the one that Mr. Suzuki, president of the Japan Transplant Patients Association, investigated in The Asia-Pacific Journal: Japan Focus and found that it performed 2,000 organ transplants in one year in 2005¹⁵².

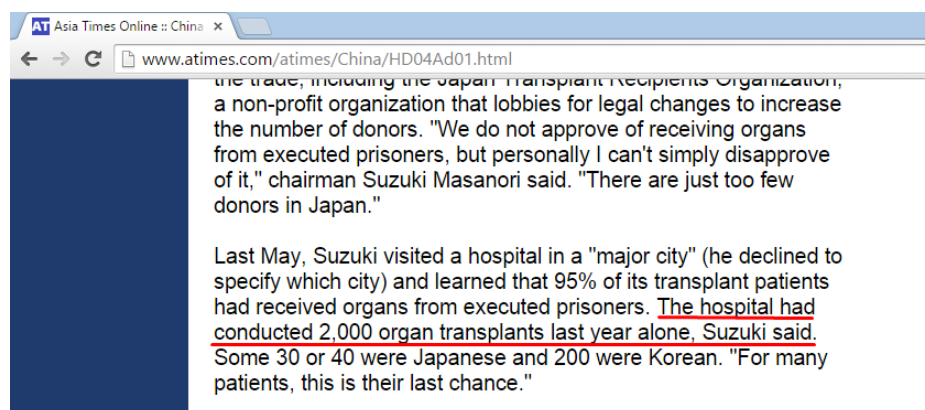


Figure 1 Snapshot from "Asia Times" article in April 2006

Based on our analysis, the hospital mentioned by Mr. Suzuki should be the First Hospital Affiliated with China Medical University in Shenyang, China. It is the biggest organ transplantation center in northeastern

China. It is also the first hospital to develop liver transplantation and Pancreas-kidney transplantation in the area. This hospital has established an “International Transplant (China) Network Support Center” in 2003, and it is located at the Transplant Research Institute of the First Hospital Affiliated with China Medical University.¹⁵³ The organization is dedicated to provide transplant services for foreigners. Most of the patients were from Japan. The center even has a Japanese language web site and purchased advertisements on the Internet. After the organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners were reported in 2006, this hospital was exposed. Soon after that, the web site was removed.

2. Extremely short waiting time for transplantation and priority donor selection for second surgery, which can be done within one week

According to its website, the International Transplantation (China) Online Support Center offered a special service: In case the transplanted organ malfunctions, the center will select another donor for the patient and perform the surgery again within a week.

“Generally, the waiting time for a liver transplant is only one month, no more than two months at the most. The shortest waiting time for a kidney transplant is a week, no more than one month at the most to obtain an HLA matched donor. Although donors are selected through a variety of rigorous examinations, if in any case their physical condition is abnormal such as fatty liver at the time when the kidney is harvested, the surgery will be canceled before the patient’s abdomen is cut open. The center will be responsible for finding another donor for the patient and conducting the transplant again within one week.”¹⁵⁴

3. Organs are from living donors

The archived webpage of the hospital in September 2004 shows:

- Good quality organs from living donors: “Comparing to cadaveric kidney transplant in Japan, kidney transplant in this hospital is safer and more reliable.”

- “China’s living donor kidney transplantation is totally different from cadaveric kidney transplants you learned from Japanese hospitals and dialysis centers.”¹⁵⁵

What needs to be clarified is that “living-donor organ transplant” in mainland China is different from the living-donor organ transplant which ensures the safety of living donor transplantation abroad. In other countries, only part of the liver will be transplanted from the donor (mainly from the relatives of the patient) to the patient, while in China the entire liver will be cut off from the living person to be transplanted to the patient. Since a person has only one liver, it is actually killing the person(donor) by taking his liver.

4. The hospital provides special services for Japanese patients in order to solicit business

“Since Japanese and Chinese people have very similar physical characteristics, most of the patients of this center are from Japan. Not only several doctors and head nurses of the Transplant Research Institute went to Japan to study, and are very familiar with Japanese culture, also a majority of the nurses can speak Japanese, which provides a lot of convenience for Japanese patients. All such patients will be admitted to high official’s wards for special care, after the surgery.”¹⁵⁶

III. The organs in this hospital came from the CCP government

On the center's website, it claimed, "The ability to perform such a large number of transplants is inseparable from the support of the Chinese government."¹⁵⁷ This is unique in the world.¹⁵⁸

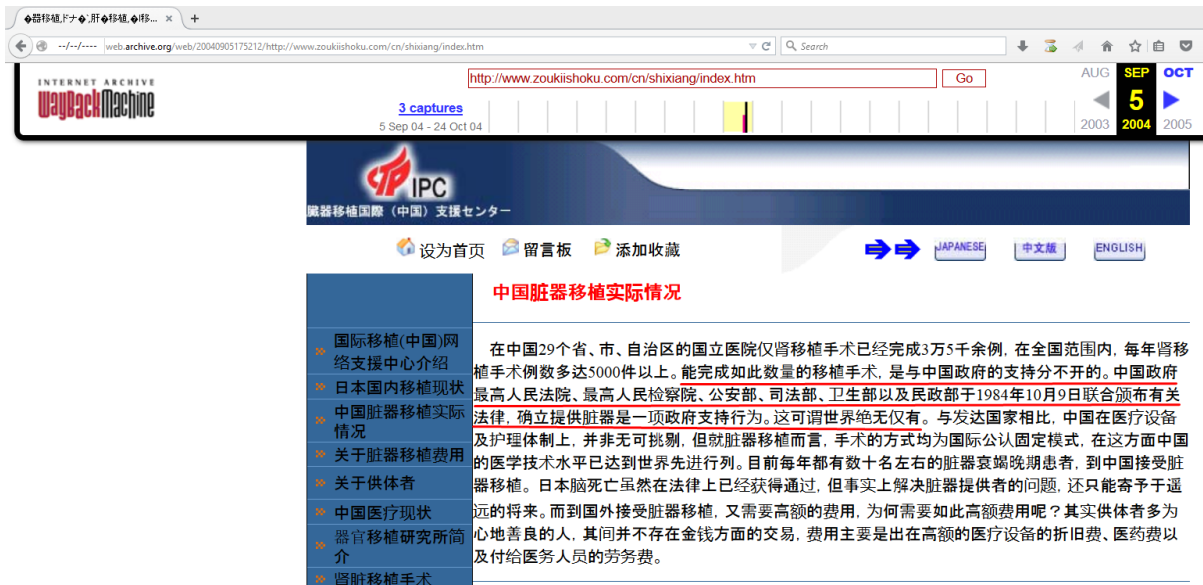


Figure 5. The archived webpage of Introduction to the International Transplantation (China) Network Support Center in September 2004

The doctoral supervisor Professor Liu Yongfeng is the director of the Organ Transplantation in this Center. The archived webpage of "List of Well-known Doctors" created on Oct. 23, 2004 gave the following description:¹⁵⁹ Professor Liu studied liver transplant and pancreas transplant at the Transplantation Center of University of Minnesota. He mastered the techniques for organ cutting, transplantation and postoperative management. In 1992, Prof. Liu Yongfeng established the Organ Transplant Department, and performed kidney transplant, liver transplant, combined liver-kidney transplant, and simultaneous pancreas-kidney transplant, etc. Now this center has been developed into one of the large-scale comprehensive organ transplant centers in China. It is the largest multi-organ transplantation center in the Northeastern China. Liu Yongfeng has trained more than twenty Ph.D. candidates, more than thirty Master's degree candidates, and directed kidney transplants in many hospitals.¹⁶⁰ He was promoted to Vice President of the First Hospital affiliated with China Medical University because of his outstanding "achievements."

According to the archived information on the Internet¹⁶¹, there were two professors, two associate professors, four Ph.D., seven Ph.D. candidates and two Master's degrees in this center in 2004. There were sixteen people who had Ph.D or Master's degrees, and half of them had studied abroad. The center was the only hospital that can perform kidney, liver, pancreas-kidney, liver-kidney, etc. multi-organs transplantation in China at that time. Based on the strength and marketing efforts of the center, 2000 cases of organ transplants performed in this center in 2005 is credible.

However, the hospital reported publicly right now that over 800 cases of kidney transplants and over 200 liver transplants were performed as of October 2012, averaging 100 cases per year. From 2,000 cases a year changed to 100 cases published online,¹⁶² it's a 20-fold reduction.

IV. The investigation confirmed that the hospital was involved in organ harvesting and human experiments on Falun Gong practitioners

The hospital has established an organ transplantation laboratory and has undertaken 3 projects from the National Natural Science Foundation of China, 1 project from the Ministry of Health, and more than 10 projects from the Provincial and Municipal Science and Technology Commission. Liu Yongfeng conducted researches on organ preservation, low-temperature molecular biology, and ischemia-reperfusion injury, and published more than 100 papers. He has won the award for Chinese Doctoral Degree Recipients for Their Outstanding Contributions, the Fok Yingdong Foundation National University's First Young Teacher Award, Sackler Chinese Surgeon Annual Award, the Second and Third Prize of the Ministry of Health Science and Technology Progress, the Second Prize for Provincial Science and Technology Progress, the First Prize for National Science and Technology Progress nominated by the Ministry of Education and other awards.¹⁶³

From 2003 to 2008, Wang Lijun, former Director of Chongqing Public Security Bureau, established the "On-site Psychological Research Center" with the main purpose of live organ transplantation experiments when he was Director of Public Security Bureau of Jinzhou City, Liaoning Province, whose partners included 7 foreign universities and 17 domestic universities and hospitals, among which was China Medical University.¹⁶⁴

On September 19, 2006, Ren Jinyang, the secretary-general of the China Guanghua Science and Technology Foundation gave a speech at the award ceremony for the Guanghua "Innovation Special Contribution Award". In his speech, he said, "Professor Wang Lijun and the Research Center conducted basic research and clinic trials to study how to resolve the challenging issue, which is, the organ transplant recipients are generally not receptive to organs from donors put to death through drug injection. They have created a

brand-new protective fluid, which is used to provide a perfusion treatment for liver and kidney previously subjected to drugs. After animal tests, in vitro experiments and clinical trials, they have achieved an important milestone where the recipient's body is able to accept the liver and kidney after such a treatment." Wang Lijun mentioned in his acceptance speech, "Our scientific and technological achievement is the result of several thousand of intensive on-site case collection, and the effort from so many of us..."¹⁶⁵

On May 25, 2012, WOIPFG conducted a telephone investigation on Chen Rongshan, the Director of Urology of the PLA 205 Hospital in Jinzhou City. Chen had completed 632 cases of kidney transplants before December 2006.¹⁶⁶ He had admitted harvesting organs from Falun Gong practitioners, and confirmed that China Medical University was taking part in human experiments.

Below is a segment of the transcript of telephone conversations between the WOIPFG investigator and Chen Rongshan:

The following is an excerpt from the recorded conversation between a WOIPFG investigator, disguised as "a member of the Wang Lijun inter-departmental investigation team," and Chen Rongshan, retired director of the Urological Surgery Department of the PLA No. 205 Hospital of Jinzhou City. Chen Rongshan admitted that the organ transplant donors were detained Falun Gong practitioners, and that the court had approved this.

Investigator: Wang Lijun had a research project about Organ Transplantation after Drug Injection.

Have you cooperated specifically?

Chen Rongshan: Involved in the cooperation also included the China Medical University, or the hospital affiliated with China Medical University.

Investigator: Some of your organ donors were jailed Falun Gong practitioners, is that true?

Chen Rongshan: **Those** all went through **the court**.

The statement from Liu Yongfeng¹⁶⁷, the director of the Institute of Organ Transplantation of China Medical University, shows that: he participated in the development and research of organ preservation fluid and developed kidney preservation fluid which is leading in China. His rapid combined abdominal organ extraction technique could reduce organ damage and warm ischemia time, which is the most widely used organ extraction procedure in China. He has undertaken various "scientific research" projects, including four projects supported by National Natural Science Foundation, and won the first prize award of National Science and Technology Progress.

V. Telephone investigation: Suspicion of the existence of "judicial" and other unusual donor sources

8. Investigator: He said that those from Falun Gong practitioners are better. Can you get it like this?

Dr. Mao: This is too difficult! This is too difficult and too few. Now there are very few corpses from prisons. These questions, you would better ask our director, okay?

Investigator: So, you mean too few. If there is any, it is less, a little less than it was before, right?

Dr. Mao: That's for sure. That's right! Now the country does not allow it, definitely not allow that thing, right.

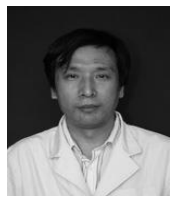
