China's Organ Transplant Organizations are the Executing Entities for the Communist Party's State Crime of Live Organ Harvesting

Since 1999, led by its then-leader Jiang Zemin, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) criminal group has been manipulating China's entire state apparatus, including the Party, government, military, armed police, judicial system, and medical institutions, through the Political and Legal Affairs Commission and the "610" system, to commit nationwide mass extermination of Falun Dafa practitioners by means of live organ harvesting for transplantation. The CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a crime against humanity and a crime of genocide initiated on the orders of Jiang Zemin.

Since the CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a state genocidal crime conducted as a political campaign, organ transplant institutions in all provinces, central government-controlled municipalities, and autonomous regions of mainland China, including all military, armed police, and local hospitals (medical centers) are suspected to have participated in this crime, even including a considerable number of hospitals unqualified to perform organ transplants, such as small and medium-sized hospitals and specialized hospitals. Similar to how all Chinese hospitals were involved in forced abortions during the CCP's implementation of the "one-child policy", all transplant facilities in China today have participated in live organ harvesting.

In view of the broader context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, those in charge of organ transplant hospitals/centers and similar institutions in China are suspected of having been involved in the crime of live organ harvesting from groups such as Falun Gong practitioners.

Evidence Collection Methods

1. Direct and indirect comprehensive telephone investigation and on-site investigation of the people suspected of involvement in the live organ harvesting

The subjects of our investigations include government officials, policemen, doctors and other medical personnel.

Geographical Distribution of the Subjects of Investigation, and the Duration of Investigations:

The WOIPFG's subjects of investigation are people in different positions, who are located across the entire country of China. Our investigations have been ongoing for nearly two decades, and our investigation results have always been consistent. The evidence gathered by us verifies that live organ harvesting is a systematic arrangement by the CCP.

1) Subjects of investigation: Presidents, directors, doctors, nurses, and security guards of organ transplant hospitals.

2) Hospitals involved: A considerable amount of recorded evidence has been obtained from many provincial, military, armed police, and local organ transplant hospitals (centers) across China.

3) Time span: Our investigations on the live organ harvesting started in 1999, and they're ongoing to this day.

2. Data investigation

1) We have been collecting data from the hospitals' websites and press releases.

2) We have been searching for and analyzing medical papers on transplantation.

3) We have been using the website www.archive.org to view the hospitals' previously archived information.

4) We have been collecting reports from the official Chinese media outlets.

5) We have organized all the information obtained from our investigations to create a database of the hospitals.

All the facts have shown us that the CCP is by no means a rational or normal organization or political party; but intead, it is a supra-state criminal syndicate controlled by a group of criminals who have committed crimes against humanity. The CCP's logic of thinking and principles of action are anti-human, and the crimes it has committed are forms of evil that humanity had never seen previously.

WOIPFG's investigative report series contains nearly 70 investigation reports on the alleged organ harvesting of living Falun Gong Practitioners at major Chinese military and civilian hospitals and on their staff members suspected of participation in this crime. This volume contains four such investigation reports.

Beijing Chao-Yang Hospital, Capital Medical University is the organ transplant center in Beijing, with three organ transplant qualifications of liver, kidney, and lung¹. The number of organ transplants is large, and the number of kidney transplants ranks first in the country for three consecutive years². According to the telephone investigation: Emergency transplants are available, and the waiting time for transplants is short. The director of liver transplant and doctors admitted to using Falun Gong practitioners as donors, and the transplant volume is large. In view of the background of the CCP's national crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners, Beijing Chao-Yang Hospital is seriously suspected of being a key institution for organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners.

Hospital overview:

Beijing Chao-Yang Hospital, Capital Medical University was established in 1958. It is the Third Clinical Medical College of Capital Medical University and the hospital where Beijing Institute of Respiratory Diseases is located. It is a third-level first-class hospital in Beijing that integrates medical treatment, teaching, scientific research and diseases prevention. It is among the designated medical institutions in Beijing that are covered by Class A Medical Insurance.

The hospital currently has two locations. The hospital covers a total area of 102,800 square meters, with a construction area of 210,000 square meters. It has more than 4,300 employees and consists of 1,900 beds and 59 clinical and medical technology divisions. The number of annual outpatient and emergency visits is about 3.8 million. The number of annual inpatient admissions is more than 89,000, and the number of surgeries is about 34,000³.

I. The hospital's Hepatobiliary Surgery Department is the site of the Beijing Organ Transplant Center's Liver Transplant Department

The CCP's Ministry of Health has an organ transplant center with the capability to simultaneously perform major organ transplants, such as liver, heart, kidney, lung, small intestine and pancreas transplants. The Beijing Organ Transplant Center's Liver Transplant Department is located in the Hepatobiliary Surgery Department of Beijing Chaoyang Hospital.⁴

II. The Department of Urology carries out kidney transplants, in a large scale

The Department of Urology has developed rapidly. The pancreas-kidney combined transplantation was carried out in 1999. It claims to have completed more than 3,000 cases of kidney transplants by 2016, and the actual number of transplants is even greater⁵. The Urology Center of the hospital consists of Ward One, Ward Two, West Ward and Outpatient Center, with a total of 112 open beds⁶. The annual outpatient volume is more than 100,000, the annual inpatients volume is more than 2,500, and the annual operation volume is more than 2,000.

1.1.1 III. The hospital has participated in the Beijing Tissue Typing Center. From 1998 to 2000, The number of kidney transplants of the hospital ranked first in China for three consecutive years

Five hospitals, including Beijing Friendship Hospital, the PLA No. 301 Hospital, Beijing Chaoyang Hospital, China-Japan Friendship Hospital and Peking Union Medical College Hospital, have participated in the operations of the Beijing Tissue Typing Center. These hospitals belong to four systems, including the Ministry of Health, the Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences, the People's Liberation Army (PLA) and the municipality of Beijing.⁷ Beijing Chaoyang Hospital claims that from 1998 to 2000, its number of kidney transplants ranked first in China for three consecutive years.⁸

1.1.2 VI. The hospital's strong surgical teams for liver/kidney transplants show that its actual organ transplant volume is massive

In 2014, World Organization to Investigate the Persecution of Falun Gong (WOIPFG) released a list of the hospital's organ transplant surgeons.⁹ The surgeons performing kidney transplants include six chief physicians, nine associate chief physicians and 17 others, with a total of 32 surgeons. The surgeons performing liver transplants include three chief physicians, seven associate chief physicians, five attending physicians and 12 others, with a total of 27 surgeons. They are capable of forming multiple liver and kidney transplant surgical teams.

Zhang Xiaodong was the deputy director of Beijing Chaoyang Hospital's urinary surgery department and its chief physician. As of 2016, his surgical team had performed more than 3,000 cases of kidney transplantation.¹⁰

Wang Wei was an associate chief physician of Beijing Chaoyang Hospital's urinary surgery department. He obtained his doctorate in July 2004. As of 2014, he had independently carried out around 500 cases of renal transplantation and had participated in nearly 1,000 cases of kidney transplant surgeries and postoperative patient management.¹¹

Guan Delin was Vice President of the First Hospital of Tsinghua University and Deputy Director of the Beijing Organ Transplant Center. As of 2014, Guan Delin had successfully performed more than 1,000 cases of kidney transplants by himself.¹²

Beijing Business Today reported on September 7, 2005 that Guan Delin had performed "more than 2,700 cases of kidney transplantation, more than 40 cases of living related kidney transplantation, nearly 20 cases of combined pancreas-kidney transplantation."¹³ Guan Delin used to serve as the director of the urology department at the Beijing Red Cross Chaoyang Hospital.¹⁴




Figure 1. Snapshot of Beijing Business Today Website

By January 1999, he had performed more than 1,000 kidney transplants. In contrast, from January 26, 1999 to September 7, 2005, within six years and seven months, Guan Delin performed more than 1,700 cases of

kidney transplantation, while he was serving important leadership positions, performing teaching tasks and working as committee members and editorial board members. Therefore, Guan Delin's average number of kidney transplants per year was 258 cases (1,700 cases divided by 6.58 years). However, he performed only over 100 cases of kidney transplant surgeries in 1998.¹⁵ So what's the reason for the large increase in Guan's workload?¹⁶ Since Guan Delin alone could perform 258 cases of kidney transplantation per year, and there were so many surgeons in this hospital, how large would the annual organ transplant volume be?

V. Telephone investigation: The doctors admitted to using Falun Gong practitioners as donors; the hospital can perform emergency transplants; the organ wait times are very short; the hospital has a large organ transplant volume

1. The doctors admitted to using Falun Gong practitioners as donors

Summary:

"If everything goes well, it can be done two or three weeks." Investigator: "The donors are those Falun Gong practitioners, that kind of normal healthy donors, right?" Lang Ren: "Right, right, correct, correct, you are right." (Recording 1 download: MP3, Transcript download: pdf 5)

Profile: Lang Ren is a chief physician, an editorial board member of the "Chinese Journal of Hepatobiliary Surgery" and a member of the Beijing Medical Association's Enteral Nutrition Committee.¹⁸

Subject(s) of investigation: Dr. Li, Doctor-on-duty, the Urology Surgery, Beijing Chaoyang Hospital Date: December 2, 2018 (01186-10-85231457)

Summary:

Investigator: "They are still the normal kidney sources from Falun Gong (practitioners), right?" Dr. Li: "Right, right, right."

Investigator: "Generally speaking, if you take a donor, you should not only take a kidney, but also the heart, liver and kidney. How long does it take for this process?" Dr. Li: "About three or four hours."

Investigator: "It takes three or four hours to get this organ from disinfection, draping to completion, right?" Dr. Li: "Right, right, right."

Investigator: "Sometimes you go directly to the source of the kidney to get the organs, and sometimes you transfer them through an intermediary and get them from outside and use them at the hospital. Now you don't need an intermediary, right?"

Dr. Li: "Maybe sometimes now, but generally, yes."

Investigator: "The organs collected by the intermediary are also normally organs of Falun Gong. The source of the organs is the same, right?" Doctor Li: "Yes."

Investigator: "My question is, what the intermediary takes is the same as what you take, right?" Doctor Li: "Yes, right, right."

2. The hospital can perform emergency transplants

Usually, emergency liver transplants are emergency liver replacement surgeries performed on patients with acute or severe liver diseases, who can survive for no more than 72 hours. Due to the difficulty of emergency organ matching and the long wait times for donors, emergency liver transplants are not common in foreign countries. In China, emergency liver transplantation has been widely implemented in recent years.

Subject(s) of Investigation: Doctor, the Liver Transplant Doctors' Office, Beijing Chaoyang Hospital¹⁹ **Date:** March 7, 2019 (+86-10-85231504)

Summary: There are a lot of liver transplants performed in this hospital. The wait time is as short as one or two days, maybe half a month sometimes. The wait wouldn't be too long. (Recording 3 download: <u>MP3</u>, Transcript download: <u>pdf 012</u>)

3. The organ wait times are very short

Subject(s) of Investigation: He Qiang, Director of Liver, Gallbladder and Spleen Surgery, Beijing Chaoyang Hospital²⁰ Date: March 3, 2016 (+86-13701194928)

Summary: "We have always been doing liver transplants. The (organ) wait times are one to two weeks. This year, we have already performed more than a dozen cases, and the price is 700,000 yuan (per case)." (Recording 4 download: <u>MP3</u>, transcript download: <u>pdf2</u>)

- 3. Investigator: Are those organs from prisoners or Falun Gong practitioners that were used previously still available?

Doctor: None of those are available now, None.

- 3. You come to Beijing Chaoyang Hospital to find me, at the East Bridge in Chaoyang District. Just call me.
- 4. We did not stop during the epidemic, we have continued doing it; we did it yesterday, and did four [transplants] in three days.
- 5. Investigator: If it goes well, can it be done within a month?

VI. An illegal organ broker disclosed the dark secrets of Chaoyang Hospital²⁷

"There are many kidney sources, and a surgery can be scheduled within a week." A small kidney transplant advertisement with a phone number appeared in 2017 near many Class A tertiary hospitals in Shanghai, Zhengzhou, Qingdao, Guangzhou, Xiamen and other places. Since November 2017, WOIPFG continuously investigated this case for three months. WOIPFG investigators conducted several investigations on Wang, the contact person in the advertisement, in the name of a patient's family member, doctor and hospital organ coordinator. During this period, Wang disclosed many dark secrets regarding the organ procurement. The following are some excerpts of the telephone investigations on Wang concerning Beijing Chaoyang Hospital.

Subject(s) of investigation: Mr. Wang, Kidney Transplant Organ Broker (I) Date: January 3, 2018 (+86 183102589794)

Summary:

1. Wang said that in the underground small hospital they built near Beijing Chaoyang Hospital, "They have done several times more cases than the Class A tertiary hospitals this year." The family member of a patient said that they did not feel confident about Wang's small hospital. Wang

said that there was no problem, as all the surgeons were actually the doctors and directors from Class A tertiary hospitals. In his small hospital, "they have done several times more cases this year than the Class A tertiary hospitals."

He also said that he performed surgeries "every day". "I finished another surgery yesterday, you know." He said that sometime the caller could not find him by phone, because he was busy with surgeries most of the time.

- 2. Wang said that all the surgeries performed in the underground operating room were using living donors. In fact, many of the living donors used by some Class A tertiary hospitals were "all provided by us." He said that he could arrange for patients to go to Chaoyang Hospital for surgeries, but the kidney sources would be the same, as they would all be living donors provided by them.
- 3. Wang guaranteed that the kidney sources were from young people, "who are all under 25 years old". "Basically all of them are under the age of 25, and donors of 27 or 28 years old may be accepted if their conditions are particularly good." Wang said repeatedly that he guaranteed the donors to be young and healthy. When the family member asked why there were so many young males, he said that they had their own channels.
- 4. When being asked whether he could perform organ transplant surgeries other than kidney transplants, Wang replied, "Liver transplants can also be done. For a liver, it probably takes two weeks," but the surgery could only be performed in a Class A tertiary hospital, with a wait time of just two weeks.

Summary:

- 1. Wang said that they had "cooperation with Beijing's Chaoyang (Hospital) and the Armed Police (General Hospital)". When the investigator asked about both hospitals' experiences, Wang said, "They have connections, you know? They are afraid of nothing!" When the investigator asked about their connections and how they were developed, Wang replied, "Their directors have connections with the military or the central government, you know? That is, even people know clearly what they're doing; no one dares to stop them!"
- 2. Wang said that the underground small hospital conducts more transplant surgeries than the Class A tertiary hospitals. "In Chaoyang, we probably have three or four people, in cooperation with the (organ transplant department's) director. So they give me five cases per person per month. You know, that's five beds. He, he just tells you that you will be given five beds this month. That means, five cases of surgeries."
- 3. Wang said, "You should know that we are [operating] illegally. If something goes wrong, you have to settle it by yourself. As long as you do this thing, you don't want to cause any trouble. If something were to happen, such as an accident, you should handle it by yourself. Don't, don't make trouble publicly, don't make it known to reporters or make trouble abroad. If you make trouble abroad, it's troublesome."
- 4. Wang said that they performed kidney excisions at night, only with their own people. "The (practice) in Chaoyang is that the donors are outside (of the hospital). Since only the liver transplants are performed inside the hospital, the donors all have their organs excised in an operating room outside. After being excised, the organs are brought over there." Wang said that it took about two hours to perform a kidney excision, which is very simple to perform.
- 5. Investigator: "Originally, they arrested a large number of people, because at that time, these petitioners (i.e. Falun Gong practitioners) did not report their names. So they did (live organ harvesting) with these people. But there must be some (other arrests) later on. They have been constantly arresting people. Ah, they would dispose some of them. But after the change of state leadership, this policy still continues. It cannot be discussed openly, right? But, they are still doing it, so he can only turn a blind eye to it, right? Mr. Wang: "Yes, this, this has always been the case."
- 6. Wang said that there's an unwritten rule when cooperating with the hospitals. If something happens, "we are like this in this business: we must protect the hospitals. Because if we say it out, then everyone's crime will become greater and heavier. So we'd rather not say it! Then we would have protected the hospitals. Then you can still operate outside for us; even if you don't help us operate, we can still cooperate after we are released." Wang said, "It cannot be said that (the country) does not control it. It also controls it, but that is on the surface, you know." Wang said, "In 2012 or 2013, around that time, in the international community, a small country at UN, probably instigated by another country, accused our China about this issue. They stirred up some trouble over this issue. They did not mention Falun Gong, but brought up the issue that China used organs from executed prisoners, as a human rights issue. However, our country was able to resolve the issue at that time."
- 7. The WOIPFG investigator said, "In the past, the organs from the judiciary system were mostly from Falun Gong practitioners. The organs used in transplants now are also from Falun Gong practitioners,

but they claim that they are from voluntary donors." Wang agreed, "Right, right, correct."

8. Wang said, "In Chaoyang, when a patient comes, the director will talk to him seriously, about how his or her operation is going to be like, but there is a problem getting kidney source. Then we will talk with the patient, and we will tell the patient, go tell the director that I have the kidney source, I have a way and I have connections, so I am able to get a kidney for you. Then the director would say, hey, sounds good, go ahead and obtain the kidney yourself, I will arrange the operation for you. Then, even if the operation fails, or some problem occurs, we have secured the patient, you know. If someone from your hospitals comes with the patient, if any problem arises and there is an investigation, he will serve as a witness. It won't be any problem if the operation goes well, but if anything goes wrong with the operation, he will sure go after you. "

- 1. Speaking of money, Wang said, "When (surgeries) are performed in other hospitals, we can add a little bit of profit for you (in our pricing), more or less, do you know? We add a little bit of profit for the doctor, who's mainly in charge of this or the director. It's roughly, basically around 50,000 yuan...I will add another 50,000 yuan for you, and then you allocate the money among yourselves, okay?" The investigator asked, "Chaoyang and the First Central Hospital, Tianjin First Central Hospital also work like this?" Wang answered, "Yes, yes."
- 2. Regarding the specific operation, physical examinations are done at the Beijing Armed Forces General Hospital, and operations are done at Chaoyang Hospital. The two procedures appear to be separately carried out. Wang said, "Chaoyang would take a look at the results of your physical examination. After the hospital looks at them, the patient would come to have a checkup again at Chaoyang, but the donor will not go through a checkup there, you know. For donors, they (Chaoyang) only look at the results from previous checkups."
- 3. Wang said that the procedures are very crucial. "Chaoyang would have a quota. Within the spot in the quota, when he performs a surgery for one patient, for instance, Wang So-and-so, he would do it according to the normal procedures. That is, brain death, or (organ) donations of this kind. After performing a surgery for this patient, he does it again... when we do it again, it would be imposture. Using Wang So-and-so's spot within the quota to perform surgeries for other people."
- 4. The real name of one single person can be used to perform surgeries for more than a dozen individuals.
- 5. The directors at Chaoyang Hospital prepares stamps and performs the forgery in paperwork. Wang reminds the doctors that their hospitals cannot report the actual large number of operations to the Ministry of Health.
- 6. Wang said that in Chaoyang there were two directors falsifying paperwork, Zhang Xiaodong and another director. After hearing the investigator mention the names of Wang Wei and others, he said that they were all doing it. There were two groups, and Hu Xiaopeng and the others were all under Zhang

7. There are at least four people like Wang providing organs to Chaoyang Hospital. And each month each of them can do more than 20 organ transplants outside the hospital. Wang said, "There are four, four people that I know. These are just the ones that I know." The investigator said, "You see that with four people, that's more than 80 cases. There would be over 100 cases per month." Wang said, "They didn't report that many cases to the higher authorities. There are many, according to me, which were not reported at all, you know. There are way too many people! It's a little, a little bit against common sense."





Preface

Multiple provincial organ transplantation institutions were established in the Third Xiangya Hospital in 2003. In 2005, the Transplantation Medicine Engineering Technology Research Center of the Ministry of Health was formally established in the Third Xiangya Hospital. The hospital has abundant organ donors, and patients can obtain liver sources within two weeks. The number of organ transplants is enormous, but it is kept low-key and secretive to outsiders. During our telephone investigation, Ye Qifa, the hospital's Vice President, did not deny using organs from Falun Gong practitioners. Based on the above abnormal situation and the results of the telephone investigation, the Third Xiangya Hospital of Central South University is suspected of being one of the national organ allocation centers that harvest organs from live Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

I. Hospital Overview

In 1998, the hospital passed the acceptance inspection of the Ministry of Health and became a Grade-A Tertiary Hospital. From 1999 to 2005, the hospital expanded and developed rapidly. In 2007, the hospital obtained the qualifications for liver and kidney transplantation from the Ministry of Health⁷⁵. At present, the hospital has 1,800 open ward beds, 46 medical laboratories and clinical departments, and more than 2,100 employees. Organ transplantation has been the specialty of the hospital for many years⁷⁶.

II. The hospital has great potential for organ transplants with the hardware and personnel to perform thousands of transplants every year.

In August 2001, the hospital invested nearly 100 million yuan to build a transplantation medical center of nearly 8,000 square meters, including a dialysis center, an experimental center, laminar flow operating rooms and ICU ultra-purified transplant laminar flow wards. At the same time, the Hunan Provincial Transplantation Medical Center settled in the hospital⁷⁷. There are 150 ward beds available⁷⁸. Based on this figure, if the bed turnover rate is 100% (the average bed occupancy rate in the national Grade-A Tertiary Hospitals is as high as 103%⁷⁹), and if the hospitalization time for liver and kidney transplant is 30 days, the hospital has the potential to perform more than 1,825 ($150 \times 365 \times 100\%/30=1825$) cases of liver and kidney transplants per year. (Calculation method: number of ward beds X number of days in a year X bed turnover rate/average hospitalization time for liver and kidney transplants performed per year)

According to the "Central South University News" report in 2009: "Since the new surgical building of the Third Xiangya Hospital was completed and put into use, the number of beds has been increasing, from 1,000 before the start-up to 1,467. Once the 19th ward and the old cadre department open to use, the actual number of open beds is estimated to be 1,800. Since the beginning of this year, the number of inpatients has increased by 29% compared with the same period last year. The hospital bed utilization rate has reached or exceeded 100%, which is in a saturated state. Hospital leaders have even adopted the approach to shorten the average inpatient days to increase the bed turnover rate." ⁸⁰ The actual transplant volume may be even higher.




Figure 1 Snapshot of the Third Xiangya Hospital of Central South University website

The Transplant Center has more than twenty professors and associate professors, and nearly a hundred medical, nursing, and technical staff⁸¹. "In October 2002, transplant expert Ye Qifa led a transplant team of eight experts to join the Third Xiangya Hospital."⁸² Huang Zufa, President of the Third Xiangya Hospital, also emphasized the role of Ye Qifa's team in an interview with a reporter from the Central South University Journal: "In 2002, eight high-level organ transplant talents headed by Professor Ye Qifa, an organ transplant expert, joined our hospital...", "So far, we have carried out transplants of heart, liver, kidney, pancreatic islet cells, hematopoietic stem cells, small intestine, etc.", "Our hospital has once performed two liver and five kidney transplants simultaneously, and we already have the ability to perform six or seven transplants at the same time."⁸³

III. The status of the hospital's Transplant Center in the organ transplant industry has been continuously upgraded.

1. In August 2001, the Third Xiangya Hospital built a Hunan Transplantation Medical Center building⁸⁴. On September 19, 2003, when the building was officially opened, Xinhuanet published a report: *The Deputy Minister of Health of the People's Republic of China Performs a Liver Transplant at Central South University*. The article reads:" (The Transplant Center has completed) 300 liver transplants and 600 kidney transplants in the past three years. On that day, the Transplant Center arranged seven liver and kidney transplants. Huang Jiefu performed a liver transplant⁸⁵."

2. In 2003, multiple provincial organ transplant institutions were established in the Third Xiangya Hospital.

On September 18, 2003, Hunan Provincial Transplantation Medicine Engineering Technology Research Center, Hunan Medical Association Transplantation Medicine Professional Committee, and Central South University Xiangya Institute of Transplantation Medicine were established at the Third Xiangya Hospital. At the same time, the hospital officially signed an organ transplant cooperation agreement with the University of Pittsburgh in the US⁸⁶.

3. In 2005, the Transplantation Medicine Engineering Technology Research Center of the Ministry of Health was formally established in the Third Xiangya Hospital.

In 2005, after being evaluated by relevant domestic experts organized by the Ministry of Health and approved by the Ministry of Health, the Transplantation Medicine Engineering Technology Research Center of the Ministry of Health (hereinafter referred to as the "Center") was established in the Third Xiangya Hospital of Central South University. "After three years of development, the Center has carried out hundreds of piggyback liver transplants and over one thousand kidney transplants. It has also carried out liver-kidney, liver-pancreas, liver-intestine, pancreas-kidney and multi-organ combined transplants, spleen transplants, pancreas transplants, heart transplants, split liver transplants, relative liver transplants, thyroid and parathyroid gland transplants, and liver, spleen and pancreatic cell transplants. IV. The hospital is suspected of being a national organ allocation center, and it is highly probable that it has been an organ allocation center in Hunan Province.

On September 24, 2003, the Public Health Newspaper⁸⁸, a subsidiary of the Hunan Daily Press Group, reported that Huang Jiefu had delivered a speech at the Third Xiangya Hospital to build an organ allocation network, which involved the centralized detention of living donors and the building of the allocation center: "Hunan Transplantation Medicine Engineering Technology Research Center was established on September 18. Provincial, regional, and national management networks will gradually form, playing the role of information sharing and rational utilization and allocation of resources. Moreover, the increase in the number of (organ transplant) surgeries will improve the technical development of the entire transplant medicine community. More importantly, organ transplants based on a regulated donor market have largely saved medical costs for patients. Eliminating the need to transport donors back and forth would cut the surgery cost in half, and the transplant quality would be greatly improved due to shorter wait times for organs. "

Based on the analysis, the Ministry of Health, the military, and the police system have cooperated in setting up multiple living organ donor banks across China, detaining a large number of Falun Gong practitioners, and providing organs for transplants to hospitals nationwide. But how can these organ banks be coordinated to reduce confusion, prevent information leaks, and make them more effective? This series of issues needed to be solved urgently in 2003, the peak of the national transplantation. So, it was not a simple matter for Huang Jiefu, Vice Minister of Health, to come forward to talk about building an organ allocation network at the Third Xiangya Hospital in September 2003.

Huang Jiefu said: "Provincial, regional, and national management networks will gradually form, playing the role of information sharing and rational utilization and allocation of resources..." It is quite possible for them to place the project of the Ministry of Health in the Third Xiangya Hospital and establish a national organ allocation center. "Eliminating the need to transport donors back and forth would cut the surgery cost in half." It reflects the operation mode of unified deployment and allocation of organs nearby.

VI. Medical papers show that the quality of donor organs far exceeds that of executed prisoners, suggesting that there are other sources of healthy donors.

According to the statistics of *Family Health Newspaper*, a subsidiary of Heilongjiang Daily Press Group, in 2003, the number of "organ donations from citizens after death" in China was still zero. By 2006, family members of twenty-two deceased agreed to donate their relatives' organs. As of November 20, 2008, the number of donors finally reached a hundred and four⁹⁵. On March 7, 2012, an article on qq.com quoted Huang Jiefu, "Organ shortage is the bottleneck for the development of our country's organ transplantation industry. Due to the lack of voluntary donations from citizens, organs from executed prisoners have become the main source of organ transplants. ⁹⁶" Huang Jiefu said in an interview with CCTV in July 2018 that the quality of the organs of executed prisoners is poor. The requirements for organ sources are very strict, and such organs cannot be obtained on the execution ground⁹⁷. Medical papers show that the quality of donor organs far exceeds that of executed prisoners, indicating that there are other sources of healthy donors. And Falun Gong practitioners are most likely the major source of healthy organs.

March 2002 to December 2005	107 cases of liver transplants and liver excisions were performed. Livers were all harvested by in situ hypothermic perfusion whole organ resection. 107 donors were in good health ⁹⁸ .
January 2004 to June 2008	91 cases of orthotopic liver transplants and liver excisions were performed, including 80 males and 11 females aged 19-55 years , with an average of 29 years old. The preoperative liver and kidney function and virological tests were normal. Multi-organ combined rapid excision was executed ⁹⁹ .
January 2004 to July 2006	64 liver excisions were performed. The donors were cadavers with no heartbeat, aged 19-55 years (average 32.5). Preoperative examination showed normal liver and kidney function, no fatty liver, no positive hepatitis C antibody or human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) antibody ¹⁰⁰ .



The hospital has a large number of transplants in an striking growth rate. It always has sufficient organ donors, short waiting times, and transplants as usual during pandemic. A transplant doctor openly admitted that the source of organs was from Falun Gong practitioners. Dr. Tan Yunshan, the Director of the liver pathology department, admitted that Jiang Zemin ordered the live harvesting of organs from Falun Gong practitioners for transplantation.

During the investigation by WOIPFG, a doctor at the Liver Transplant Center in Fudan University's Zhongshan Hospital was asked "whether you have the kind of [organs] from those who practice Falun Gong." The answer was: "What we have here are all of this kind."¹²⁶ **I. Hospital Overview**

Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University is a third level first class general hospital. On May 23, 2007, this hospital was appointed by the Ministry of Health to perform liver, kidney and heart transplant surgeries.¹²⁷ It was the only hospital in Shanghai to obtain certification for heart, liver and kidney transplants all at once. Its Organ Transplant Center was established on October 30, 2001.¹²⁸

II. High volume and rapid growth-rate of transplant surgeries at the hospital

Until Sep. 22, 2007, media and hospitals made the following statements:

1. The online media *Sina.com* reported in December 2003: The total number of organ transplants at Fudan University's Organ Transplant Center has exceeded 100 cases per year, with an annual growth rate of 50 percent. On December 8, 2003, it cooperated with the world's largest organ-transplant institute and co-founded the "Fudan University Zhongshan Hospital—US Pittsburg University Thomas E. Starzl Collaborating Transplant Research Center", claiming "looking forward to reaching new milestones in the area of organ transplantation."¹²⁹

In August 2006 (article submitted on February 10), Qin Xinyu, Fudan University Zhongshan Hospital's CCP secretary, vice president, and director of general surgery, published an article on *Chinese Hospitals*, stating that at the time, major organ transplant operations on heart, lung, liver and kidney had reached about 400 cases.¹³⁰

3. An online archiving website (www.archive.org) disclosed that as early as 2005, the following statements appeared on the hospital's official website: "Zhongshan Hospital has completed a grand total of nearly 1,000 cases of kidney transplants, more than 200 cases of liver transplants, 107 cases of heart transplants, 6 cases of combined heart and lung transplants, and 11 cases of combined liver and kidney transplants. The number of organ transplants is rapidly increasing every year."¹³¹

4. On Sep. 22, 2007, the following statement appeared in the special edition of the *Zhongshan Hospital Newspaper* celebrating Fudan University Zhongshan Hospital's 70-year anniversary¹³²: "Currently, the hospital has completed a grand total of more than 2,000 cases of kidney transplants, more than 570 cases of liver transplants (11 cases of living-donor liver transplants), over 200 cases of heart transplants, 9 cases of combined heart and lung transplants and 13 cases of combined liver and kidney transplants. The number of organ transplants at the hospital is increasing rapidly every year. This will enable more and more patients with end-stage kidney, liver, heart and lung diseases to have a new lease on life."

It should be said that the above reports are mutually corroborating, and the development trend is consistent. **III. The transplant center has a strong transplant surgeons' team and the huge transplant volume** 1. The Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University had a strong transplantation team. According to the surgeons list released in 2014 by WOIPFG¹³³, there were 27 physicians in Kidney Transplantation Department, including 6 chief physicians or professors, 5 associate chief physicians or associate professors. As for Liver Transplantation Department, there were 10 chief physicians or professors, 9 associate chief physicians or professors. As for the Cardiac Surgery Department, there were 3 chief physicians or professors.

2. The number of transplants performed by individual doctors in the liver transplantation team reflects the huge practical number of transplants performed by the hospital.

Fan Jia is deputy director of Fudan University's Organ Transplant Center, a professor, and chief physician.¹³⁴ On April 16, 2001, Fan Jia finished his first liver-transplant surgery.¹³⁵ By December 2006, he had completed a total of more than 500 cases of liver transplants.¹³⁶ By 2012, he had completed over 1100 liver transplants.¹³⁷ Fan Jia, as the current president of Zhongshan Hospital, "He worked 80+ hours per week, and completed 100+ cases of liver transplant per year".¹³⁸

From the above team analysis, the hospital has at least 10 chief physicians, 9 associate chief physicians, and Fan Jia himself, as the president of Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University, must have many management and administrative matters to deal with, it is impossible for him to be the person who does the greatest number of surgeries. How about other doctors who can perform surgery? Let us see a few examples below.

Zhou Jian, the chief physician and professor of Organ Transplantation Center of Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University. As of June 2022, nearly 3,000 liver transplants have been completed.¹³⁹

Huang Xiaowu, the chief physician of liver tumor surgery, Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University, participated in nearly a thousand cases of liver transplants, and served as the group leader of liver transplant ward.¹⁴⁰

Qiu Shuangjian, the deputy director, chief physician and professor of liver tumor surgery, Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University, served as a principal member of the liver transplant team, has participated in the majority of liver transplants in Zhongshan Hospital, being the surgeon in 500 cases.¹⁴¹

Huang Cheng, the associate chief physician and associate professor of liver tumor surgery, Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University, has already participated in more than 500 cases of liver transplantation since 2002.¹⁴²

Shi Yinghong, the associate chief physician and associate professor of liver tumor surgery, Zhongshan Hospital of Fudan University, was involved in more than 400 cases of liver transplantation.¹⁴³

3. The number of kidney transplantation per year is much higher than that of liver transplantation

The above report shows that the hospital has done many liver transplants, and the following one shows that the hospital's annual transplant volume of kidney transplants is even higher.

a) According to published reports, the number of kidney transplants in this hospital is 4 to 5 times that of liver transplants.

In 2005, the hospital official website stated "Zhongshan Hospital has accumulated nearly a thousand cases of kidney transplant, and over 200 cases of liver transplant. The number of organ transplants are increasing rapidly every year."¹⁴⁴ The number of publicly reported kidney transplants is five times that of liver transplants.

On September 22, 2007, *Zhongshan Hospital Journal*, the hospital newspaper's special edition for the 70th Anniversary¹⁴⁵, mentioned "At present, the hospital has completed more than 2000 cases of kidney transplants in total, and over 570 cases of liver transplants. And the number of organ transplants is increasing every year." The number of publicly reported kidney transplants is nearly four times that of liver transplants.

b) The Hospital has strong kidney transplantation team.

There are 27 kidney transplant doctors, 6 senior titles (chief physician or professor), and 5 associate chief physicians, which can form multiple kidney transplant teams.

4. Hospital organ donor has been sufficient all the time

The hospital's official website claimed: "In recent years, due to the shortage of donors, the number of organ transplants in the country has generally decreased. However, the kidney transplant at Zhongshan Hospital is a standout¹⁴⁶. The number of kidney transplants has been increasing year by year."

From 2005 until July 24, 2014, the webpage of the hospital introduction was not changed¹⁵² with the same statement "Zhongshan Hospital has completed nearly 1,000 cases of kidney transplants and more than 200 cases of liver transplants. The number of organ transplants is increasing rapidly every year. ¹⁵³"

2. In September 2007, Zhongshan Hospital Journal, the hospital newspaper's 70 Anniversary special issue, mentioned that kidney transplant had reached over 2,000 cases.¹⁵⁴ But in July 2014, it changed to "the number of kidney transplant in Zhongshan Hospital already exceed 1,000 cases now."¹⁵⁵ How could the kidney transplants decrease?

From May 2000 to April 2011, "there were 298 cases of orthotropic heart transplantations carried out. 291 donor hearts were from cadavers, 7 hearts were from brain-dead donors. Donors were aged 18 to 45-years-old. Average age is $26.8(\pm 4.5)$. 283 were males and 15 females. All "donors" had no obvious history of cardiovascular diseases or other major organ diseases. The procuring methods of the hearts were the same as previously reported. Among these 298 cases, after 2007, 60 hearts were extracted when the donors had ventricular fibrillation or after the heart stopped beating, and the rest were extracted while the heart was still beating.¹⁵⁶

The authors indicated here that at least 231 healthy young people, while not brain dead and with their heart still beating, were put on hospital beds, and killed for their hearts.

On March 7, 2012, an article on qq.com quoted Huang Jiefu, "Organ shortage is the bottleneck for the development of our country's organ transplantation industry. Due to the lack of voluntary donations from citizens, organs from executed prisoners have become the main source of organ transplants. ¹⁵⁷" Huang Jiefu said in an interview with CCTV in July 2018 that the quality of the organs of executed prisoners is poor. The requirements for organ sources are very strict, and such organs cannot be obtained on the execution ground¹⁵⁸. Medical papers show that the quality of donor organs far exceeds that of executed prisoners, indicating that there are other sources of healthy donors.

The medical papers have the following descriptions: "None have a clear history of cardiovascular disease or other major organ diseases," "60 donor hearts were harvested in ventricular fibrillation or cardiac arrest, and the rest were harvested while the heart was still beating." These statements show that the quality of donor organs far exceeds that of executed prisoners, and the source of donors is dubious. Moreover, the article stated that 291 cases were hearts provided by cadavers, but most of them were obtained while the hearts were still beating, which also does not meet the situation of cadaveric donors.

Preface

Shanghai General Hospital is one of the hospitals in the city that carries out the largest variety and number of organ transplants. The official website reported in 2016 that since 2001, the hospital has consistently maintained the third place nationwide in the total number of annual liver transplants²⁰⁰. The development of the hospital's organ transplant business is in sync with the CCP's persecution of Falun Gong, and the source of organ donors is extremely rich. For example, Tan Jianming, Director of the Shanghai Organ Transplantation Research Center²⁰¹, used eight spare donor organs for a kidney transplant operation for a patient at the Shanghai General Hospital in 2003.²⁰²

Dr. Li Wengang, the subject of a telephone investigation in 2017, said, "President Peng Zhihai has done more than 5,000 cases (liver transplants), and in previous years was able to do more than 400 cases per year." When asked about the availability of Falun Gong donor in a telephone investigation in 2018, Peng Zhihai said, "No problem, no problem." In the broader context of the Chinese Communist Party (CCP)'s state crime of organ harvesting from living donors, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of organ harvesting from living members of Falun Gong and other groups.

Hospital Overview

hospital branches out into two parts, Hongkou and Songjiang, covering an area of about 295,000 square meters. There are 4206 employees, including 570 with senior titles and 1411 with Master's degree or above. There are 1820 approved beds. There are 68 clinical tertiary disciplines and medical-technical disciplines in the two northern and southern parts.²⁰³

I. One of the hospitals with the most types and numbers of organ transplants in the city

In August 2001, Shanghai Clinical Medical Center for Organ Transplantation was established and affiliated with Shanghai General Hospital. The Center, which started out with kidney transplantation, was established on the basis of Shanghai Organ Transplantation Research Center and Shanghai Tissue Matching Center. The hospital claims to have carried out various kidney transplants, heart transplants, liver transplants, combined liver-kidney transplants, combined pancreas-kidney transplants, combined kidney-adult islet cell transplants and other substantial large organ transplants, corneal transplants, allogeneic finger transplants, as well as fetal islet cell transplants, bone marrow transplants, a total of twelve major types²⁰⁴, and is one of the hospitals in the city carrying out the largest variety and number of organ transplants²⁰⁵. The Institute of Organ Transplantation of Shanghai Jiao Tong University is also located at Shanghai General Hospital²⁰⁶. The official website reported in 2016 that since 2001, the hospital has consistently maintained the third place nationwide in annual total number of liver transplants²⁰⁷.

II. The hospital used eight spare donor organs for one kidney transplant

Tan Jianming, director of the Shanghai Organ Transplantation Research Center ²⁰⁸, performed a kidney transplant on a patient at Shanghai General Hospital in 2003. During the following two weeks, this patient and four kidneys were tested for blood and other matches. Due to the patient's antibody reaction, none of the kidneys were a match and as a result all four kidneys were taken away. The patient returned to this hospital about two months later. Four more kidneys were brought in for similar testing; when an eighth kidney proved to be a match, the transplant was completed successfully. Dr. Tan told the organ recipient that the eighth kidney was from a death row inmate.²⁰⁹

III. The organ transplantation center carries out emergency liver transplant with sufficient donor sources

In 2002, the first emergency liver transplant in Shanghai was performed, and in 2004, the first emergency blood group incompatible liver transplant in China was successfully performed to treat acute liver failure. 10 cases have been completed so far, among which 4 cases were the first internationally reported blood group incompatible active consecutive second transplant.²¹⁰

IV. The team of liver and kidney transplant doctors is strong and the actual transplant volume is large.

The name list released by WOIPFG in 2014 includes the transplant doctors of the hospital.²¹¹ About the doctors specialized in kidney transplantation alone, We were able to find from the official website and papers that 31 of them did do the surgery, including 9 chief physicians, 5 associate chief physicians and 17 others. For liver transplant doctors, we can find from the official websites and papers 26 of them who did do the surgery, including 6 chief physicians, 5 associate chief physicians and 10 others. Multiple liver and kidney transplant teams can be formed.

Tan Jianming, director of the Shanghai Organ Transplantation Research Center.²¹² Tan used eight kidneys for matching for a kidney transplant at Shanghai General Hospital in 2003.²¹³ Tan had performed more than 4,200 kidney transplants as of June 2014.²¹⁴

Peng Zhihai was vice president of Shanghai General Hospital and director of the Shanghai Organ Transplant Center.²¹⁵ In April 2017, according to Li Wengang, a hepatobiliary surgeon at Xiamen No.174 Hospital, on a survey call, "Peng Zhihai from the transplant center at Shanghai Jiao Tong University has been here for a few days and is preparing for surgery at Xiamen University. President Peng Zhihai has done more than 5,000 cases (liver transplants) and was able to do more than 400 per year in previous years.²¹⁶"

V. Large number of organ transplant beds

The Department of Urology, with 3 exclusive wards (1 ward in the hospital's southern branch and 2 wards in the hospital's northern branch), has a total of 126 general beds (38 in the southern branch and 88 in the northern branch) and 20 non-fixed beds in the hospital's ICU, day ward and special needs ward of the International Medical Center. The department is a national clinical drug experimental base.²¹⁷ Kidney transplantation is the traditional strength of the urology department and is the core component of Shanghai Clinical Medical Center for Organ Transplantation (located in Shanghai General Hospital)²¹⁸.

The Department of General Surgery of Shanghai General Hospital is the organ transplantation center of Shanghai and the quality control center of liver transplantation of Shanghai. In recent years, the department with Prof. Peng Zhihai as its head, has carried out complex hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgery in the era of liver transplantation, and established a liver cancer treatment system integrating liver descending treatment - liver resection - liver transplantation - salvage liver transplantation and formed a clinical standard. At present, the Department of General Surgery has 5 wards with 243 beds in two sub-departments in the north and south, with hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgery, gastrointestinal surgery and breast and thyroid surgery under it²¹⁹.

VI. The hospital promotes liver transplantation to other medical units in Shanghai and across China

Shanghai General Hospital has promoted liver transplantation to other medical units in Shanghai as well as 11 provinces and 2 cities across China. The target units include: Renji Hospital of Shanghai Second Medical University, Xinhua Hospital of Shanghai Second Medical University, Ninth People's Hospital of Shanghai Second Medical University, Eastern Hospital of Shanghai Tongji University, Changhai Hospital of Shanghai Second Military Medical University, Eastern Hepatobiliary Hospital of Shanghai Second Military Medical University, Eastern Hepatobiliary Hospital of Shanghai Second Military Medical University, Eastern Hepatobiliary Hospital of Shanghai Second Military Medical University, Eastern Hepatobiliary Hospital of Shanghai Second Military Medical University, Beatern Hepatobiliary Hospital of Shanghai Second Military Medical University, Eastern Hepatobiliary Hospital of Shanghai Second Military Medical University, Shenzhen People's Hospital, Second Hospital of Shandong Medical University, Dongguan People's Hospital of Jiangxi Medical University, Hospital of Xi'an Medical University, Henan 153 Hospital, Wuxi Second People's Hospital, Henan 153 Hospital, Jiangsu Wuxi Second People's Hospital, Fujian Medical University Hospital, Qinghai Medical College Hospital, Guizhou Dujun People's Hospital, Hunan Medical University Xiangya Hospital, Xinjiang Medical University Cancer Hospital.²²⁰

Meng Jianzhu, the Secretary of the Jiangxi Provincial Party Committee, personally connected the First Affiliated Hospital of Nanchang University with the Shanghai Organ Transplant Center (First People's Hospital) to establish a joint and collaborative relationship.²²¹ The First Affiliated Hospital of Nanchang University had a record of completing six large organ transplants simultaneously in one day.²²²

VII. Doctors admitted organs used were from Falun Gong practitioners, and said that donors were available every day and were all living persons.

The following is a transcript of the conversation between a WOIPFG investigator and an anonymous doctor with the Liver Transplant Center of the First People's Hospital affiliated with Shanghai Jiao TongUniversity in a telephone investigation.

Investigator: I wanted to know how long the waiting time will be?

Doctor: We have donors, we have them every day. We are doing it today.
