China's Organ Transplant Organizations are the Executing Entities for the Communist Party's State Crime of Live Organ Harvesting

Since 1999, led by its then-leader Jiang Zemin, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) criminal group has been manipulating China's entire state apparatus, including the Party, government, military, armed police, judicial system, and medical institutions, through the Political and Legal Affairs Commission and the "610" system, to commit nationwide mass extermination of Falun Dafa practitioners by means of live organ harvesting for transplantation. The CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a crime against humanity and a crime of genocide initiated on the orders of Jiang Zemin.

Since the CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a state genocidal crime conducted as a political campaign, organ transplant institutions in all provinces, central government-controlled municipalities, and autonomous regions of mainland China, including all military, armed police, and local hospitals (medical centers) are suspected to have participated in this crime, even including a considerable number of hospitals unqualified to perform organ transplants, such as small and medium-sized hospitals and specialized hospitals. Similar to how all Chinese hospitals were involved in forced abortions during the CCP's implementation of the "one-child policy", all transplant facilities in China today have participated in live organ harvesting.

In view of the broader context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, those in charge of organ transplant hospitals/centers and similar institutions in China are suspected of having been involved in the crime of live organ harvesting from groups such as Falun Gong practitioners.

Evidence Collection Methods

1. Direct and indirect comprehensive telephone investigation and on-site investigation of the people suspected of involvement in the live organ harvesting

The subjects of our investigations include government officials, policemen, doctors and other medical personnel.

Geographical Distribution of the Subjects of Investigation, and the Duration of Investigations:

The WOIPFG's subjects of investigation are people in different positions, who are located across the entire country of China. Our investigations have been ongoing for nearly two decades, and our investigation results have always been consistent. The evidence gathered by us verifies that live organ harvesting is a systematic arrangement by the CCP.

- 1) Subjects of investigation: Presidents, directors, doctors, nurses, and security guards of organ transplant hospitals.
- 2) Hospitals involved: A considerable amount of recorded evidence has been obtained from many provincial, military, armed police, and local organ transplant hospitals (centers) across China.
- 3) Time span: Our investigations on the live organ harvesting started in 1999, and they're ongoing to this day.

2. Data investigation

- 1) We have been collecting data from the hospitals' websites and press releases.

- 2) We have been searching for and analyzing medical papers on transplantation.
- 3) We have been using the website www.archive.org to view the hospitals' previously archived information.
- 4) We have been collecting reports from the official Chinese media outlets.
- 5) We have organized all the information obtained from our investigations to create a database of the hospitals.

All the facts have shown us that the CCP is by no means a rational or normal organization or political party; but instead, it is a supra-state criminal syndicate controlled by a group of criminals who have committed crimes against humanity. The CCP's logic of thinking and principles of action are anti-human, and the crimes it has committed are forms of evil that humanity had never seen previously.

WOIPFG's investigative report series contains nearly 70 investigation reports on the alleged organ harvesting of living Falun Gong Practitioners at major Chinese military and civilian hospitals and on their staff members suspected of participation in this crime. This volume contains four such investigation reports.

Preface

China's military and police hospitals are the main perpetrators of the genocide of harvesting organs from living Falun Gong practitioners. Specifically, the hospitals affiliated to the Military Medical Universities are the principal actors of the crime. On September 30, 2014, WOIPFG's telephone investigation of Major General Bai Shuzhong, the director of the Health Division of PLA's General Logistics Department, proved the allegation to be true.¹

Xijing Hospital Affiliated to the Air Force Medical University is one of the suspects that committed the atrocities of forced organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners.

From the end of 2019 to the beginning of 2020, WOIPFG's investigators, posing respectively as a family member of a prospective patient and a WOIPFG investigator, conducted three-week telephone investigations of Dr. Li Guowei, a kidney transplant surgeon. The recorded phone conversation further confirmed that the practice of forced organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners has been continuing in China to this date.²

Hospital Overviews

The predecessor of the hospital was the Second Army Hospital of the Northwestern Military Region. In 1954, it was reorganized as the First Affiliated Hospital of the Fourth Military Medical University. In 1984, it was called "Xijing Hospital." In 1993, it was rated as a triple A hospital. In 2017, the Fourth Military Medical University was renamed as the Air Force Medical University, and accordingly, the hospital was renamed as the First Affiliated Hospital of the Air Force Medical University (publicly known as: Xijing Hospital of the Air Force Medical University).

According to its website, in 2013, the hospital's overall performance ranked in the Top 5 among all Chinese Hospitals.³ It has the qualifications to four organ transplant programs, namely heart, liver, lung, and kidney transplantation.⁴ The hospital has 6 national research priority programs, and 3,218 beds in total. The hospital covers an area of 430 mu (7.8 acres), with a construction area of 503,200 square meters.⁵

I. The Department of Hepatobiliary, Pancreas and Splenic Surgery becomes a Military Organ Transplant Center

The department has been recognized as a national research funding priority. In 2005, it became all-China Military Organ Transplant Center, which conducted liver and multiple organ transplantations.⁶ It has performed almost all types of liver transplants. In 1999, the first small bowel transplantation was performed here, in 2003, a pancreas-kidney joint transplantation (SPK), in 2005, a liver-kidney-pancreas joint transplantation, in 2006, the first face transplant operation in China (the second in the world), and in 2008, the first heart-liver-kidney joint transplantation in Asia.⁷

The Urology department of Xijing Hospital is the largest and the most comprehensive one in the Northwestern Area. It has a kidney transplant ward and Crossmatch laboratory services.⁸

II. Alarming numbers of single-day cardiac transplants

The hospital has set records twice for conducting 3 heart transplants consecutively in one day. Wang Hongbing, the deputy director of the Department of Cardiovascular Surgery, became one of the record keepers in China for performing the 3 heart transplants.⁹

Cai Zhenjie, the former Head of the Cardiovascular Surgery Institute in the Fourth Military Medical University and now the Head of the Cardiology Institute of the General Hospital of Armed Police, also completed 3 heart transplants on a single day in Sep. 2003.¹⁰

III. Sufficient beds in transplantation departments

The Urology Department of the Hospital has 80 beds in total.¹¹ The Department of Hepatobiliary and Pancreas Surgery has three wards and 150 beds, including a low-temperature laminar flow ward with the

transplant center.¹² So the departments involved in transplantation have a large number of beds and thus great potential for transplant surgery.

IV. A strong team of transplant surgeons

In 2014, WOIPFG released a name list of surgeons who participated in organ transplantation.¹³ From the information in the public domain, we found that in terms of kidney transplantation, 36 surgeons had performed such operations, among them 6 Chief Surgeons, 8 Deputy Chief Surgeons, 2 Attending Surgeons, and 20 assisting staff members.

In addition, in the Department of Hepatobiliary, Pancreatic and Splenic Surgery alone, there are 7 Professors, 5 Associate Professors, and 30 others.¹⁴ All the medical doctors in that department hold Doctorate Degrees. In total, there are 42 members on the staff. They form multiple liver and kidney transplantation teams.

V. WOIPFG's Phone Investigation of Xijing Hospital Engaging in Live Organ Harvesting¹⁵

From Dec 26, 2019 to Jan 15, 2020, World Organization to Investigate the Persecution of Falun Gong (WOIPFG) conducted an investigation on Li Guowei, a kidney transplant surgeon at Xijing Hospital Affiliated to the CCP's Air Force Medical University (formerly the Fourth Military Medical University). In the first four telephone inquiries, the investigator posed as the patient's family members looking for donated organs, and in the fifth call, in the capacity of WOIPFG investigator in an official verification of the case. Five phone recordings about the CCP's live organ harvesting have been obtained through our step-by-step investigation from multiple angles. The investigation result confirms once again that the CCP's organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners actually exists, and this heinous crime has not stopped and is still ongoing.

Our fourth phone investigation taking place on January 13, 2020 especially exposed several deeply hidden secrets of the CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners, as well as the party's long-standing lies of sourcing transplant organs from executed prisoners and voluntary donors through the Red Cross Society of China. The person under investigation acknowledged straightforwardly, "The organs come from Falun Gong practitioners", while in the CCP authorities' public statements, they have been described as young donors with high-quality and primary illness-free organs. He even claimed, "As long as you are daring enough, then at that time (i.e., when a Falun Gong practitioner donor becomes available)...as long as you dare to take a look, I can bring you to the bedside and let you have a look, that is, to let you see with your own eyes that this person is in his 20s."

In the end, the WOIPFG investigator revealed his identity and cautioned Li Guowei that he had perpetrated the crime against humanity and would eventually face a pathetic ending. The investigator advised him to atone for his sins and crimes by cooperating with the WOIPFG's investigation. However, he replied, "China is a one-party system. You don't need to tell me this stuff." His attitude also reflected the extent of the CCP's evil brainwashing, which would turn individuals into demons and has degraded the once highly-cultured China into a hell.

A WOIPFG investigator posing as a family member of a prospective patient, talked to Dr. Li Guowei at Xijing Hospital.

1. When the investigator asked Li Guowei to provide organs from Falun Gong practitioners, Li said: "We are also willing to use them! In the past, the government allowed hospitals to use the kidneys from executed prisoners. Those organs were really good. After we conducted the surgeries ourselves, we all knew that kind of organs were really good."
2. When asked about the organ sources, Li said: "The majority of the people are unwilling to donate now, and fewer and fewer people are willing to donate. Even if you have their written consent, if their family members disagree, the donation is invalid. The so-called allocation by the Red Cross Society are... it is totally just a verbal dictation from the officials!"
3. When asked about the price of a kidney transplant, Li said: "The kidney sources in Shaanxi are the cheapest. One costs around 100,000 yuan. Someone had already asked the organ transplant center in Tianjin, and the kidney source alone would cost 350,000 yuan in cash."

WOIPFG's Second Investigation on Li Guowei

Summary:

A different WOIPFG investigator continued to discuss with Li Guowei, posing as a different family member of the same prospective patient.

1. The investigator: "If you can help out, I can bring in the money with me in full amount." Li said: "It's not a problem for me to find this thing (Falun Gong organs) for you! I am in this department, so this is relatively easy for me to get it done."
 2. When talking about the quality of the donors, Li said: "I can get to know how old the donor is, if he has any intrinsic or pre-existing health conditions, whether he's healthy or not. I can get to know all those information, but you are not entitled to know!"
 3. When talking about the organ sources, Li said: "The competition is very fierce. It's not like what people said about the Red Cross Society that people get officially and randomly selected as recipients. It's not like that! You probably understand it even without me telling you." The investigator then said the Red Cross Society is "just a disguise". Li responded: "Right, right, it's just an official narrative."
 4. The investigator said that there were certain channels to source organs from Falun Gong practitioner and it's not absolutely impossible to get them. Li replied: "That, to be honest, is hard to tell. Can't tell the truth. (Laughter)." Li admitted that Red Cross is just a façade. He said: "The upper level explicitly doesn't allow it for the time being." The inference is it was allowed before.
 5. The investigator said: "You need to tell me the truth." And he asked him whether he could find Falun Gong practitioner's organs. Li replied: "Of course, I can find it for you. For sure, I can get it. Just that you need to spend more money. I can find it."
- The investigator: "You should look for the type (of organs) that Han Mei talked to you about. You can definitely find one, right?" Li replied: "Right, yes... I understand the type you are talking about."

1. Li said: " Under 30, don't have pre-existing health conditions. Most likely to get someone under 30. Although we are talking about under 30-year-olds, if you are lucky, we may find someone in his 20s, maybe younger than 20, between 15 and 20 years old. That's all possible!"
2. The investigator said: "About this kind of organs from Falun Gong, some of them may also be problematic. I heard they are beaten so badly when they are forced to be "transformed" and to write a guarantee. Some refuse to write it. They would go on hunger strikes, go through force-feeding, so their organs have been driven to the brink of failure."
- Li replied: "I know what you meant. As long as you are daring enough, I can bring you to the bedside to have a look. Then when we take out the organs, at the time of removing organs, you can't see it, because we would be in the operation room then....It's that when the time comes, I can let you have a look, to let you see with your own eyes that the person is in his 20s... I'm just afraid that you may be too timid to take a look. As long as you are dare enough to see it, you can."
3. The investigator asked: "Will the organs be removed in the hospital?" Li replied: "Yes , in the hospital. The investigator: "Immediately transplant it after the removal?"
- Li: "Yes. As soon as it's being removed, because if you need to fix something... all will be done in the hospital, not outside, such as small clinics, places like that. It's not the case right now. All the surgical treatments are done inside Xijing Hospital. We won't send you away to a villa outside of the hospital or other places. That won't happen. It did happen before."

WOIPFG's Fourth Investigation on Li Guowei

Summary:

1. Li: "All sources used by hospitals were from prisoners, all from prisoners."
- Investigator: "Prisoners, Falun Gong practitioners are called prisoners because they are locked in prisons, right?"
- Li: "How other people call them, we don't care. That is not something you or I should be concerned about. It has nothing to do with us!"
2. Investigator: "You perform (surgeries) and source organs from Falun Gong practitioners, but you cannot talk about it openly. You can only say that they are good-quality organs, with no pre-existing health conditions, and young, right?"
- Li: "Right, right, that's how we say it. It's correct for you to say that! (laughter)"
- Investigator: "Let's stop beating around the bush. You can find for us organs from Falun Gong practitioner, but officially, in public, we would just say those organs are of high-quality, no pre-existing health conditions, and young. That's it. Right? "
- Li: "Right, right, right."
- Investigator: "Alright! This is what you meant, right?"
- Li: "Yes, that's what I meant."
3. Investigator: "You said that the military system recently paused (organ transplants) for a little while. What's the reason?"
- Li: "Because recently the military has been auditing their books! Because you need to pay cash for the kidney sources in due course. Because at present, cases like yours are not allowed. The hospital does not allow cash transactions."

Summary:

During the first four investigations, the WOIPFG investigators approached Li under the pretense of being family members of a prospective patient. In the fifth investigation, the investigator formally identified himself as a WOIPFG member, in the hope that Li would atone for his crimes by cooperating with the investigation and exposing the truth.

1. Investigator: "I am telling you that we can give you an opportunity to make contributions to atone for your crimes. If you cooperate with our investigation to expose the dark secrets, you will make contributions and make atonement for the crimes that you've committed in the past due to the CCP's coerce and inducement. Do you understand what I'm saying now?"

Li Guowei: "I got it."

2. Investigator: "Could you accept and cooperate with our investigation to expose all the dark details to us?"

Li Guowei: "I can't."

Investigator: "Why?"

Li Guowei: "No reason. No reason."

3. Li Guowei: "As you said, which kind of people would be saved?"

Investigator: "Exposing the hidden secrets of forced organ harvesting from live Falun Gong practitioners, then they couldn't keep doing that anymore."

Li Guowei: "If they can't do that anymore, how about the survival of those patients waiting for organ transplants?"

Investigator: "The patients could follow the normal channels (to obtain donated organs) to survive. You can't kill those good people just because you want to survive. Can that be right?"

Li Guowei: "Who killed good people?"

Investigator: "Aren't Falun Gong practitioners good people?"

Li Guowei: "Falun Gong?"

Investigator: "Right. Falun Gong practitioners just follow their faith, right?"

Li Guowei: "Those things are none of my business. I am just an ordinary citizen. It's useless for you to tell me these stuffs."

Investigator: "But you have directly participated in the live organ harvesting. You've performed the transplant operations, and you are a participant."

4. Li Guowei: "Don't tell me these anti..anti-CCP theories. China is one-party system. Don't you tell me these!"

Conclusion:

1, The five recorded phone conversations further proved that the crime of harvesting organs from living Falun Gong practitioners actually exists, hasn't stopped, and is continuing.

2, The investigations on Jan 10, 11 and 13, 2020 exposed the lies from the CCP that all organ transplants in China were from voluntary donated organs. Dr. Li Guowei conceded that the Red Cross is just a disguise. He said that sourcing organs from Falun Gong is explicitly not allowed for the time being. The implication is it was allowed before. Now it's not allowed only temporarily or explicitly.

He also confessed that all the organs used in the transplants in the hospital were sourced from Falun Gong practitioners, but they can't talk about it openly. They could only say it's of high-quality without pre-existing health conditions. To prove to the prospective patients that the hospital is still sourcing organs from Falun Gong practitioners, he said that as long as you are dare enough, I can bring you to the bedside to have a look. Let you see with your own eyes the source is about in his 20s.

3, Li Guowei can tell so much details about the dark secrets of organ transplant which demonstrated that he has been engaging in forcibly removal organs for years, therefore, has committed the atrocities of organ harvesting from live Falun Gong practitioners.

Li Guowei is not only a kidney transplant surgeon, but he could also be a member of the Organ Procurement Organization (OPO) at Xijing Hospital. He should clearly know all the illegal channels to obtain organ sources at the hospital.

Li is not only a kidney surgeon, but also a member of the hospital's Organ Procurement Organizations. He has been fully aware how the hospital has been sourcing organs through various channels, but he has been evasive when talking about his involvement in killing innocent people. He defended himself with the argument of China is a one-party system. Don't tell me these!". He is so deeply involved in the CCP's crime against humanity that he's unable to extricate himself from it. He ignored the advice and warning from WOIPFG, and thus lost a rare opportunity to save himself.

VI. Investigation on Bai Shuzhong, former director of the Health Division for the Chinese People's Liberation Army's (PLA) General Logistics Department (GLD) ¹⁷

On September 30, 2014, a WOIPFG investigator called Bai Shuzhong, pretending to be a member of the Special Investigation Team working on Bo Xilai's case

Bai Shuzhong stated that it is Jiang Zemin who ordered to source organs from Falun Gong practitioners to supply the organ transplant surgeries. **"Several Military Medical Universities directly affiliated to our GLD requested that repeatedly as Jiang brought a lot of attention to the matter back then."**

Summary

In September 2014, when we investigated over phone on the former director of the Health Division of PLA's GLD, Bai Shuzhong, he confirmed that it is Jiang Zemin who ordered to source organs from Falun Gong practitioners for transplant surgeries. As the then top leader of the military health system, Bai Shuzhong played a key role in directly passing on the order of genocide from Jiang and implementing it in practice.

His term of office was between 1998 and 2004, which coincided with the peak time of the CCP's persecution against Falun Gong practitioners and its atrocities of live organ harvesting. Therefore, he has personal information about the situation and can explain it in detail.

The recorded telephone conversations confirmed that it was the then-head of CCP, Jiang Zemin, who ordered organ harvesting of living Falun Gong practitioners. Jiang and the former CCP top-level officials utilized the state power to launch a mass killing against Falun Gong practitioners all across China.

Foreword

The No. 307 Hospital of PLA is a tertiary level-A general institution that embodies medical treatment, teaching, and scientific research with a total of 1,500 beds.⁵² It is one of the first hospitals to be qualified for

kidney transplantation, and among the early ones that carried out large-scale kidney transplantation in the army.

On April 10, 2007, a WOIPFG member conducted a phone investigation of Chen Qiang the contact person for kidney source at the transplantation department of the No. 307 Hospital. Chen Qiang stressed that they have a chain operation involving authorities, police, and prison in handling Falun Gong practitioners' organs, and they can provide evidence proving the donors are Falun Gong practitioners.⁵³ The investigation proved that the No. 307 Hospital is on high suspicion of harvesting organs from living Falun Gong practitioners.

Following the publication of the phone recording, the content of transplantation center was removed from the hospital profile, and it is now known as the Urology Department. In fact not only has the No. 307 Hospital never stopped conducting kidney transplant operations, but also the kidney transplant center is the hospital's superior department.

I. Hospital Overview

What was later known as the No. 307 Hospital of the People's Liberation Army was founded in 1957 and had been named the Isotope Hospital of the National Ministry of Health. It was transferred to the military in 1958 and became an affiliated hospital to the Academy of Military Medical Sciences. In September 2005, the hospital moved from Beijing's Haidian District to Fengtai District. The area of the new hospital site and building area were both three times larger than the original, and the number of beds increased as well.⁵⁴

II. Kidney Transplant Center

According to a report of the official website of the hospital on August 10, 2014, Urology is one of the key departments of the hospital. The department has 80 beds. At that time, there were 23 clinicians, 2 director-level physicians, 5 deputy director-level physicians, 6 attending physicians, and 10 other physicians, including 1 tutor for Master's degree students and 1 tutor for Ph.D candidates.⁵⁵

According to a report of the official website of the Hospital on March 25, 2016, the kidney transplant center of the PLA No. 307 Hospital is able to carry out multiple types of kidney transplant surgeries, such as allogeneic kidney transplantation, relative's kidney transplantation, autologous kidney transplantation, kidney transplantation for elderly patients, and pediatric kidney transplantation.⁵⁶

1. Its kidney transplant center was established in 2000

With its kidney transplant center established in 2000, the hospital has completed nearly a thousand cases of allogeneic kidney transplantation and on multiple occasions provided kidney transplant guidance to hospitals outside Beijing.⁵⁷ The No. 307 Hospital of PLA is one of the military hospitals that performs kidney transplants early on a large scale.⁵⁸

2. Doctor from 307 Hospital: Now kidney transplant surgery is being performed every night at the No. 307 Hospital.⁵⁹

According to a report on Minghui.org on May 10, 2006, a doctor from the No. 307 Hospital stated that now kidney transplant surgery is being performed every night at the No. 307 Hospital. They don't know where so many kidney sources come from, and they don't understand why doctors must choose to do kidney transplants at night. After the operations, they transfer all the kidney transplant patients to other small hospitals nearby for post-op care.⁶⁰

III. Telephone investigation: Chen Qiang, contact person for kidney sources, acknowledged that they have a chain operation involving authorities, police, and prison in dealing Falun Gong practitioners' organs.

On April 10, 2007, 3:09 am to 3:28 am, a WOIPFG investigator spoke by phone with Chen Qiang, a contact person for kidney sources at the transplant department of the No. 307 Hospital of PLA. Chen stressed that dealings in Falun Gong practitioners' organs involved a chain operation among authorities, police, and prison, and documents confirming organ donors as Falun Gong practitioners can be provided too. Those practitioner donors who did not reveal their names would be given a code. ⁶¹

Investigator: Alright, but there is another thing that I am not completely clear about and don't quite understand. That is, these people are detained in forced labor camps or prisons. I know, usually it's in the local police station...

Chen Qiang: Nowadays very few are held in forced labor camps.

Investigator: Ok, but where are they usually detained now?

Chen Qiang: Now they are all held in prisons...all in prisons now. Usually, they are sent away from Beijing and transferred to prisons in other cities/provinces."

Investigator: You see, the 50,000 yuan in advance is no problem, just as I told you. I can give you 20,000 yuan extra to just make you feel secure. But about the total amount that'll have to be paid later, let me know a number, so that I feel more certain when I follow through.

Chen Qiang: About this...you'd say...eh...I have to use contacts to find it for you. The money they ask for specifically..., eh... it will be around 200,000 yuan. Do you understand?

Investigator: Right.

Chen Qiang: About Falun Gong...I later called them...I asked my boss to call them, who said they'd have to pull them out from there.

Investigator: Oh.

Chen Qiang: Now (the Falun Gong practitioners) have all been transferred to prisons in other cities/provinces. They (i.e. the officials) need to transfer (the organs) from there...so the money...a large portion of this money must be paid to the people over there, you know that?

Investigator: Yes. You know that, several years ago, they secretly detained many Falun Gong practitioners, who had gone to petition but did not provide their names. There were no records, no registrations.

Chen Qiang: Yes, it is quite normal, you know ... so they don't have their names—I am telling you—they only have code numbers, you understand?

Investigator: Yes.

Chen Qiang: If they could not find out their real names, they could just assign code numbers, you know.

Investigator: Oh.

Chen Qiang: And it's done according to their fingerprints...the person's fingerprints...it's done according to that, you know? It's all done this way now...in today's society, who'd have no...who'd have no...he'd have no way to have it done...especially things like this, you know it?

Investigator: Right.

Chen Qiang: I'm telling you that when such things are done—it's not that I don't want to tell you things – I can't tell you specifically what kind of people are involved and their names, you understand that?

Investigator: Right.

Chen Qiang: Such as people from above...the contacts in local police, I can't tell you about them. I can't handle this casually. How can I do it so casually? We are all well connected. Since I am doing this, so I have connections each step of the way. How can it be done without connections?

Investigator: That's right, I just...

Chen Qiang: With such things, it's all a chain operation, you know it?

Investigator: Right.

IV. Witness testimony

Falun Gong practitioner Yu Ming went to three organ transplant hospitals in Beijing in November 2018. Shown in the video he took at the risk of his life were: the General Hospital of the Armed Police, the No. 309 Hospital of the People's Liberation Army, and the No. 307 Hospital of the People's Liberation Army.

Yu Ming said that in the No. 307 Hospital of the People's Liberation Army in Beijing, doctors obviously have been trained in specific ways to deal with people who come to investigate organ transplants. "We can see that many things are strictly confidential here. When we asked about the organ transplant price and waiting time, he [a hospital representative] immediately became alert."⁶²

Personal Profile: Chen is the Director of the Department of Urology and director-level doctor of the No. 307 Hospital of the PLA. He is also the youth member of the PLA Organ Transplant Committee.

He graduated from the Medical Department of Shanghai Second Military Medical University in July 1987, and obtained a doctor of medicine degree from the General Hospital the PLA in 1998.

From 1998 to 2000, he was engaged in post-doctoral research at Kansas University Medical Center in the United States.

After returning to China in 2000, he established the Kidney Transplant Center in the 307 Hospital of the PLA to carry out allogeneic kidney transplantation, living donor kidney transplantation between relatives, and autologous kidney transplantation due to renal artery stenosis, totaling more than 200 cases.⁶³

Personal Profile: Qu is the attending physician of the Department of Urology, the No. 307 Hospital of the PLA.

WOIPFG's Investigative Report on the Alleged Organ Harvesting of Living Falun Gong Practitioners at Changzheng Hospital (Affiliated with the PLA Second Military Hospital) and Its Staff Members Suspected of Participation

Preface

The Organ Transplant Center of this hospital is the first organ transplant research institute established by the CCP military. It has a large volume of organ transplants, including emergency liver transplants, and the waiting time for donors is extremely short. The shortest waiting time is 4 hours after admission for liver transplantation. During the three years from 2003 to 2006, Changzheng Hospital performed 120 cases of emergency liver transplantation. Warm ischemia time is zero or extremely short. In view of the background of the CCP's crime of live organ harvesting, the CCP's military and armed police hospitals are the main force of the CCP's live organ harvesting, especially the affiliated hospital of the Military Medical University is the key suspected criminal unit. On September 30, 2014, WOIPFG confirmed this fact through the recording of the telephone investigation of Major General Bai Shuzhong, the former head of the Health Department of the General Logistics Department of the CCP's military⁶⁸. Therefore, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners.

I. General Information about the Hospital

Shanghai Changzheng Hospital (Changzheng Hospital of the Second Military Medical University, the second affiliated hospital of the Second Military Medical University of the Chinese People's Liberation Army) is a general tertiary Class A hospital integrating medical care, education and scientific research. The hospital is located at No. 415, Fengyang Road, Huangpu District, Shanghai, and the Nanjing Branch is at No. 200, Jianning Road, Nanjing. The hospital is staffed as a divisional unit, the leaders and cadres of the hospital are active-duty military officers, and the professional and technical personnel on the staff are the active-duty civilian cadres. Today, the hospital has a total construction area of 229,990 square meters, among which 110,099 square meters are for medical care and work, and 119,891 square meters are for daily life. 1574 beds have been opened, among which 1074 are in the hospital headquarters and 500 are in the Nanjing branch. It is equipped with the organ transplantation institute of People's Liberation Army ⁶⁹.

1. The Organ Transplant Center of the Changzheng Hospital is the first organ transplantation institute of PLA

The Organ Transplant Center of Changzheng Hospital is the first organ transplantation institute of PLA. It was established in early 2003 by combining a kidney transplantation group in the Department of Urology and a liver transplantation group in the Department of General Surgery of the Changzheng Hospital. It was approved on December 17, 2003, as the first PLA research institute of organ transplant, by the PLA Department of General Logistics.⁷⁰ It is now the highest level organ transplantation institution in the military, combining medical treatment, teaching and research. It has carried out many kinds of transplantations, such as kidney, liver, heart, simultaneous liver-kidney transplantations, and simultaneous pancreas-kidney transplantations. The number of transplantation cases ranked among the top in China. The Organ Transplantation Research Institute made medical advances in adult liver transplantation, adult kidney transplantation, pediatric liver transplantation, pediatric kidney transplantation, live liver transplantation, live kidney transplantation, liver and kidney joint transplantation, pancreas and kidney joint transplantation.⁷¹ The Organ Transplantation Center of the Second Military Medical University was also set up in the Changzheng Hospital, and so was the “Shanghai Kidney Transplantation Quality Control Center.”⁷²

2. The hospital has great potential for organ transplants with the capacity to perform thousands of transplants every year

The Organ Transplant Center of Changzheng Hospital had 120 beds in 2014. It has a liver transplantation, kidney transplantation, liver and gallbladder surgery clinic, hospitalization ward, and an organ transplantation rehabilitation ward. It has 6 labs including tissue matching, medicine concentration monitoring, organs storage, animal testing, transplantation immunology and transplantation pathology.⁷³

Based on this figure, if the bed turnover rate is 100% (the average bed occupancy rate in the national Grade-A Tertiary Hospitals is as high as 103%⁷⁴), and if the hospitalization time for liver and kidney transplant is 30 days, the hospital has the potential to perform more than 1,460 ($120 \times 365 \times 100\% / 30 = 1460$) cases of liver and kidney transplants per year. (Calculation method: number of ward beds X number of days in a year X bed turnover rate/average hospitalization time for liver and kidney transplant = number of liver and kidney transplants performed per year)

3. The liver and kidney transplantation team is large and they can form several transplantation groups

The Transplantation Center of the Changzheng Hospital Affiliated with the PLA Second Military Medical University has a staff of over 60 people, among which 15 are senior members.⁷⁵ In the kidney transplantation division, there are 6 chief surgeons, 6 deputy chief surgeons, 2 attending surgeons, and 15 other staff members. In the liver transplantation division, there are 2 chief surgeons, 5 deputy chief surgeons, 1 attending surgeons, and 22 other staff members. They can form several groups to carry out liver and kidney transplantations. In 2014, WOIPFG published a list of transplantation doctors in the hospital. From the official websites and published articles, we can verify 59 doctors who carried out liver and kidney transplantations.⁷⁶ Zhu Youhua, director of the Organ Transplantation Center of the Shanghai Changzheng Hospital, carried out at least 3,680 kidney transplantations by 2010.⁷⁷ He also carried out 5 kidney transplantations in a single day.⁷⁸

Min Zhilian, chief surgeon of the Department of Urology, had performed over 2600 kidney transplantations according to public information in 2014.⁷⁹

Fu Zhiren, director of the Organ Transplantation Department of the Changzheng Hospital had completed over 1,240 cases of liver transplantation, according to public information in 2014.⁸⁰

Ding Guoshan, professor and chief surgeon at the Organs Transplantation Center had carried out over a thousand liver transplants according to internet public information in 2013⁸¹.

4. The number of organ transplantation in Changzheng Hospital is large

The Organ Transplantation Center's official website claims, that in the 9-day period from April 22 to April 30 2005, the Center carried out 16 liver transplantations and 15 kidney transplantations.⁸²

III. The Source of the Live Organs

According to the telephone investigation conducted in September 2014 on Bai Shuzhong who served as the director of the Health Division of the Chinese People's Liberation Army (PLA) General Logistics Department between 1998 and 2004, it can be concluded that most of the affiliated hospitals of the CCP's Military Medical Universities have participated in live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners, one of which is the Second Affiliated Hospital of the PLA's Naval Medical University (a.k.a. Affiliated Changzheng Hospital of the Second Military Medical University).

On September 30, 2014, a WOIPFG investigator called Bai Shuzhong, in the name of Bo Xilai's project team.

Bai Shuzhong, former director of the Health Division for the Chinese People's Liberation Army's (PLA) General Logistics Department.

He served as the director of the Health Division of the Chinese People's Liberation Army (PLA) General Logistics Department between 1998 and 2004. That period was the peak time of the CCP's persecution of Falun Gong practitioners and its crime of live organ harvesting. The Army plays a key role in live organ harvesting. As the supreme medical executive leader, Bai should be one of those who knew the situation then best.

Investigator: "When you were the director of the health division for the PLA General Logistics Department, regarding excising organs from captivated Falun Gong people for organ transplantation, was it an order from Wang Ke, the then-director of the PLA General Logistics Department, or did it directly come from the Central Military Commission?"

Bai: "Back then, it was President Jiang. There was an order, a sort of instruction. It said to start carrying out this thing, which is organ transplantation. I should say, it was not just the military that was doing kidney transplants."

Investigator: "We also obtained some information, that is, back then, the Joint Logistics Departments (of the Military Regions) were responsible for detaining a batch of Falun Gong people as live organ donors, right?"

Bai Shuzhong: "At least according to what I remember, after President Jiang issued the instruction, we all did a lot of anti-Falun Gong work, because President Jiang paid a lot of attention to this matter and took this matter very seriously."

The recording clearly indicates that the live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners was directly ordered by Jiang Zemin, and more than one government/CCP system besides the military was involved in live organ harvesting.

This telephone recording affirms the weight of the evidence WOIPFG has acquired from the military, armed police, regional government agencies and the judiciary and legal systems. All of these entities are suspected of directly participating in the crime of live organ harvesting. It also expounds on the reasons behind this issue and confirms the judgment WOIPFG has made based on the collected evidence.

IV. Short Waiting Time, and Capable of Performing Emergency Transplantation

1. The Transplantation Center carries out emergency liver transplantation, with waiting time as short as 4 hours

The organ transplantation center of Changzheng Hospital has adequate donors for emergency liver transplantation, with an average waiting time of 1 week and the shortest waiting time being 4 hours. During

the 3 years from 2003 to 2006, Changzheng Hospital carried out 120 cases of emergency liver transplantation. The recipients were serious hepatitis patients, with the average survival time being 3 days after hospitalization. "Emergency liver transplantation is the only way. The shortest waiting time of liver transplantation was 4 hours after patient was admitted to the hospital."⁸³ The hospital clearly has the ability to obtain live donor organs quickly.

移植的成功率越来越高。近 3 年我科采用急诊肝移植方法治疗了 120 例重型肝炎患者，总成功率达到 76.2%。

1. 重视术前调理：术前调理有两个目的：使患者能够等到供体；使患者降低手术风险，加快术后各脏器功能恢复。术前调理的众多措施中我们认为较为重要的有以下几点：①纠正内直接影响术后的恢复；②改善肝脏缺血缺氧的病理状况（应用生大黄、杜松克或白醋灌肠以降血氨，用小剂量甘露醇或甘油果糖降低颅内压，用大量 6-氨基酸或雅博思以醒脑），使患者术后易于配合，利于早期恢复；③保护肾功能，预计肾功能较难恢复的可直接行肝肾联合移植；④术前严重感染的防治。

On the name list of the Shanghai Changzheng Hospital, the section to introduce Ma Jun claims: Up to now, he has completed over 1,240 cases of liver transplantation processing around the operations (including over 300 cases of serious hepatitis).⁸⁴

2. The official website shows that the average liver organ wait time in Shanghai Changzheng Hospital's Transplant Center is one week

Shanghai Changzheng Hospital's transplant center clearly stated on its liver transplant application form that the average wait time for a liver transplant was one week⁸⁵.

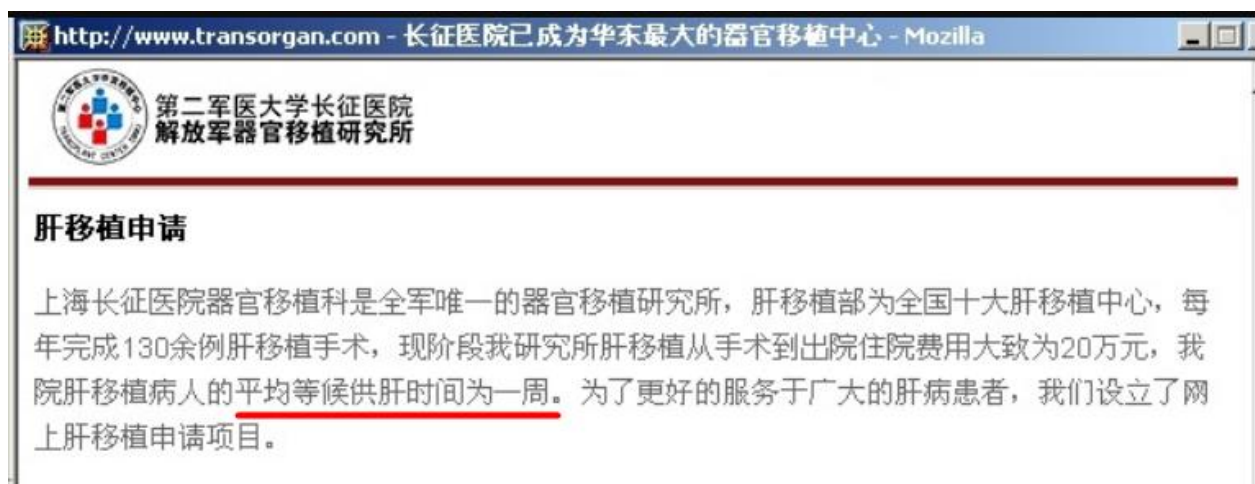


Figure 4 Online liver transplant application form of the organ transplant center at Shanghai Changzheng Hospital.

V. The number of organ transplantations is big at the Changzheng Hospital

1. Clearwisdom.net issued an urgent announcement on April 6, 2006 in which it says, “Falun Gong practitioners in underground concentration camps, including Sujiatun Camp, have been secretly relocated and are subject to slaughter at any time. Meanwhile some hospitals in China have suddenly increased the number of transplant operations. Apparently a massacre with the purpose of exterminating all witnesses of such extermination camps is taking place right now in China.” The journalists called the transplantation centers of many big hospitals, and most of the doctors told that there would be a big number of donors before the end of April and after this time it would become small.

Shanghai Changzheng Hospital confirmed once again that there would be a lot of organ donors in April.

Doctor: “There will be quite many donors in late April. The donors are coming one after another, but you need to grasp the chance, you know? After this period there will be much fewer of them. After April, there will be none in some period of May, because there are materials. If you don’t do it when there are materials, you are forcing yourself into a dead end when there are no materials.”

Shanghai Changzheng Hospital:

Reporter: “Do you have organs from healthy people in their 20-30’s?”

Doctor: “Yes, we do.”

Reporter: “Do you have blood type AB?”

Doctor: “There should be some. They will be available soon.”

Shanghai Changzheng Hospital indicated that the number of patients increased significantly recently and all the big hospitals were working overtime to do organ transplantations.

Doctor: “There are 30 people in the queue waiting for the transplantation.”

Reporter: “Are you working overtime to do it?”

Doctor: “Yes, yes! We have several groups of doctors. We can do 24 hours a day because we have 4 groups to take turns.”

When asked about the source of the organs, the doctor at Shanghai Changzheng Hospital said: “We have a unified source from the state. Regarding this, well, only doctors know about it.”^{86 87}

2. Director Zhu Youhua of the Kidney Transplant Center of Shanghai Changzheng Hospital (January 29, 2016) said in the phone investigation conducted by WOIPFG: “We do kidney transplants every day. We are doing it now, and patients are still in operation. It is not only that we are doing this, the whole country is doing a lot!”⁸⁸

3. The nurse at the expert appointment hotline of Changzheng Hospital said in the phone investigation conducted by WOIPFG on November 28, 2019: “We can do kidney transplantation. We have Doctors Wang Liming and Wang Yawei who can see patients on Thursday, and Doctor Han Shu who can see patients on Monday afternoon. It is a bit hard to get a bed.”⁸⁹

VI. Medical Papers Show Evidence of Changzheng Hospital Participating in Live Organ Harvesting

The medical paper published in “Shanghai Medicine” in November 2004 shows that from October 2001 to September 2004, Changzheng Hospital performed 240 liver transplants, with warm ischemia time of the donor livers being 0-8 minutes⁹⁰. If the organ donors were already corpses when the livers were being

extracted, how could the warm ischemia time be zero? The warm ischemia time is zero or ultra-short, so organ harvested from living donors is suspected. The reasons are as follows:

The warm ischemia time is zero, which means that when the organ is harvested, there is a heartbeat and blood supply. That is, live organ harvesting. Generally, it can only be done in a brain-dead state or by harvesting organs from living people.

In principle, there are no "brain-dead donors" or organs harvested from "brain-dead donors" in China that have a zero or ultra-short warm ischemia time.

Personal Profile: Chief Surgeon, professor, currently the director of the PLA's organ transplantation research institute, Ph.D supervisor, Chairman of the PLA's Organ Transplant Professional Committee, standing member of the Organ Transplantation Committee of the Chinese Medical Association, standing member of the China Dialysis and Transplantation Research Association, deputy editor of the Chinese Journal of Organ Transplantation, editorial board member of the Journal of the Second Military Medical University, and director of Shanghai Kidney Transplant Quality Control Center.

Zhu was born in June 1952. He graduated from the Department of Military Medicine of the Second Military Medical University in 1976. He has been conducting basic and clinical research of urologic surgery and kidney transplantation for more than 30 years.⁹¹

Foreword

The number of kidney transplants in Nanfang Hospital Affiliated with Southern Medical University has ranked the second in the country for many years, and the Department of Hepatobiliary Surgery has done the most liver transplants in Guangdong Province. The transplant doctor disclosed in the investigation by WOIPFG that the waiting time for a donated organ is short here, the hospital was given priority to receive liver donations, and the director does surgery for overseas patients only. The hospital is the first foreign-related medical center of the Chinese army, serving as a tool for the United Front and providing special services for wealthy merchants. One of the doctors said, "Our (real) human skin supplies are excessive" In the general context of the CCP's state crime of organ harvesting, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners as well as members of other groups.

Hospital Overview: The hospital is a tertiary level-A, general hospital. It covers an area of 203,000 square meters and has 2,225 beds. There are 4,271 professional and technical personnel, including 603 senior professional and technical positions, 118 doctoral tutors, and 131 master tutors. There are 28 experts who enjoy special government allowances from the State Council.¹²⁰

I. It is the CCP's first military hospital that provides organ transplant service to foreigners

The First Affiliated Hospital of the First Military Medical University of the People's Liberation Army (PLA) was handed over to Guangdong Province by the army in August 2004 and renamed Nanfang Hospital Affiliated to Southern Medical University¹²¹. In March 1995, the hospital was awarded the honorary title of "Model Medical Relief for Overseas Chinese" by Jiang Zemin. It is the only "medical center that treats foreigners" in the army and became a tool for the CCP to use organ transplantation to befriend overseas Chinese and other nations in the world. The hospital is a Grade A kidney transplant, Grade A liver transplant and Grade B heart transplant unit promulgated by Guangdong Province in 2004¹²² As of the end of 2006, it "has provided hospitalizations and physical examinations for nearly 70,000 patients from more than 70 countries and regions".¹²³ On May 23, 2007, it was designated by the Ministry of Health as the hospital for carrying out kidney transplantation and liver transplantation.¹²⁴

II. It is the main hospital for the CCP's military to harvest organs from living Falun Gong practitioners

Bai Shuzhong, who served as the head of the Department of Health, PLA General Logistics Department from 1998 to 2004, directly admitted during WOIPFG's telephone investigation that during his tenure in office, Jiang Zemin personally ordered the organ harvesting of living Falun Gong practitioners, and that the Affiliated Hospital of Military Medical University was the major hospital that carries out Jiang Zemin's order in the military system.¹²⁵ (Recording 1: [MP3](#); Transcript Download: [pdf16](#))

"It was Chairman Jiang at that time", "who had an instruction that said", "to conduct organ transplantation", and instructed that "(It) could be managed by these military medical universities. Several military medical universities directly under the PLA General Logistics Department had repeatedly requested the approval (for carrying out organ transplantation), because at that time Jiang paid great attention to this issue and attached great importance to it."

III. There are many transplant teams, including multiple kidney and liver transplant working groups

The hospital has a strong transplant team. In the kidney transplant department and liver transplant surgery department, there are 57 liver and kidney surgeons. There are multiple kidney transplant teams and multiple liver transplant teams:

The kidney transplant department currently has more than 30 medical staff, including 2 professors, 6 associate professors or deputy chief surgeons, and 4 attending surgeons. Most of them have doctorate degrees.¹²⁶ In 2014, WOIPFG released the list of transplant doctors in this hospital. We can find from the official website and papers that, among the doctors who are specialized in liver transplantation alone, there are 27 of them who have actually performed surgery¹²⁷, including 4 chief surgeons, 2 deputy chief surgeons, 4 attending surgeons, and 16 other surgeons.

IV. The number of kidney transplants has ranked second in China for many years

1. In November 2001, 2,123 kidney transplants were done

Yu Lixin, the head of the hospital's kidney transplantation, claimed in his paper "Progress in Clinical Allograft Kidney Transplantation in China" published in *Armed Police Medical Science* in 2004 that as early as November 2001, the hospital had completed 2,123 kidney transplants.¹²⁸ This hospital, second only to Beijing Friendship Hospital, is No. 2 on the list in the nation.

In July 2009, the hospital's official website still claimed that kidney transplantation ranked second in China and first in Guangdong Province.¹²⁹ From this, it can be seen that the hospital has long ranked second in the country in terms of the number of kidney transplants.

2. The annual kidney transplants in 2002 and 2003 were as high as 500 cases per year, and that number would be even greater during the peak period

According to Yu Lixin's paper, the average annual transplant volume of the hospital from December 2001 to August 2003 was 501 cases per year. According to the nationwide explosive growth of the organ transplant volume in 2004 and 2005, the hospital's kidney transplant volume during the peak period can be estimated to be even greater.

As *Yangcheng Evening News* reported on August 2003, Yu Lixin said: "From the completion of the first human kidney transplant in 1978 to August 2003, more than 3,000 kidney transplants have been performed.¹³⁰ As mentioned in the above report, Yu Lixin said: "As of November 2001, the hospital had completed 2,123 kidney transplants".¹³² From this, it can be calculated that from December 2001 to August 2003, the hospital witnessed an increase of more than 877 kidney transplants (3000-2123=877) in one year and 9 months, with an average of at least 501 cases per year [877/ (1+9/12) =501].

After 2000, China saw an explosive grow in the number of organ transplants, and Nanfang Hospital is no exception. Let us illustrate with the following two examples:

Online media Sina reported in Dec. 2003: the Organ Transplant Center at Fudan University with its total number of organ transplants cases reaching 100 per year and an annual growth rate of 50 percent, co-founded the "Fudan University Zhongshan Hospital—US Pittsburg University Thomas E. Starzl Collaborating Transplant Research Center" on Dec. 8, 2003, with the world's largest organ-transplant institute and stated it was "looking forward to reaching new milestones in the area of organ transplantation."¹³³

The number of kidney transplants announced by The First Central Hospital of Tianjin exceeded 300 in 2004.¹³⁴ It was stated in the year-end summary meeting of the Oriental Organ Transplant Center 2005 that, in 2005, a total of 436 kidney transplants were completed.¹³⁵ The rate of increase in the number of kidney transplants is close to 50%.

The number of kidney transplants announced by Nanfang Hospital of Southern Medical University in 2003 had reached 501 cases per year. 2004 and 2005 saw explosive growth in the number of organ transplants in China. The hospital's annual kidney transplant volume in 2004 and 2005 was estimated to be even greater.

V. The Department of Hepatobiliary Surgery is the unit with the largest number of liver transplant cases in Guangdong Province

The Department of Hepatobiliary Surgery of Nanfang Hospital is one of the largest liver transplant centers in Guangdong Province.¹³⁶ The Liver Transplant Center of the Third Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University, located in Guangdong province too, is also one of the units that carry out large number of liver transplants. On February 23, 2006, *Southern Magazine* stated that in 2005, Chen Guihua, the director of the Third Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University, completed 246 liver transplants in one year.¹³⁷ The number of liver transplantation of Hepatobiliary Surgery of Nanfang Hospital should be similar to that of the Affiliated Third Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University. Chen Guihua completed 246 liver transplants in only

one year, in spite of his busy administrative and management schedules as the hospital's director. Considering there are 27 surgeons engaged in liver transplants,¹³⁸ multiple liver transplant teams could be formed in Nanfang Hospital.

Phone recordings show that four teams of liver transplants could be formed in the hospital.¹³⁹

VI. The hospital provides organs to local hospitals; "(real) human skin sources are inexhaustible"

1. Peng Xuemei, an anesthesiologist at the First Affiliated Hospital of Jinan University who has been working partnership with Ding Hongwen in transplant operation, said that there are many sources of organ donations, and Nanfang Hospital with a military background is one of them.¹⁴⁰

The Kidney Transplantation Department of the People's Hospital of Yiyang City claims: "With the full cooperation of the General Hospital of the PLA and the Kidney Transplant Center of the Affiliated Hospital to the First Military Medical University, the best kidney is selected. To choose the most suitable type, a comprehensive examination of the donor kidney is conducted in advance, and strict checks are implemented to ensure the best matching of the donated kidney. " ¹⁴¹

2. The hospital provides special services for tycoons and billionaires

A former official who once worked for a long time in China's Guangdong Federation of Returned Overseas Chinese recently disclosed to The Epoch Times that as early as the 1980s, the CCP was already using the "Nanfang Hospital" (The Affiliated Hospital of the First Military Medical University of the People's Liberation Army, militarily coded as the 157 Hospital) to harvest organs from death row prisoners for transplantation. They use the personal connections of this special group of overseas Chinese, as a tool for the United Front, to provide special services for tycoons and billionaires, and at the same time to make huge profits.¹⁴²

3. "We have more (real) human skins than needed"

An insider said: "Nanfang Hospital is an Affiliated Hospital to the First Military Medical University of PLA. At that time, there was no foreign currency exchange in China, and vouchers were required for internal organs replacements and organ transplants. In the 1980s, the hospital set up an agent department of Huiqiao Building in Hong Kong, which directly accepted Hong Kong dollars and made a lot of money. Soon another new building was built for business expansion in 1988 "

Once at lunch, a doctor from Hebei who worked in the Nanfang Hospital said to us: Don't let others know, let alone the US government, that our (real) human skin supplies are inexhaustible."¹⁴³

VII. Bai Lan, a former consultant of China General Chamber of Commerce, went to this hospital for a kidney transplant, because organs are easy to obtain¹⁴⁴

Bai Lan, a consultant to China General Chamber of Commerce who returned from mainland China after kidney transplant, died suddenly on September 18, 2016. Relatives and friends said she died of "health reasons". It was Nanfang Hospital that persuaded Bai Lan to perform a kidney transplant in Guangzhou.

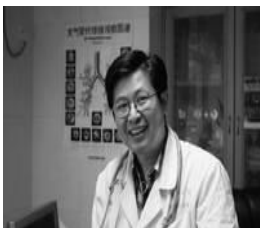

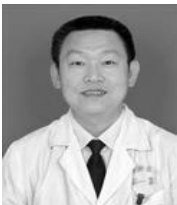
