## China's Organ Transplant Organizations are the Executing Entities for the Communist Party's State Crime of Live Organ Harvesting

Since 1999, led by its then-leader Jiang Zemin, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) criminal group has been manipulating China's entire state apparatus, including the Party, government, military, armed police, judicial system, and medical institutions, through the Political and Legal Affairs Commission and the "610" system, to commit nationwide mass extermination of Falun Dafa practitioners by means of live organ harvesting for transplantation. The CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a crime against humanity and a crime of genocide initiated on the orders of Jiang Zemin.

Since the CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a state genocidal crime conducted as a political campaign, organ transplant institutions in all provinces, central government-controlled municipalities, and autonomous regions of mainland China, including all military, armed police, and local hospitals (medical centers) are suspected to have participated in this crime, even including a considerable number of hospitals unqualified to perform organ transplants, such as small and medium-sized hospitals and specialized hospitals. Similar to how all Chinese hospitals were involved in forced abortions during the CCP's implementation of the "one-child policy", all transplant facilities in China today have participated in live organ harvesting.

In view of the broader context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, those in charge of organ transplant hospitals/centers and similar institutions in China are suspected of having been involved in the crime of live organ harvesting from groups such as Falun Gong practitioners.

### Evidence Collection Methods

#### 1. Direct and indirect comprehensive telephone investigation and on-site investigation of the people suspected of involvement in the live organ harvesting

The subjects of our investigations include government officials, policemen, doctors and other medical personnel.

Geographical Distribution of the Subjects of Investigation, and the Duration of Investigations:

The WOIPFG's subjects of investigation are people in different positions, who are located across the entire country of China. Our investigations have been ongoing for nearly two decades, and our investigation results have always been consistent. The evidence gathered by us verifies that live organ harvesting is a systematic arrangement by the CCP.

- 1) Subjects of investigation: Presidents, directors, doctors, nurses, and security guards of organ transplant hospitals.
- 2) Hospitals involved: A considerable amount of recorded evidence has been obtained from many provincial, military, armed police, and local organ transplant hospitals (centers) across China.
- 3) Time span: Our investigations on the live organ harvesting started in 1999, and they're ongoing to this day.

### 2. Data investigation

- 1) We have been collecting data from the hospitals' websites and press releases.

- 2) We have been searching for and analyzing medical papers on transplantation.
- 3) We have been using the website [www.archive.org](http://www.archive.org) to view the hospitals' previously archived information.
- 4) We have been collecting reports from the official Chinese media outlets.
- 5) We have organized all the information obtained from our investigations to create a database of the hospitals.

All the facts have shown us that the CCP is by no means a rational or normal organization or political party; but instead, it is a supra-state criminal syndicate controlled by a group of criminals who have committed crimes against humanity. The CCP's logic of thinking and principles of action are anti-human, and the crimes it has committed are forms of evil that humanity had never seen previously.

WOIPFG's investigative report series contains nearly 70 investigation reports on the alleged organ harvesting of living Falun Gong Practitioners at major Chinese military and civilian hospitals and on their staff members suspected of participation in this crime. This volume contains four such investigation reports.

year.<sup>3</sup>The development of organ transplantation is in sync with the CCP's persecution of Falun Gong. Combined with the background of the CCP's national crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners, Peking University People's Hospital is seriously suspected to be a key unit that harvests organs from living Falun Gong practitioners.

#### I. Hospital Profile

Peking University People's Hospital was established in 1918. It is currently a comprehensive tertiary A hospital with medical, teaching and scientific research capabilities. It is an affiliated hospital and second clinical medical school of Peking University under the National Health Commission, PRC's supervision.<sup>4</sup> Its Organ Transplant Center was launched in October 2001 and was then renamed as Peking University Organ Transplantation Institute.

#### II. Profile of Organ Transplant Center

Peking University Organ Transplant Center ("the Center") was transformed to Peking University Organ Transplantation Institute ("the Institute"). It was established upon the personal instruction of Han Qide, then Vice Chairman of the Standing Committee of National People's Congress of the PRC, in October 2001. It was composed with five medical institutions under Peking University including Peking University First Hospital, People's Hospital and Peking University Third Hospital.<sup>5</sup> According to the hospital, the center is currently the largest organ transplant medical institution in China with the highest academic level. The Center has become one of the most influential organ transplant centers and leads in many aspects in China.<sup>6</sup>

For the medical practice and research of liver, kidney, pancreas, heart, corneal and bone marrow transplant, The Center got several national and provincial grants, including the Special Fund for Scientific Research in the Public Interest by Ministry of Health of the PRC, 973 fund, grant of National Natural Science Foundation, and Specialized Research Fund for the Doctoral Program of Higher Education by Ministry of Education of the PRC etc. The grants totaled over 20 millions in 2013.<sup>7</sup>

#### III. Enormous liver and kidney transplants with 4000 cases in one year

In Sep. 2013, Zhu Jiye<sup>8</sup>, the head of Peking University Organ Transplantation Research Institute and the director of the Hepatobiliary Surgery Program at Peking University People's Hospital, said in an interview with *China Economic Weekly*, "Before the pilot project in 2010, the organs from executed prisoners accounted for almost all donor sources in China. Our hospital used to perform 4,000 liver and kidney transplants within one year, and the sources of these organs were all death-row prisoners."<sup>9</sup>

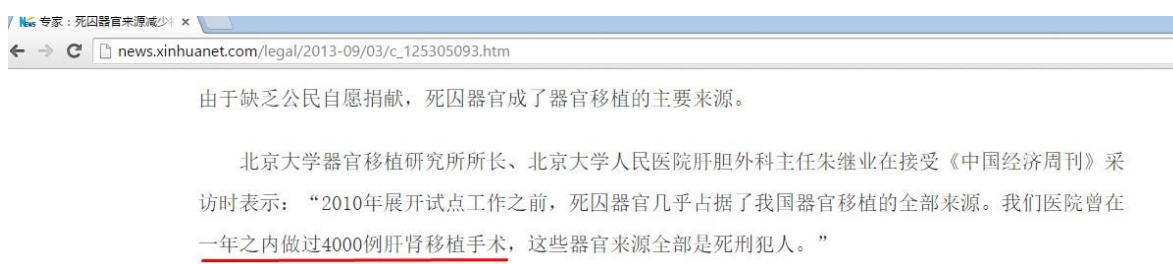


Figure 1 September 2013, "Xinhua Network" article snapshot

The CCP cracked down Falun Gong from July 1999. Since then, China organ transplant market grew rapidly. Especially in 2003, the organ transplants doubled. It ignited the fever of organ transplant travel to China from 2003 to 2006 all over the world. The wait time in some Chinese hospital was as short as one to two weeks while it would take two to three years overseas. Where were these organs from? Were the so called death-row inmates enough to support the rapid growing demand? <sup>10</sup>

According to Amnesty International, the average number of executed prisoners between 2000 and 2005 was 1600 per year while this hospital got 4000 cases of liver and kidney transplants in one year. <sup>11</sup> Per Ye Qifa, there were up to over 1000 hospitals that could perform organ transplant in 2007<sup>12</sup>. The number of executed death-row-inmates was far from such operation. Moreover, in an interview with the CCTV in July 2018, Huang Jiefu said that the quality of executed prisoners' organs was very poor, and the requirements for organ sources were very strict, so it was impossible to obtain suitable organs on the execution ground.<sup>13</sup> That indicates there are other donor sources. The Falun Gong practitioners who can't get any law protection could be one of such major sources.

#### IV. Transplant data shrunk severely on hospital official website

The hospital claimed on its official website on July 16, 2014 that it became one of the first tertiary level-A hospitals designated by the Ministry of Health to perform kidney transplants in 2007, and that it performed 80 to 90 transplants every year. <sup>14</sup> Since the hospital started performing liver transplants in 2000, it has performed more than 600 cases of liver transplants, <sup>15</sup> with an average of 40 liver transplants per year. Therefore, this shows that the hospital's actual annual number of organ transplants is 30.70-33.30 times of the annual number publicly stated.

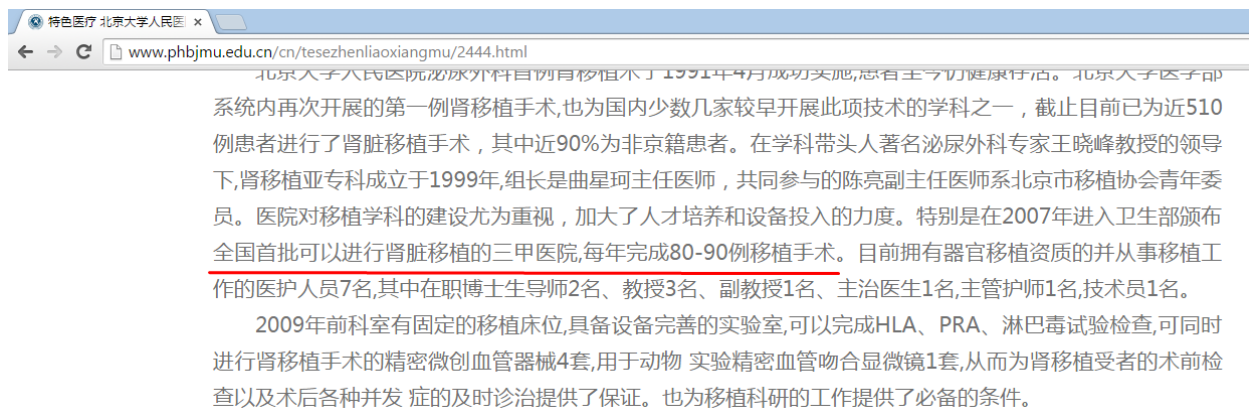


Figure 2 Peking University People's Hospital Cached

#### V. Strong team of liver and kidney transplant surgeons shows actual enormous operations

WOIPFG published the organ transplant surgeon list of the hospital. There were up to 31 liver and kidney transplant experts<sup>16</sup>, who can constitute several liver and kidney transplant teams. Among them, there are eight professors, six associate professors, four attending surgeons, including two doctoral supervisors and five master student supervisors. 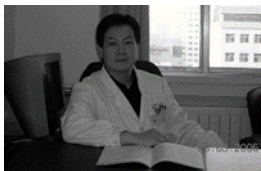

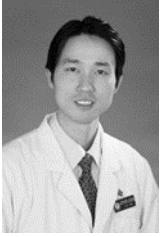

Yuhuangding Hospital in Yantai is a tertiary level-A general hospital,<sup>53</sup> with a strong transplant team.<sup>54</sup> Organ transplantation tops the four signature technologies at this hospital<sup>55</sup>. The Hospital has a strong transplant team, and its annual organ transplant volume ranks first in Shandong Province<sup>56</sup>. As of 2016, Liu Dongfu, a single transplant doctor, has performed above 3,000 kidney transplants<sup>57</sup>. Investigations show that the wait time for organ transplants in this hospital is extremely short, young donors are available here, and its organ transplant volume is large. Doctors in the Hospital did not even deny using organs from Falun Gong practitioners. The City's Red Cross claimed that they did not provide donors. The organ coordinator at the Hospital said that the donors were not allocated by the National Organ Network, either.

### **I. Hospital overview**

According to the hospital website, as a tertiary level-A hospital, Yantai Yuhuangding Hospital is a regional comprehensive medical center in Shandong Province. It was listed among the top 100 hospitals in China in 2017 and 2018. With over 4,800 employees, including over 380 PhDs and 159 advisors for doctoral or master students,<sup>58</sup> the hospital has 50 clinical programs and 18 medical laboratories. Organ transplantation and endoscopic minimally invasive surgery are among the hospital's top brand technologies.<sup>59</sup>

### **II. Annual volume of organ transplant surgeries ranks first in Shandong Province**

Organ transplantation tops the four signature technologies at this hospital.<sup>60</sup> Since Gao Zhenli took over the Organ Transplant Center at Yuhuangding Hospital in 2004, its organ transplantation programs (kidney, heart, liver, and pancreas-kidney joint transplants) have developed rapidly, and the hospital's annual transplant volume is ranked No.1 in Shandong Province.<sup>61</sup>

The hospital has a particularly large number of patient beds in its transplant programs, and its urology department has a kidney transplant ICU, an organ transplantation laboratory, and a tissue typing unit. More than 100 kidney transplant surgeries are done per year (there're now more than 1,000 accumulated cases of kidney transplants) with 100 beds.<sup>62</sup> The Hepatobiliary Surgery at the hospital is one of the key specialty programs at the provincial level in Shandong, offering top quality medical treatments for patients. Established independently in 1998, it was the first such a program in Shandong. With 92 beds, it has performed allogeneic in-situ liver transplants for patients with early liver cancer and advanced liver diseases.<sup>63</sup>

The hospital's urology center has 29 doctors, 38 nurses and technicians, including 13 with senior titles, one advisor for Ph.D. degrees, and three advisors for master degrees.<sup>64</sup> The Hepatobiliary Surgery Center has 37 medical staff, including five chief surgeons, five associate surgeons, one postdoctoral researcher, six other

surgeons with Ph.D. in medicine, eight staff members with master degrees, one Ph.D. student advisor, and four master student advisors.<sup>65</sup>

Gao Zhenli, Director of Organ Transplant Center in Yuliuding Hospital, conducted 114 kidney transplants and two pancreas and kidney joint transplant surgeries in 2004. He performed 160 cases of kidney transplants in 2005, 163 cases in 2006, 108 cases in 2007, 132 cases in 2008, and over 120 cases in 2009.<sup>66</sup>

Liu Dongfu is a chief surgeon and professor, the vice chairman of the Organ Transplantation Society in Yuhuangding Hospital, and a member of Shandong Organ transplantation. He has conducted more than 3,000 cases of kidney transplants.<sup>67</sup>

From the above data, we can see that the yearly volume of transplant operations performed by these two doctors has already been high. Besides, the Department of Urology and the Department of Hepatobiliary Surgery of the Hospital also have many doctors who can perform transplant operations. Therefore, it is not difficult to imagine the large number of organ transplants performed. Of course, Yantai Yuhuangding Hospital's organ transplant business is not only supported by its hardware facilities and transplant medical personnel but its abundant source of organs.

In 2003, he completed the training course of Advanced Minimally Invasive Surgery at United Christian Hospital in Hong Kong.

Song Zhanwen has performed the complex surgeries like liver transplants and provided the postoperative care. He's been doing liver and pancreas transplants in Jiaodong region since 2000, and as of 2006, had completed 22 cases of liver transplants independently and provided the postoperative care for over 60 cases.<sup>98</sup>

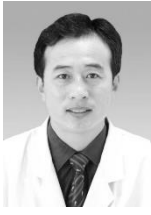

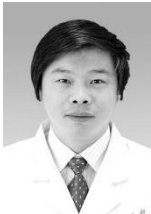

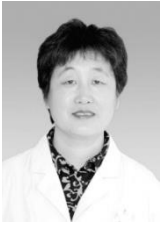

The Beijing Friendship Hospital is where Beijing organ transplant matching center is located with plenty donors and beds as well as strong transplant operation team. The hospital claims to be the largest kidney transplant center in Asia with large volume of kidney transplants. The WOIPFG investigative report shows the hospital expands its transplant capacity and has high volume of surgery. Upon the massive scheme of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, this hospital is obviously suspected of involvement with the alleged live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners.

#### I. Hospital Profile

The construction scale of Beijing Friendship Hospital totals 305,300 square meters with 194,000 square meters at Xicheng district campus and 111,300 square meters at Tongzhou district campus of the first phase. The hospital has more than 3,600 employees including 139 graduate advisors and 526 senior professional and technical staff. There are 2000 beds opened in two campuses. Average daily outpatient visits exceed 10,000. Average annual hospital discharges are 74,000.<sup>108</sup>

#### II. The hospital self-proclaimed the largest kidney transplant center in Asia and ranks first in China for kidney transplants.

The Beijing Friendship Hospital pioneered dialysis therapy and kidney transplant in China.<sup>109</sup> The hospital self-proclaimed the largest kidney transplant center in Asia with high volume of kidney transplant.<sup>110</sup> Yu Lixin, the head of kidney transplant center at Nanfang Hospital, said in an article, "Advances of clinical isotype kidney transplants in China" on *Medical Journal of Chinese People's Armed Police Forces* in 2004 that the hospital had completed 2,300 kidney transplants in October 2000.<sup>111</sup> Its kidney transplant volume ranks first in China. The Ministry of Health of the PRC approved this hospital in June 2006 to be one of the first hospitals with kidney transplant qualification.<sup>112</sup>

#### III. The hospital is Beijing organ transplant matching center with plenty donors.

In 1997, this hospital was assigned as Beijing organ transplant matching center by the Beijing Municipal Health Bureau. It established the Sino-US Terasaki matching center in 1998. The hospital completed the first 1,000 cases, 2,000 cases, and then 3,000 cases of organ transplant in China.<sup>114</sup> The Beijing matching center of organ transplant was officially established on June 23, 1998.

The matching center was operated with five hospitals, including Beijing Friendship Hospital, PLA 301 Hospital, Beijing Chaoyang Hospital, Sino-Japanese Friendship Hospital and Beijing Union Medical College Hospital. These hospitals are respectively affiliated with MOH, Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences, PLA and the municipality of Beijing. This center included a leading group of the matching organ

transplant center, a committee of experts, the central office, central laboratory, databases, technical collaboration and hospitals.

This center was located in Kidney Transplant Laboratory of Beijing Friendship Hospital and it had developed an intelligent computer program for kidney transplant tissue matching from 1994 to 1997, which shared the kidney resource exchange and enabled the rapid information transmission among participating hospitals.<sup>115</sup>

#### IV. The strong operation team of kidney transplant shows its massive volume of surgery.

According to the surgeons list released by WOIPFG in 2014,<sup>116</sup> there were 36 surgeons in kidney transplant program, including 7 chief surgeons, 10 associate chief surgeons and 19 surgeons. And there also were 16 surgeons in liver transplant program, including 6 chief surgeons, 2 associate chief surgeons and 5 attending surgeons. They can form several kidney and liver transplant teams.

#### V. Enormous beds at transplant inpatient service

There were 85 beds at the Urology Surgery program and over 150 beds at General Surgery program at this hospital.<sup>117</sup> Its liver transplant was at the international advanced level with development of whole liver transplant, living donor liver transplant, split liver transplant, auxiliary liver transplant, domino liver transplant, single-segment liver transplants, and so on.<sup>118</sup>

#### VI. Telephone Investigation

**Summary: A liver transplant doctor said that the acquisition of donors in the past had taken advantage of legal loopholes. There were multiple liver transplant teams, the volume of liver transplants was large, and the scale of the transplant center expanded.**

### **WOIPFG's Investigative Report on the Alleged Organ Harvesting of Living Falun Gong Practitioners at the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University and Its Staff Members Suspected of Participation**

The First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University was established in 1999, at the same time period when the CCP started the persecution of Falun Gong. The number of kidney transplants increased rapidly. In 2001, the Institute of Organ Transplantation of Xi'an Jiaotong University was established, becoming one of the largest transplant centers in China<sup>157</sup>. As of December 2012, the Institute has guided 23 hospitals in 13 provinces and cities to carry out more than 10,000 cases of kidney transplants<sup>158</sup>. According to the official website data, as of December 2013, the hospital has performed 3,764 cases of kidney transplants<sup>159</sup>. About 96.5% of the organ donors were of unknown origin. As of June 26, 2021, the hospital has completed 6,000 kidney transplants<sup>160</sup>. The Department of Kidney Transplantation of the hospital once completed 10 kidney transplant operations in a single day<sup>161</sup>. Telephone investigation revealed: suddenly rushed transplantation, admitted the use of Falun Gong practitioners as donors; short waiting times; and a large number of transplants.

In view of the background of the CCP's national crime of live organ harvesting, the hospital is obviously suspected of participating in the crime of live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

#### **Hospital Overview**

The hospital is a large scale comprehensive "Third level First class Hospital". The hospital covers an area of 148,000 square meters with capacity of 2,600 beds. The Division of Organ Transplantation is a national key clinical specialty. The hospital claims that its level and number of liver and kidney transplantation have reached the domestic advanced level.<sup>162</sup>

The Forensic Key laboratory of the Ministry of Health was established in October 1999 at the Forensic Department, Xi'an Jiaotong University, with the consent of the Department of Medical Science, Technology

and Education of Ministry of Health. The Key laboratory was co-founded by the Ministry of Health, Ministry of Public Security and the Supreme People's Court. <sup>163</sup>

Three months after the CCP crackdown on Falun Gong Practitioners in July 1999, the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Public Security and the Supreme People's Court jointly built the Laboratory of Forensic Medicine. A forensic laboratory is supposed to provide evidence for criminal cases, but now it was directly involved in organ transplant tissue matching, which is the duty of medical and health related organizations. This allows the public security system, which arrests and detains large numbers of Falun Gong practitioners, and the court system, which holds the death sentences or provides forged death certificates, become the direct beneficiaries of organ transplants. This also provides the motivation and practical feasibility for the judicial system to harvest organs from live Falun Gong practitioners.

## II. Organ Transplant Demonstration Center of Central and Western China

This hospital was the Organ Transplant Demonstration Center of Central and Western China. It had guided other hospitals to conduct more than 10,000 cases of kidney transplants, and trained more than 500 core technical staff for other transplant centers in China.

After 1999, kidney transplantation grew rapidly. By June 2000, the number of kidney transplant broke over 1,000 cases.<sup>164</sup> The number of kidney transplants ranked the forefront top of nation for a long time. The institute of Organ Transplantation Research of Xi'an Jiaotong University was established in 2001 and became one of the largest transplant centers with a set of medical, teaching and research functions.<sup>165</sup> The Institute is a national key clinical specialty.<sup>166</sup> By December 2012, it had guided 23 hospitals of 13 cities to conduct more than 10,000 cases of kidney transplants.<sup>167</sup> It has led the development of liver, heart, lung and small intestine transplants, and has had a model effect on organ transplantation in central and western China. Each year, it supervises about a thousand cases of kidney transplants for other hospitals.

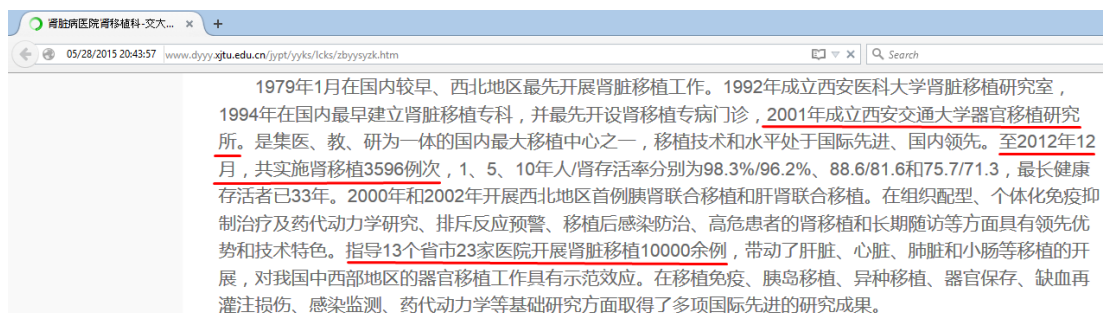


Figure 1 Snapshot of the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University

Established in 2001, the main research directions of the Institute of Organ Transplantation are kidney, liver, heart, lung, pancreas, small intestine and combined multi-organ transplantation. The Division of Kidney Transplantation is a national key discipline and a PhD-granting discipline with 48 beds.<sup>169</sup> The Hepatobiliary Surgery was the largest one in Northwest area with 162 beds.<sup>170</sup>

### 2. Strong liver transplantation team

The Division of Hepatobiliary Surgery is the largest hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgery specialty in Northwest China, with 108 staff members, including 33 doctors (8 professors, 7 associate professors, 2 attending surgeons, 5 doctoral supervisors, 26 medical doctors), 72 nurses, 2 medical technicians, and 1 administrative staff member.<sup>171</sup> Several liver transplantation teams can be formed. The Division of Hepatobiliary Surgery carried out the first cadaveric donor liver transplant in Northwest China in 2000.<sup>172</sup>

### 3. More than 300 cases of kidney transplantation every year

The surgeons of Kidney Transplant Center are all doctoral degree holders, included 9 doctoral supervisors, who have trained 85 Ph.D. and 156 masters students.<sup>173</sup> It also had 5 associate professors and 5 experimental researchers, including 2 researchers and associate researchers, and 3 experimental technicians.<sup>174</sup> They could form multiple kidney transplant teams.

On August 13, 2017, kidney transplant surgeon Zheng Jin said: “We do over 200 cases a year! Our goal is 300 cases this year. We already have more than 100 cases. Guangzhou Zhongshan, Shanghai, Hubei Tongji, Zhejiang University are all doing quite a lot! All doing more than three hundred cases per year.”<sup>175</sup>

On March 4, 2019, a nurse in kidney transplant ward<sup>176</sup> said: Now more than 300 cases of kidney transplants can be done in a year.

On December 24, 2019, a nurse at Kidney Transplant Ward<sup>177</sup> : Except for Wednesday morning when there is no clinic, from Monday to Friday outpatient clinic (kidney transplant) are all open. Many doctors do surgery, all of them are professor-levelled.

On December 26, 2019, a nurse of the kidney transplant department of Xijing Hospital, Fourth Military Medical University<sup>178</sup> , said: Our hospital does not do as much as the Jiaotong University Medical College, they did a lot! When asked: Jiaotong University Hospital said they could make four or five hundred a year, is that right? Answer: Yes, yes, yes, yes!

## IV. The data published on its official website shows that the source of a large number of donors is unknown

By June 2013, the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University had conducted 69 cases of Donations after Cardiac Death (DCD) heart transplant, 132 cases of DCD kidney transplants, 60 cases of DCD liver transplants. It claimed to have implemented the most DCD transplants and has the most efficiency in utilizing the organs in the country<sup>179</sup>. By December 2013, the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University had conducted 3,764 cases of kidney transplant<sup>180</sup>, among which only 132 cases (3.5%) were specified as DCD. The rest 3,632 cases (96.5%) have no explanation of the organ source.

## V. Media reports: After 1999, kidney transplantation in the hospital began to develop rapidly

1. Minghui.org reported on July 10, 2006, "Investigation clues: kidney transplantation in the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University School of Medicine".<sup>181</sup>

According to the webpage of the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University School of Medicine, the kidney transplantation department "completed the replacement of the old and the new staff in 1999, with Professor Xue Wujun as the director of the kidney transplantation department and Associate Professor Tian Puxun as the deputy director of the department, which ushered in a "brilliant" period of development for kidney transplantation. "

The number of kidney transplant cases in the First Affiliated Hospital has been increasing year by year, with more than 150 cases of kidney transplants each year (more than 160 kidney transplants in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003). By May 2006, kidney transplants broke through 2200 cases, with obvious improvement in transplantation results.

In 1999, the kidney transplantation department took the lead in carrying out living kidney transplantation in Northwest China, and has successfully carried out 25 cases of living kidney transplantation. In 2000 successfully carried out the first combined pancreas-kidney transplantation in Northwest China; In 2002 carried out the first combined liver-kidney transplantation in Northwest China, and has successfully carried out 5 cases, "filling the gap of combined multi-organ transplantation in Northwest China ". It became the kidney transplant center in Northwest China.

Since year 2000, the center has been hosting annually a national program for Continuing Medical Education (CME) on kidney transplantation. The students came from large general hospitals in 14 provinces and autonomous regions in China. "After learning from the program, the students went back to their hospitals and conducted a larger number of high-quality kidney transplants, having achieved a remarkable outcome from that Continuing Medical Education."<sup>182</sup>

**2. Minghui.org reported on March 3, 2007, "Investigation clues: Director Xue Wujun of Organ Transplant Institute, Xi'an Jiaotong University, is suspected of more than 1,750 cases of kidney transplants".<sup>183</sup>**

Xue Wujun, male, Han nationality, born in March 1961. Currently (2007) he serves as the Director of the Organ Transplant Research Institute at Xi'an Jiaotong University, the Deputy Director of the First Hospital of the Xi'an Jiaotong University, the Director of the Kidney Disease Center, the Director of the Kidney Transplant Division, and the Director of the Kidney Transplant Center of Shanxi Province. He is also a member of many academic associations, such as standing committee member of the Chinese Organ Transplant Association, editor of the Chinese Journal of Organ Transplants, and member of the Novartis Organ Transplant Expert Committee.

Since April 1999 Xue Wujun served as the Deputy Director of the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Medical University and the First Hospital of the Xi'an Jiaotong University and the Director of the Kidney Disease Center and Kidney Transplant Division. Under his leadership, the center performed over 1,750 kidney transplants; conducted combined pancreas-kidney transplants and combined liver-kidney transplants. He also "guided and assisted" in kidney and other transplants in 16 hospitals in Northwestern and Northern China.

In 2001, Xue organized and hosted the first "Conference of Organ Transplants in Shanxi Province and Northwestern China."<sup>184</sup>

According to the Minghui.org report on August 21, 2019:

Liu Shuxue, a staff member of the Food and Drug Administration of Ning County, Qingyang City, Gansu Province, male, in his 40s, underwent a liver transplant in the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University in April 2017.

Wang Chunxia, an employee of Ning County Maternal and Child Health Station, female, 50 years old, also underwent a liver transplant in the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University in May 2017.

Liu Shuxue and Wang Chunxia each waited only one month to obtain the donor. They themselves were not aware of the source of the liver donor. <sup>185</sup>

## VII. Telephone Investigation

Summary: suddenly rushed transplantation, admitted the use of Falun Gong practitioners as donors, short waiting time, and a large number of transplants.

### 1. Suddenly rushed transplantation, admitted the use of donors from Falun Gong practitioners

The Minghui website published an urgent announcement on April 6, 2006. The abstract stated: the witnesses in Sujiatun and other underground concentration camps have been secretly transferred and may be massacred at any time. Some mainland hospitals suddenly rushed to perform organ transplant operations in large numbers. Holocaust aimed at destroying witnesses in concentration camps is taking place. WOIPFG investigators called the transplant centers of major hospitals to get to know the situation, most doctors stated that there will be a large number of donors available before the end of April, and the chances will decrease after this time.

A doctor at the Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University: "If you come here... let's try to have it done before May." The doctor said that there are living livers and kidneys. The liver is whole liver. Some blood types have matching donors now.

In 2006, the investigator had a phone conversation with Dr. Wang from the Department of Liver Transplantation at the First Affiliated Hospital of Xi'an Jiaotong University.

Investigator: How long does it take to wait for a donor?

Dr. Wang: ... Let's try to have it done before May!

Investigator: "Is it a living kidney?"

Dr. Wang: There is liver as well. "

Investigator: " Are they also living donor livers?"

Dr. Wang: " "Yes, yes. "

Investigator: "I heard that there are 20-30-year-old healthy donors?"

Dr. Wang: "Yes, yes."

Investigator: "The source was picked from a human body, right?"

Dr. Wang: "That's right, right."
