China's Organ Transplant Organizations are the Executing Entities for the Communist Party's State Crime of Live Organ Harvesting

Since 1999, led by its then-leader Jiang Zemin, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) criminal group has been manipulating China's entire state apparatus, including the Party, government, military, armed police, judicial system, and medical institutions, through the Political and Legal Affairs Commission and the "610" system, to commit nationwide mass extermination of Falun Dafa practitioners by means of live organ harvesting for transplantation. The CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a crime against humanity and a crime of genocide initiated on the orders of Jiang Zemin.

Since the CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a state genocidal crime conducted as a political campaign, organ transplant institutions in all provinces, central government-controlled municipalities, and autonomous regions of mainland China, including all military, armed police, and local hospitals (medical centers) are suspected to have participated in this crime, even including a considerable number of hospitals unqualified to perform organ transplants, such as small and medium-sized hospitals and specialized hospitals. Similar to how all Chinese hospitals were involved in forced abortions during the CCP's implementation of the "one-child policy", all transplant facilities in China today have participated in live organ harvesting.

In view of the broader context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, those in charge of organ transplant hospitals/centers and similar institutions in China are suspected of having been involved in the crime of live organ harvesting from groups such as Falun Gong practitioners.

Evidence Collection Methods

1. Direct and indirect comprehensive telephone investigation and on-site investigation of the people suspected of involvement in the live organ harvesting

The subjects of our investigations include government officials, police officers, doctors and other medical personnel.

Geographical Distribution of the Subjects of Investigation, and the Duration of Investigations:

The WOIPFG's subjects of investigation are people in different positions, who are located across the entire country of China. Our investigations have been ongoing for nearly two decades, and our investigation results have always been consistent. The evidence gathered by us verifies that live organ harvesting is a systematic arrangement by the CCP.

- 1) Subjects of investigation: Presidents, directors, doctors, nurses, and security guards of organ transplant hospitals.
- 2) Hospitals involved: A considerable amount of recorded evidence has been obtained from many provincial, military, armed police, and local organ transplant hospitals (centers) across China.
- 3) Time span: Our investigations on the live organ harvesting started in 1999, and they are ongoing to this day.

2. Data investigation

- 1) We have been collecting data from the hospitals' websites and press releases.

- 2) We have been searching for and analyzing medical papers on transplantation.
- 3) We have been using the website www.archive.org to view the hospitals' previously archived information.
- 4) We have been collecting reports from the official Chinese media outlets.
- 5) We have organized all the information obtained from our investigations to create a database of the hospitals.

All the facts have shown us that the CCP is by no means a rational or normal organization or political party; but instead, it is a supra-state criminal syndicate controlled by a group of criminals who have committed crimes against humanity. The CCP's logic of thinking and principles of action are anti-human, and the crimes it has committed are forms of evil that humanity had never seen previously.

WOIPFG's investigative report series contains nearly 70 investigation reports on the alleged organ harvesting of living Falun Gong Practitioners at major Chinese military and civilian hospitals and on their staff members suspected of participation in this crime. This volume contains seven such investigation reports.

Foreword

The Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College (formerly the Hospital of the General Bureau of Agricultural Reclamation of Hainan Province) was officially transferred to Hainan Medical College for management in February 2016 and became the affiliated hospital directly under the management of Hainan Medical College. After Hainan was established as a province in 2008, the hospital became the affiliated unit of the chairman of the Hainan Provincial Organ Transplant Professional Committee, and an independent kidney transplant team was established in the Department of Urology that year. In 2010, the hospital obtained the national qualification for kidney transplantation. In 2017, Hainan Medical College established the "Hainan Medical College Transplant Medicine Research Institute" in the hospital, which is divided into basic department and clinical department. For this reason, Huang Jiefu, Guo Yanhong, Zheng Shusen and other high-ranking officials in the transplant field of the Chinese Communist Party were all present at the scene to support the hospital to comprehensively carry out large organ transplantation and build it into a training base for national transplant medical talents under Belt and Road Initiative.¹ After the official establishment of the Organ Transplant Department on July 31, 2018, the number of liver and kidney transplants in the hospital has increased significantly, and patients waiting for donors, "who are ready for surgery on the same day when donors become available, can receive transplant in about four or five days." In view of the general context of the CCP's state crime of living-donor organ harvesting, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners as well as members of other groups.

I. Hospital overview

The Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College (referred to as the "Second Hospital of Hainan Medical College") was founded in 1952.² It is a large-scale comprehensive tertiary level-A hospital integrating medical treatment, teaching, scientific research, rehabilitation and preventive health care. It has the national qualification for organ transplantation and is a designated hospital for "test-tube babies" in Hainan Province. The General Hospital has 2,100 beds and 2,673 employees, including 2,212 professionals, 298 associate senior and above titles, and 276 postgraduates with doctoral or master's degrees. There are 7 experts with the State Council's special allowance and provincial privileges.³

The hospital has 47 clinical departments and 25 medical technology departments. The department of organ transplantation has carried out and will soon carry out organ transplants such as kidney, liver, heart, lung and pancreas, and is a training base for transplant surgeons in countries along the Belt and Road.⁴

II. The hospital established the Hainan Medical College Institute of Transplant Medicine

In May 1982, The Hospital of Hainan Agricultural Reclamation (the predecessor of the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College) carried out the first allogeneic kidney transplant on the island. From 1996 to 2005, Han Qiguang served as the director of kidney transplantation. In May 2008, the Organ Transplant Professional Committee of Hainan Medical Association was established, and the hospital became the affiliated unit of the chairman of the Hainan Provincial Organ Transplant Professional Committee. In 2008, an independent kidney transplantation team was established in the Department of Urology. In January 2011, Zhang Guoqing served as the director of the Kidney Transplantation Professional Group in the Department of Urology. In 2010, the hospital obtained the National Kidney Transplant Qualification and became one of the first 163 institutions in China approved to perform human organ transplants. In 2017, Hainan Medical College established the Hainan Medical College Transplant Medicine Research Institute, which is divided into a basic department and a clinical department.⁵

III. Huang Jiefu and Zheng Shusen came to the hospital to guide and carry out large organ transplantation, and to build a training base for transplant talents in Belt and Road countries.

On April 25, 2018, Huang Jiefu, the former vice minister of the Ministry of Health and chairman of the China Human Organ Donation and Transplantation Committee, Guo Yanhong, deputy director of the National Health and Medical Administration Bureau, and Zheng Shusen, the president of Shulan Hospital, came to the hospital to guide the organ transplant work. They proposed that the Second Hospital of Hainan Medical College should carry out heart, lung, liver, pancreas, kidney and other large organ transplants, and build it into a training base for transplant talents in Belt and Road countries.⁶

Professor Wang Yi, Chairman of the 4th Hainan Provincial Organ Transplant Professional Committee and President of the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College, said that he will strive to build Hainan into a training base for organ transplant doctors in the Belt and Road countries and an international research center for transplantation.⁷

The Department of Organ Transplantation was established on July 31, 2018, with 34 beds (including 8 transplant ICU beds); 8 transplant specialists, 4 anesthesiologists, 2 intensive care specialists, and 4 specially-appointed cardiopulmonary transplant specialists. There are 4 organ transplantation operating rooms; 2 DD organ harvesting operating rooms; there are 2 ECMO sets, HLA tissue matching, CDC, PRA, DSA testing and FK506 and CsA drug concentration testing and other equipment. The Ethics Committee for Clinical Use of Organ Transplantation Technology and the Human Organ Procurement Organization (OPO) operate independently. There are special tools such as potential donors and human organ transfer helicopters and special vehicles for on-site organ harvesting operations.⁸

IV. Establish the Department of Organ Transplantation and hire Zeng Fanjun as the director

In May 2011, Xiao Jinzhu became the director-level member of the Organ Transplantation Professional Committee of the Hainan Provincial Medical Association. In May 2016, the hospital selected and sent a group of 18 doctors, nurses, anesthetists, and intensive care doctors to be trained at the Liver Transplant Department of the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University under the supervision of Zheng Shusen. In October 2016, Chief Surgeon He Shumin served as the Director of the Second Division of Urology and the Director of the Kidney Transplantation Professional Group. In March 2018, Professor Wang Yi served as a member of the National Organ Transplantation Professional Committee. In June 2018, Zeng Fanjun joined the organ transplant team to prepare for the establishment of an independent organ transplant department. On July 31, 2018, the Department of Organ Transplantation was formally established with Zeng Fanjun appointed as its director.⁹

On May 15, 2021, a reporter learned from the 2021 annual meeting of the Organ Transplantation Professional Committee of the Hainan Medical Association that in 2020, member units of the Fourth Hainan Organ Transplantation Professional Committee completed a total of 138 organ transplant operations, of which 29 were liver transplant operations, 99 cases of kidney transplantation, 3 cases of pancreas-kidney transplantation, 1 case of heart transplantation, and 6 cases of lung transplantation.¹⁰

From the opening of the department on July 31, 2018 to March 2022, the liver transplant team of the Second Hospital of Hainan Medical College has performed a total of 106 liver transplant operations.¹¹ From the beginning of 2022 to September, 154 organ failure patients received transplants.¹²

V. Telephone investigation

Highlight: The waiting time for transplantation is short, and the number of transplants is large, far exceeding the number of donations

Investigation target: Kidney transplant surgeon at the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College¹³

Investigation date: October 18, 2018

Highlight: The hospital has been doing kidney transplantation for more than ten years, and now it has expanded. The Department of Transplantation was officially opened in July. Dozens of cases have been done in the past two months. The waiting time varies, and there were those who received their surgeries on the same day (they were admitted into the hospital.)

1. Our hospital used to be a designated hospital.

3. For pneumonia examination, the patient has to pay a clinic fee. CT may cost around a few hundred yuan.
4. During the pandemic, there were relatively fewer transplant patients, but it was still being done. As long as there were donors, we would do it.
5. Last year we roughly did more than one hundred, maybe two hundred.
6. Question: Are there any Falun Gong donors?

Answer: I don't know. We nurses are not in charge of the donor, and we don't know the basic information about the donor, so if you want to know about the donor, you need to talk to doctors.

Highlights: The Kidney Transplantation Department of the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College has been doing it for more than ten years, only this year it has just been raised to the level of a medical department. Dozens of cases have been done in the past two months. Now President Xiao (Xiao Jinzhu), President Wang, and Director Sun who has joined us, are all doing it, and they are all specialized in transplantation.

VI. The hospital has a huge amount of transplants in a single day. The director of the transplant center said that multiple organ transplants a day has long been the norm in the hospital.

In April 2022, the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College completed the first combined heart and lung transplant in Hainan Province. On the same day, within 17 hours, the hospital also completed two liver transplants and five kidney transplants.²²

In September 2022, nearly 200 medical staff at Department of Liver Transplantation, Department of Kidney Transplantation, Department of Lung Transplantation, Department of Cardiovascular Surgery, Department of Critical Care Medicine, Department of Anesthesiology, Operating Room, Department of Ultrasound Medicine, Department of Laboratory, Department of Blood Transfusion, Department of Pathology, Department of Pharmacy, Nursing and other disciplines at the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hainan Medical College, worked together to complete a heart transplant, two lung transplants, a liver transplant, a kidney transplant and a combined pancreas-kidney transplant for a total of six major surgeries within 18 hours.²³

Professor Wang Yi said that organ transplantation is a key discipline of the Second Hospital of Hainan Medical College, and multiple organ transplant operations a day like this one have long been the norm in the hospital.²⁴

From February to June 1992, he studied microwave therapy technology in Changhai Hospital Affiliated to Shanghai Second Military Medical University. From July to December 1992, he was enrolled in the English training class for overseas personnel in Hainan Province and completed the course. In 1994, he studied kidney transplantation at the Institute of Organ Transplantation of Tongji Medical University. In September 2002, he was admitted to Central South University as a postgraduate in surgery. On December 5, 2004, he graduated with a master's degree in surgery and is now studying for a doctorate.

From November 1996 to November 1997, he studied in the Department of Urology, National University Hospital, National University of Singapore. Organ transplantation is an important indicator of a hospital's medical technology level, and it is also the direction of the development of surgical diagnosis and treatment technology. Preface

During the telephone investigation the doctors of the hospital admitted to using Falun Gong practitioners as donors, which were readily available, from living persons, with a high number of transplant cases. Given that, the general context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, this hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

I. Overview of Transplantation in the Hospital

The Second Affiliated Hospital of Guangzhou Medical University (in short named Guangzhou Medical Second Hospital) is a large comprehensive, third level first class hospital and a hospital affiliated with an educational medical college³³. Kidney transplantation was started in 1987, and the department was established independently in January 2001. There are 3 professors (chief physicians), 5 attending physicians and 3 physicians currently. Since the establishment of the department, nearly two thousand kidney transplants have been performed. The renal transplantation department is one of the approved hospitals to obtain the qualification of renal transplantation³⁴.

II. The Hospital Admitted to Using Falun Gong Practitioners as Donors

The transplant doctor of the hospital claimed: there was a batch of donors in mid-April 2006. They were (Falun Gong) practitioners in relatively good health, and their kidneys are all young about 20 to 30 years old, without infectious diseases, AIDS or syphilis³⁵.

III. The hospital has large number of transplant doctors and high volumes of transplant cases.

WOIPFG released a list of transplant surgeons at the hospital in 2014³⁶ according to the data found from the hospital's official website and published papers. For the kidney transplant field alone, there were 15 physicians performed the surgery, including 1 chief physician, 2 associate chief physicians, and 12 staff members. For liver transplantation alone, there were 6 physicians performed the surgery, including 4 chief physicians, 1 associate chief physician and 1 staff member.

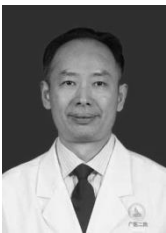

Preface

The hospital is one of the first to receive the Ministry of Health's kidney transplant qualification and built a national kidney transplant center. Shen Zhenya, Director of Cardiovascular Surgery and Research Unit, said: "We also have Falun Gong's (organs). There should be one such case this year." In the phone investigation in 2017, when asked if the inmate organ was still available as before, the transplant doctor answered, "Yeah, t's available. If the kidney source matches, it can be used. Just go to the prison to pick up." Whereas the broader context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, this hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

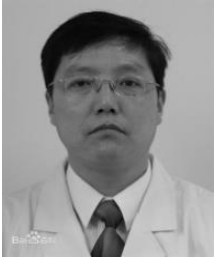

Foreword

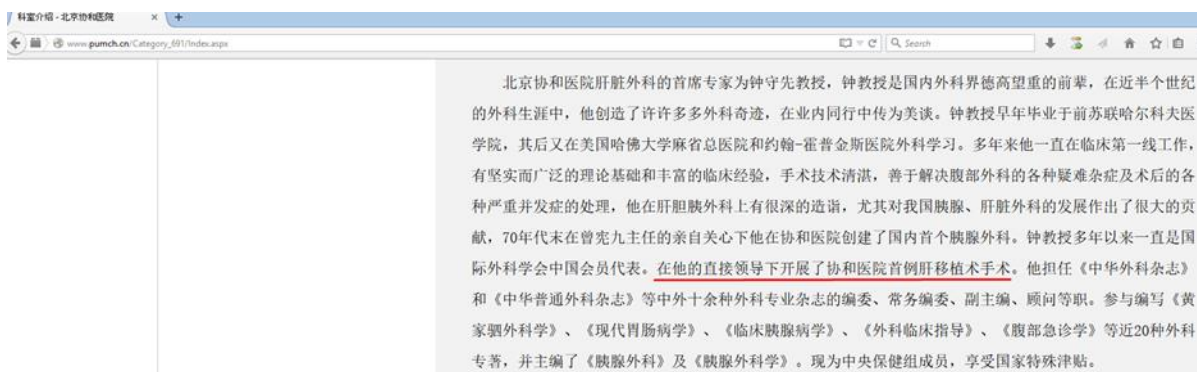
Peking Union Medical College Hospital has a strong transplant team that can form multiple liver and kidney transplant groups. The operation volume should be large, and the source of organs is suspected to be abnormal. There is an emergency green channel for kidney transplantation. In 2013, Huang Jiefu disclosed in an interview with a reporter from Guangzhou Daily that in 2012, he performed more than 500 liver transplants, of which only one was done with voluntary donation.⁷⁰ Moreover, it was the first liver transplant operation with voluntarily donated organ by citizens. Strangely, there was no mention in the hospital's official website of the number of liver and kidney transplants. In view of the background of the CCP's state crime of living-donor organ harvesting, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of harvesting organs from living Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

Peking Union Medical College Hospital is a comprehensive tertiary level-A hospital integrating medical treatment, teaching, and scientific research. It is a National Health Commission designated national guidance center for diagnosis and treatment of difficult and severe diseases. At present, the hospital has four campuses, more than 4,000 employees, 3 academicians of the two academies, 57 clinical and medical technology departments, 20 national key disciplines, 29 national key clinical specialties, 22 doctoral programs, and 29 master programs, 6 national continuing medical education bases, and more than 2,000 inpatient beds.⁷¹

The Department of Surgery of Peking Union Medical College Hospital is one of the earliest hospitals in China to carry out liver resection. Later, it developed into the Liver Surgery Center on the basis of the Basic Surgery Liver Specialty Group of Peking Union Medical College Hospital, and now it has become an independent liver surgery department. Former Ministry of Health Deputy Minister Huang Jiefu is the honorary director of the department.⁷²

Huang Jiefu is the former vice minister of the Ministry of Health of the Communist Party of China⁷⁵, the director of the China Human Organ Transplant Technology Clinical Application Committee (OTC) (July 2006)⁷⁶, and director-level member of the China Organ Donation Committee (CODC) (2008).⁷⁷

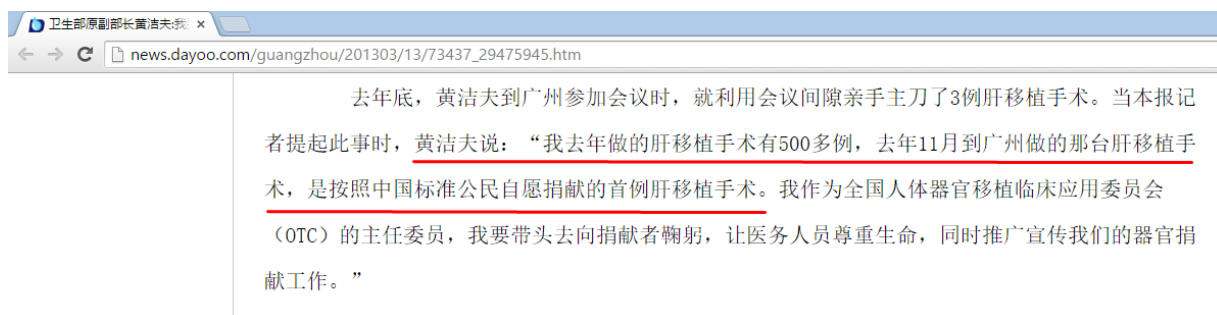


Figure 2 A snapshot of the web page of Dayang.com in March 2013

On March 20, 2020, Huang Jiefu said in an interview with a reporter from the Beijing News that now he is still doing clinical work in the Department of Surgery of Union Medical College Hospital every week. He was actually referring to conducting liver transplant operations⁷⁸.

II. The transplantation team is strong and can form multiple liver and kidney transplantation groups

Huang Jiefu was the former vice minister of the Ministry of Health of the Communist Party of China. He also held multiple positions concurrently. He was engaged in a lot of government and social functions, and he also made a lot of domestic and foreign visits and business trips every year. He cannot be the surgeon conducting most operations. He is just a liver transplant doctor at Union Hospital, the most famous hospital in the country. Huang Jiefu came to Union Medical College Hospital in 2001. The hospital has a strong staff with 2 doctoral supervisors, 3 master supervisors, 5 full professors and associate professors, 5 attending surgeons, and all members have doctorates. The Department of Liver Surgery of Peking Union Medical College Hospital routinely admits a certain number of doctors needing improvement every year for theoretical and practical training⁷⁹.

The hospital can form multiple liver transplant teams, and the operation volume should be huge, and yet there are no reports in that regard.

III. There is an emergency green channel for kidney transplantation

In 2002, the department set up a kidney transplant ward, meeting all the design requirements of a high standard organ transplant ward. The kidney transplant ward, hemodialysis center, and kidney transplant operating room are all arranged vertically. A kidney transplant specialist outpatient clinic has been set up, and a green emergency admission channel for kidney transplant patients has been opened at the same time⁸⁰.

IV. Kidney Transplant Center

The Department of Urology currently has two wards with more than 80 beds. Kidney transplantation has been carried out since the 1970s. It is one of the earliest urology doctor-granting centers authorized by the Academic Degrees Committee of the State Council. It currently has 3 doctoral supervisors and 8 master supervisors. In recent years, it has trained more than 30 doctoral and master students. Now it admits 6-8 doctoral and master's degree graduate students every year, and currently has 12 on-job graduate students⁸¹.

V. Liver transplantation training base funded by China Medical Board in New York

In June 2006, the Department of Liver Surgery of Peking Union Medical College Hospital received an one million US dollars grant from the China Medical Board in New York (CMB). The project takes the Peking Union Medical College Hospital of the Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences as the main body, and is jointly undertaken by the First Affiliated Hospital of Sun Yat-sen University and Tianjin First Central Hospital. Professor Huang Jiefu, Vice Minister of Health, is the leader of the project⁸².

VI. The hospital allegedly deleted data

The strange thing about Union Medical College Hospital is that all paper search websites in mainland China no longer have papers about liver transplantation done in this hospital, and the number of kidney transplants is very small. And the hospital's official website also deleted all pages related to the number of liver transplants. In addition, the kidney transplant data has not been updated for 10 years⁸³.

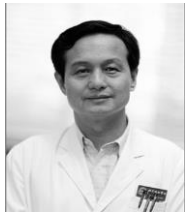

Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital has obtained the qualifications for all solid organ transplants from the National Health and Medical Commission, and has carried out all organ transplant projects clinically. The organ transplant center of the hospital is one of the few clinical transplant centers in China that integrates multiple organ transplants. In 2009, it ranked No. 28 among more than 160 transplant centers nationwide. In the 2017 telephone investigation, doctors replied: Liver transplants are all treated as emergencies, and the waiting time for transplants is short, and hundreds of cases can be performed a year. The growth and development of organ transplantation in this hospital is in sync with the CCP's national criminal campaign of living-donor organ harvesting. In the context of this national genocide campaign, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners and members of other groups. In view of the background of the CCP's state crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners, the Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital is a key unit that is seriously suspected of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners.

Hospital overview

Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital is a national tertiary level-A hospital.¹⁰² The hospital has 4,132 open beds, 6,875 employees, 1,068 experts with senior professional titles, and 54 recipients for special government allowances from the State Council. The hospital has medical equipment such as Da Vinci robotic surgery system, PET-CT, TrueBeam linear accelerator, etc. It has carried out high-tech operations such as organ transplantation, cell transplantation, large blood vessel, valve replacement, etc., and has obtained all solid organ transplantation qualifications from the National Health and Medical Commission, and clinically carry out all organ transplant projects.

I. The hospital has a "Key Laboratory of Organ Transplantation and Transformational Medicine in Sichuan Province", which has received tens of millions yuan of national funding

The establishment of the "Sichuan Provincial Key Laboratory of Organ Transplantation and Transformational Medicine" is based on the Sichuan Academy of Medical Sciences and the Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital Organ Transplantation Research Institute. In 2007, the hospital established the Institute of Organ Transplantation, as well as the Organ Transplantation Center to carry out clinical trials of kidney and liver transplantation; in 2008, it established the Laboratory of Cell Biology and Molecular Biology; in 2010, it established cell transplantation center and started to build the standard laminar flow laboratory; and following that, it established the transplantation immunology laboratory, experimental animal laboratory and pathology laboratory. In December 2011, the Sichuan Provincial Department of Science and Technology approved the laboratory as the "Key Laboratory of Organ Transplantation and Transformational Medicine in Sichuan Province".¹⁰³

hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgery, urology and endoscopic surgery, and is approved by the Ministry of Health as a designated hospital for liver transplantation and kidney transplantation. The development of the department focuses on transplantation surgery, based on hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgery and urological surgery, and now carries out clinical liver, kidney, small intestine, pancreas, pancreas-kidney combined transplantation and liver-intestine combined transplantation techniques and conventional hepatobiliary-pancreatic surgery. In June 2009, it opened the first and only organ transplant clinic in the province; in 2009, it ranked 28th among more than 160 transplant centers in China, and in 2010, it became the training base for organ transplant nurses in Sichuan Province.¹⁰⁴ In 2019, Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital performed 197 cases of large organ transplants such as small intestine transplants, heart transplants, lung transplants, liver transplants, and kidney transplants.¹⁰⁵

III. The transplant center is developing rapidly and has many beds

The Organ Transplant Center was established in March 2007 and has achieved great development in a short period of time. As of January 2011, it had developed into a clinical surgery center with more than 100 beds, 12 doctors and 27 nurses.¹⁰⁶

V. During the pandemic, Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital completed two difficult lung transplants in one day

On March 12, 2020, the lung transplantation team of Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital, led by Chen Jingyu of Wuxi People's Hospital, completed two lung transplant surgeries for critically ill patients within one day.¹¹⁰

According to Sina.com, on June 16, 2021, Yang Hongji, Director of the Organ Transplantation Center of Sichuan Provincial People's Hospital, said, "Five operations (including organ harvesting operations) were performed simultaneously, with a multi-discipline team of more than 100 medical staff. They worked until the early hours of the next day".¹¹¹

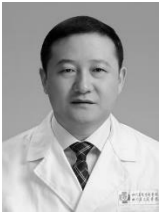

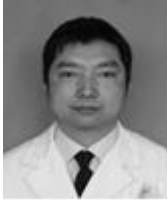

Foreword

The Second Affiliated Hospital of Harbin Medical University began doing living donor kidney transplants in 1999, which coincided with the start of the persecution of Falun Gong, resulting in a large number of kidney transplants. The hospital's official website claims it's a leader in China in terms of organ transplant types, techniques, and quality. Heart transplantation papers show that before 2005, the hospital had had a dedicated heart collection team. The donors were suspected to be living bodies, and the heart was removed after anesthesia. In view of the background of the CCP's state crime of living donor organ harvesting, the hospital is obviously suspected of participating in the crime of harvesting organs from living Falun Gong practitioners and members of other groups.

Hospital overview

The Second Affiliated Hospital of Harbin Medical University, founded in 1954, is a large comprehensive tertiary-A level hospital. The hospital covers an area of 500,000 square meters, with one outpatient department, 11 inpatient departments, and 4,534 employees.¹²⁸

I. The Hospital can complete multiple types of organ transplantation

The hospital claims that it can complete heart transplants, lung transplants, liver transplants, spleen transplants, kidney transplants, testicular transplants, combined heart-lung transplants, combined pancreas-kidney transplants, combined thyroid-parathyroid-thymus transplants, corneal transplants, and bone marrow transplants.¹²⁹ It is the only hospital in Heilongjiang Province that has obtained national permission to carry out kidney transplantation. The Department of Urology has 65 patient beds.¹³⁰

II. Telephone investigations show that living donor kidney transplantation began in 1999, and the number of kidney transplants is large

1. Living donor kidney transplantation began in 1999, which highly coincides with the time when the CCP began to persecute Falun Gong

Investigation target: Chen Zhaoyan, Chief Surgeon of the Department of Urology at the Second Affiliated Hospital of Harbin Medical University, is good at kidney transplantation. Dr. Chen Zhaoyan claimed that he alone had done hundreds of kidney transplants before. According to investigations by WOIPFG, this hospital is the only kidney transplant hospital in Heilongjiang, with 23 kidney transplant doctors.¹³²

III. The doctor's thesis shows that the organ harvesting process of the hospital is suspected of harvesting organs through murder, and the evidence shows that the donor is not a death row prisoner

"Evidence of the Chinese Communist Party Harvesting Organs from Living Falun Gong Practitioners in Medical Professional Papers in Mainland China (Updated Edition)"¹³⁵ published by WOIPFG, analyzed more than 300 medical papers from more than 200 hospitals in 31 provinces and municipalities directly under the Central Government in China. Evidence were collected from the organ harvesting process, the warm ischemia time of the organ (the period from the death of the "donor" to the cessation of blood circulation to the start of the cold perfusion of the organ), the age and health status of the "donor". These medical papers stated that the vast majority of organ "donors" are young and middle-aged, in excellent health before death, and the warm ischemia time of the organs is extremely short. These details all confirm that a large number of healthy living "donors" died during the process of organ harvesting, and the organ harvesting operations by medical workers involved in organ harvesting are suspected of killing people to harvest organs.

Among them, a study of the 2006 paper "Surgical Coordination of Donor Heart Collection for Heart Transplantation" by the Second Affiliated Hospital of Harbin Medical University¹³⁶ showed that before 2005, the hospital set up a special heart collection team and the death time of the donor can be predicted, and the anesthetist "provided medicine" on the spot, and both organ harvesting and transplantation are done in hospitals. This is not a feature of the execution of death row inmates, so the organs are suspected of not coming from death row inmates.

1. There is no organ donation system, but the donors are all "brain-dead patients"

The paper mentioned that the hospital performed 15 orthotopic heart transplants from April 1992 to December 2005, claiming that the 15 hearts were all from "brain-dead patients" who were healthy men aged 22 to 34.

However, according to the official report of the CCP, before 2006, there was no organ donation system in China.¹³⁷

2. The hospital has a dedicated donor heart collection team, which can predict the death time of the donor

The paper shows: "Our hospital has established a streamlined heart-collecting medical team, consisting of surgeons, anesthesiologists, perfusionists, operating room nurses, blood bank staff, liaison officers, etc. When task is assigned, the members of the donor team are called together for pre-operative discussion and work arrangements. Here, "the task is assigned", it means that the recipient has been found, and the donor will be "declared dead" on a certain day.

3. After the anesthesiologist administered the drug, the donor's heart goes from beating to stopping during the operation, so the operation room was suspected of being the place where murder takes place

"Preoperative preparation" mentioned that "in order to shorten the ischemia time of the donor heart, an itinerant nurse cooperated with the anesthetist to administer the drug rapidly." At the collection site, the anesthetist "administered the drug rapidly", which shows that the donor at that time was likely to be a living individual. The paper mentioned: "...block the inferior vena cava, wait for the heart to continue beating 10 to 20 times, and after the blood in the heart is drained... After the perfusion is completed, the heart stops beating and the aorta is cut off..."

2.5.1 Preoperative preparation In order to shorten the ischemic time of the donor heart, the nurse, having washed hands, will prepare the articles and medicines to be used in the operation. Before the operation, two itinerant nurses opened the vein channel in time, and after confirming that the vein was unobstructed, Before the operation, one itinerant nurse cooperated with the anesthesiologist to give the medicine quickly, while another itinerant nurse...

4. Judging from the description of the composition and setting of the heart harvesting donor group, these hearts were harvested in the operating room of the hospital and transplanted in the transplant operating room in the hospital, not in line with the practice that harvesting organs from death row prisoners on the executing grounds. Therefore, it is highly suspected that the sources of these organs are not executed prisoners.

IV. The hospital used fresh livers from healthy young people to perform liver transplantation simulation experiments

As of 2002, the Second Affiliated Hospital of Harbin Medical University conducted an applied anatomical study on 58 cases of formalin-fixed adult cadaveric livers and 8 cases of fresh livers for split liver transplantation.¹³⁸

As of 2004, the hospital performed anatomical studies of the blood supply of the duodenum, lower common bile duct, and ampulla of Vater on 30 formaldehyde-fixed adult cadavers and 10 fresh cadavers.¹³⁹

V. The data on the number of kidney transplants on the official website has not been updated for 10 years, and the page was later deleted

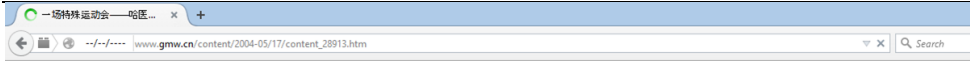

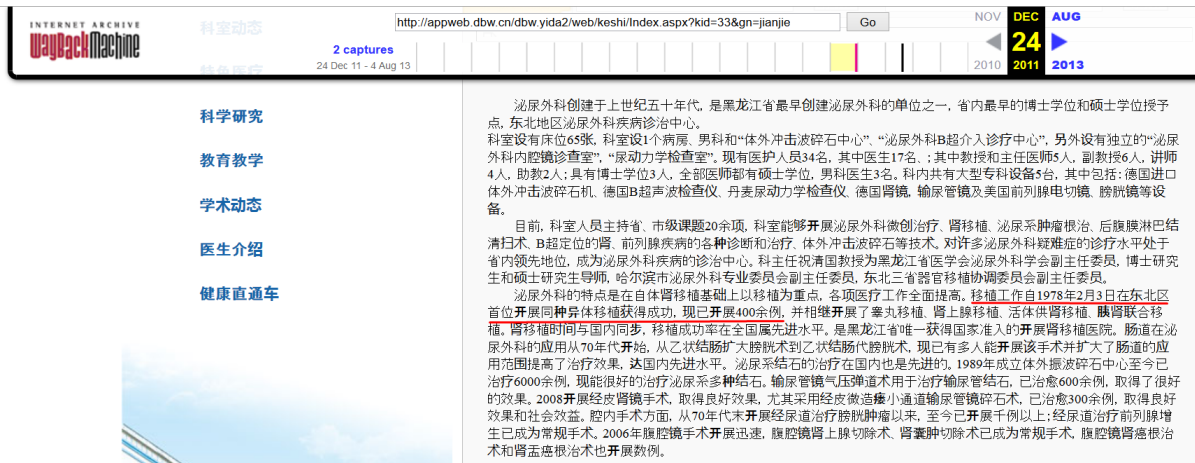

Preface

In April 2006, during a telephone investigation conducted by WOIPFG, a doctor at Zhongnan Hospital of Wuhan University (formerly the Second Affiliated Hospital of Hubei Medical University) admitted that they were using organs from Falun Gong practitioners and allocated kidneys with Wuhan General Hospital of Guangzhou Military Command. In another telephone investigation conducted in 2016, a kidney transplant doctor said the wait time for an organ was about two weeks. In 2017, a liver transplant doctor said: "We often do emergency liver transplants." Given the background of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

I. Hospital Overview

Zhongnan Hospital of Wuhan University is a Grade-A Tertiary Hospital with 3,300 beds, equipped with dual-source CT, 3.0 MRI, ECT, high-energy multi-blade grating medical linear accelerator, DSA, dual board DR, PET-CT, TOMO and other high-end medical equipment¹⁸¹.

In 2007, the Institute of Hepatobiliary Diseases of Wuhan University was formally established in Zhongnan Hospital to conduct research and clinical operations on various organ transplants, including liver transplants, kidney transplants, pancreas transplants, small intestine transplants, combined liver-kidney transplants, combined autologous liver transplants and transplants of liver cells, spleen cells, and islets¹⁸². The Hepatobiliary Diseases Institute of Wuhan University and Transplantation Medicine Center of Wuhan University were approved by Wuhan University, and their foundation stones were laid by former French President Jacques Chirac in 2006¹⁸³. The organ transplant center is funded by France¹⁸⁴. On March 17, 2007, Chirac unveiled the Hepatobiliary Disease Research Institute of Zhongnan Hospital of Wuhan University¹⁸⁵. On August 1, 2013, the hospital obtained the qualifications for kidney and liver transplants approved by the National Health and Family Planning Commission¹⁸⁶. Before this, from February 2010 to September 2013, the Transplantation Medical Center performed 98 kidney transplants¹⁸⁷; from 2002 to 2012, the hospital performed at least 407 liver transplants¹⁸⁸. Its Department of Ophthalmology comprehensively carried out ocular surface surgeries including corneal transplants¹⁸⁹.

II. Admits the use of organs from Falun Gong practitioners and the allocation of kidney sources with Wuhan General Hospital of the Guangzhou Military Command

Investigation Subject: A doctor at The Second Affiliated Hospital of Hubei Medical University (the predecessor of Zhongnan Hospital of Wuhan University)

Investigation Time: April 2006

Q: How about the kidney sources from Falun Gong prisoners here?

A: It should be said that it is okay. How about you ask the General Hospital of Guangzhou Military Command?

Q: Wait a minute... Guangzhou Military Command?

A: It is the Wuhan General Hospital. We also share (organs) with each other.¹⁹⁰

III. Transplanted organs from acute brain-dead, cardiac-dead donors

Through the search of some academic papers, we found that from 2002 to 2011, the hospital performed 407 cases of liver transplants. These livers were harvested from acute brain-dead and cardiac-dead donors¹⁹¹.

Harvesting organs from brain-dead organ donors is widely recognized and legally protected internationally. However, China has never legislated on "brain death", nor does it have a sound organ donation system, so there are no "brain dead donors" at all.

IV. China Human Organ Procurement Organization Alliance (OPO) was established at Zhongnan Hospital of Wuhan University

On November 23, 2014, the China Human Organ Procurement Organization Alliance was established at Zhongnan Hospital of Wuhan University¹⁹². The executive chairman of the alliance is Ye Qifa, a chief surgeon and Director of the Organ Transplant Center of Zhongnan Hospital. Ye served as the Vice President of the Third Xiangya Hospital in Hunan for many years. He is currently the Director of the Transplant Medicine Engineering Technology Research Center of the Ministry of Health and the Chairman of its Technical Committee. He has personally completed more than 600 liver transplants and more than 1,300 kidney transplants¹⁹³.

1. Wait time for kidney transplant: about two weeks, generally less than one month.

VI. Official Report on Short Wait Time for Organs

According to a report by people.com.cn on July 9, 2015, a 26-year-old boy, Chen Jun (pseudonym), came to the Organ Transplant Center of Zhongnan Hospital half a month earlier. Ye Qifa and Ye Shaojun decided to perform liver transplantation for the patient. Soon Chen Jun was matched with an organ donor's liver, and the transplant operation was successfully completed within a week¹⁹⁸.
