2. More than 100 cases of liver transplants were also performed this year.

Contents of the recording

Nurse: Hello!

Investigator: Hello, are you the Shanghai Changhai Hospital? Nurse: Yes, who is calling?

Investigator: A friend of mine introduced me that your Changhai Hospital has a director named Zhu Youhua who does a very good job in kidney transplantation, and your hospital does a lot. My family members are interested, so I am calling to ask, how long it will take to wait to get it done. What's the quickest time? Nurse: Well, I'm not sure about this either. It's hard to tell.

Investigator: May I ask, is this hospital still doing a lot of kidney transplants right now? Nurse: Yes.

Investigator: Is it still doing? Nurse: That's right.

Investigator: Does Zhu Youhua do it himself? Nurse: Right, Zhu Youhua does it himself.

Investigator: Zhu Youhua is doing it in-person, right? Nurse: That's right.

Investigator: That's to say you do it every day, every day, right? Like this kidney transplants, right? Nurse: That's right.

Investigator: Does that mean, the waiting time, if you do it a lot and do it every day, the waiting time should not be too long, right?

Nurse: We, I'm not sure about this. There must be a lot of people waiting. It's impossible to just come in and let you do it just because you want to do it.

Survey: Does the ward have spaces? Are beds available? I mean people to be hospitalized. Nurse: In short of availability.



Investigator: In short, that means you don't have many beds, right? Nurse: Right.

Investigator: Do you have only one ward for kidney transplantation, or a few wards are there? Nurse: Right.

Investigator: Just one ward, wow, that's too few. How many beds are there in a ward? Not many. Are there a hundred?

Nurse: What should I say? We do not only kidney transplants but also liver transplants.

Investigator: I just want to ask how many surgeries your hospital can perform every day? Nurse: How many surgeries can be done every day? If all counts, we can do one or two surgeries every day.

Investigator: This kidney transplant, you can perform one to two kidney transplants every day, right? Nurse: Right. It also depends on the situation.

Investigator: Then let's say the kidney source, the donors are healthy ones, right? In general. Nurse: Huh?

Investigator: Donors, are donors all healthy? Nurse: How do I know this?

Investigator: Got to ask a doctor, ask a doctor. Dr. Zhu Youhua opens clinic, a specialist clinic. Nurse: Right, he seems to open on Wednesdays.

Investigator: How about that, do people in the army have any priority? Can donors like those from Falun Gong or prisoners used in the past still be available? Nurse: What kind of donor? How do I know? Got to ask the doctor specifically about this. How do I know where that kidney came from?

Investigator: So, if I have to call the doctor, which number should I call? Nurse: You want a doctor's number. We don't have a doctor's number here. You can only get it when you come to the outpatient clinic here.
