Translation

Ning Na: Hello!

Investigator: You are Ning Na from the Department of Hepatobiliary Surgery at the People's Hospital of

Xinjiang Autonomous Region, right?

Ning Na: Right.

Investigator: This is the situation: I have a relative in your area who has liver cirrhosis and needs liver transplantation. I would like to ask, can your hospital arrange liver transplantation?

Ning Na: Did you mean to have liver transplantation done in our hospital?

Investigator: That's right...

Nina: Sure.

Investigator: Ah, he has type B blood and is 45 years old. If all the physical examination indicators are suitable for surgery, how long does it usually take to arrange a surgery?

Ning Na: Well...we have to wait for a suitable liver source. Does he (the patient) have...what is his current diagnosis? Cirrhosis?

Investigator: Liver cirrhosis, yes, hepatitis B, liver cirrhosis. This is what I wanted to do: I'd like to ask first about your general situation. How long does it take before a surgery can be arranged, that is, how long does a patient have to wait?

Ning Na: It's hard to say about the time. If it's allogeneic transplantation, there is the issue of liver source, and it will take time to wait for a donated liver.

Investigator: That's right. I'd like to know how long approximately the patient has to wait?

Ning Na: I am not sure about the time. For example, if I have a suitable liver source tomorrow, which is type B, then it can be done tomorrow. If there is no suitable liver source, then we have to wait.

Investigator: That is to say, if there is a suitable one, it can be done tomorrow, and then it can be done at that time. If the one available is not appropriate, we have to wait?

Ning Na: If there is a suitable one, it will be available in a month or two or soon, in a day or two. We are all like...if there is a request for transplant, we will first register it in our transplant bank, and when there is an appropriate liver source, we will call you in advance, we will give you an immediate call.

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Investigator: Ah, okay, that's great. Are your organs taken out in this hospital, and then used in transplant surgery at the same time? Or are they brought here from other hospitals?

Ning Na: Because there are (organ sources) all over the prefecture, in the whole of Xinjiang, if there is a suitable liver source, they will call a special office for transplantation in our hospital, telling us that there is a liver source, and then we will do the transplant. That's how it works.

Investigator: That's how it works. What is the average age of the liver donors you are using now? Ning Na: Generally, we will always choose the kind of liver that is more suitable, that is, the kind of liver source that is relatively good and of better quality. If the liver of this person is not good, why do we want to do this liver transplant? right? hello, can you hear me? Hello?
