China's Organ Transplant Organizations are the Executing Entities for the Communist Party's State Crime of Live Organ Harvesting

Since 1999, led by its then-leader Jiang Zemin, the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) criminal group has been manipulating China's entire state apparatus, including the Party, government, military, armed police, judicial system, and medical institutions, through the Political and Legal Affairs Commission and the "610" system, to commit nationwide mass extermination of Falun Dafa practitioners by means of live organ harvesting for transplantation. The CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a crime against humanity and a crime of genocide initiated on the orders of Jiang Zemin.

Since the CCP's live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners is a state genocidal crime conducted as a political campaign, organ transplant institutions in all provinces, central government-controlled municipalities, and autonomous regions of mainland China, including all military, armed police, and local hospitals (medical centers) are suspected to have participated in this crime, even including a considerable number of hospitals unqualified to perform organ transplants, such as small and medium-sized hospitals and specialized hospitals. Similar to how all Chinese hospitals were involved in forced abortions during the CCP's implementation of the "one-child policy", all transplant facilities in China today have participated in live organ harvesting.

In view of the broader context of the CCP's state crime of live organ harvesting, those in charge of organ transplant hospitals/centers and similar institutions in China are suspected of having been involved in the crime of live organ harvesting from groups such as Falun Gong practitioners.

Evidence Collection Methods

1. Direct and indirect comprehensive telephone investigation and on-site investigation of the people suspected of involvement in the live organ harvesting

The subjects of our investigations include government officials, police officers, doctors and other medical personnel.

Geographical Distribution of the Subjects of Investigation, and the Duration of Investigations:

The WOIPFG's subjects of investigation are people in different positions, who are located across the entire country of China. Our investigations have been ongoing for nearly two decades, and our investigation results have always been consistent. The evidence gathered by us verifies that live organ harvesting is a systematic arrangement by the CCP.

- 1) Subjects of investigation: Presidents, directors, doctors, nurses, and security guards of organ transplant hospitals.
- 2) Hospitals involved: A considerable amount of recorded evidence has been obtained from many provincial, military, armed police, and local organ transplant hospitals (centers) across China.
- 3) Time span: Our investigations on the live organ harvesting started in 1999, and they are ongoing to this day.

2. Data investigation

1) We have been collecting data from the hospitals' websites and press releases.

- 2) We have been searching for and analyzing medical papers on transplantation.
- 3) We have been using the website www.archive.org to view the hospitals' previously archived information.
- 4) We have been collecting reports from the official Chinese media outlets.
- 5) We have organized all the information obtained from our investigations to create a database of the hospitals.

All the facts have shown us that the CCP is by no means a rational or normal organization or political party; but intead, it is a supra-state criminal syndicate controlled by a group of criminals who have committed crimes against humanity. The CCP's logic of thinking and principles of action are anti-human, and the crimes it has committed are forms of evil that humanity had never seen previously.

WOIPFG's investigative report series contains nearly 70 investigation reports on the alleged organ harvesting of living Falun Gong Practitioners at major Chinese military and civilian hospitals and on their staff members suspected of participation in this crime. This volume contains five such investigation reports.

Preface

In order to confirm whether Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital is conducting/involved in the live harvesting of human organs for transplantation for profit, World Organization to Investigate the Persecution of Falun

Gong (WOIPFG) conducted a telephone investigation and a data survey on Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital, including the number of organ transplant operations, organ waiting time, organ sources, participants, patients and details of operations, etc. The survey showed that the waiting time for liver and kidney transplants at Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital is extremely short, the number of transplants is huge, and the number of patients and operations is very high.

According to the data obtained from a special investigation conducted by WOIPFG, during the half-year period from December 12, 2017 to May 20, 2018 alone, Zheng Shusen's own surgical team at Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital performed 545 cases of liver and kidney transplantation (306 cases of liver transplantation and 239 cases of kidney transplantation) and used 560 organs (including 15 discarded organs). The percentage of emergency transplants in terms of total organ transplant cases was 10% to 20%. The organ wait times were one to two weeks, with the shortest wait time being only one day. Also, there were cases of the hospital seeking patients for existing organs and organ surplus. There were more than 400,000 kidney sources, and the hospital guaranteed to provide its patients with young organ donors within one month.

It is worth noting that, according to the results of this special investigation, the hospital performed 545 cases of liver and kidney transplantation (306 cases of liver transplantation and 239 cases of kidney transplantation) during a half-year period, which included the off-seasons around the New Year's Day and the Chinese New Year. Therefore, there should have been at least 1,000 transplant cases performed during the entire year. Moreover, this is only the number of operations performed by Zheng Shusen's surgical team alone within half a year. Judging from the scale of Shulan Hospital, where there are 37 doctors (including 16 directors and deputy directors), there should be at least two surgical teams. So, according to conservative calculations, the volume should be no less than 2,000 cases of liver and kidney transplantation. (For details, please refer to the attached special investigation record.)

The investigation results from WOIPFG shows that Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital has an extraordinarily short waiting time for liver and kidney transplants, a huge number of transplants, abundant organ supply, and unclear sources of organs. The timing of the development of organ transplantation coincides highly with the time of the Chinese Communist Party's persecution of Falun Gong. Zheng Shusen, the hospital's director, did not deny the use of organs from Falun Gong practitioners for transplantation during the investigation conducted by WOIPFG on the persecution of Falun Gong. Zheng Shusen's paper was retracted by the International Liver Transplant Society due to suspicions involvement of live organ harvesting, et al.¹ Furthermore, Zheng Shusen served as the former chairman of the Zhejiang Anti-Cult Association, a specialized organization for persecuting Falun Gong by the Chinese Communist Party (2007–2017). Zheng himself participated in brainwashing and transformation activities against Falun Gong practitioners under the name of the association, constituting actual persecution crimes. ²

The investigation indicated that Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital had a very short waiting time for liver and kidney transplants, a huge number of transplants, an adequate supply of organs, and an unknown source of organs, and was suspected of being involved in the live harvesting of human organs. Shulan Hospital is suspected of committing the crime against humanity of mass live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners.

The Chinese Anti-Cult Association (CACA) was founded by the Chinese Communist Party (CCP) or Chinese government officials who have religious or scientific backgrounds. Following the direction of the CCP and with the help of the state-controlled media, the members of the CACA have been using their religious and scientific backgrounds and social identities to justify and further the persecution of Falun Gong. Their functions include providing explanations to people in China and abroad to justify the persecution,

providing suggestions to the Chinese government regarding the methods of persecution, providing theories to criticize Falun Gong's principles, and directly participating in the brainwashing and persecution of Falun Gong practitioners. After its establishment on November 13, 2000 in Beijing, the CACA quickly developed many branches in different provinces, cities, work units, and even schools. It has been motivating people from all social levels to join its movement of criticizing Falun Gong and brainwashing Falun Gong practitioners.

In view of the general background of the CCP's state crime of organ harvesting from living persons, and the large amount of relevant evidence from the hospital, Zheng Shusen is an important organizer of the CCP's large-scale live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners and the executor of the systematic persecution of Falun Gong practitioners. Shulan Hospital is suspected of committing crimes against humanity of large-scale organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners.

Evidence includes:

- 1. The director of the hospital, Zheng Shusen, did not deny the use of organs from Falun Gong practitioners during the investigation phone calls, and that the time when he did a large number of organ transplants over a long period of time coincided with the persecution of Falun Gong by the CCP
- 2. Audio evidence indicated that multiple doctors at the Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University School of Medicine, where Zheng Shusen worked, were suspected of involvement in live organ harvesting.
- 3. Data from the special investigation report shows that Shulan Hospital has a huge number of transplanted organs, with ultra-short waiting times and unknown sources of organs.
- 4. Zheng Shusen's paper was retracted by the International Liver Transplant Society, due to being suspected involved in live organ harvesting³.
- 5. Zheng Shusen was the former chairman of the Zhejiang Anti-Cult Association (2007-2017), which was a dedicated organization for the persecution of Falun Gong by the Chinese Communist Party. Zheng himself was personally involved in the actual persecution of Falun Gong practitioners under the name of the Association, including brainwashing and conversion, and was responsible for writing a book in 2009 as the director of the editorial board to discredit Falun Gong⁴.
- 6. Zheng Shusen was the chairman of the China Organ Procurement Organization (OPO), and during his tenure, OPO members and individuals were suspected of live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners.

I. Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital Overview

Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital is a tertiary private general hospital. On December 6, 2015, Shulan Hospital was officially opened for business in Hangzhou, with Zheng Shusen being its president (he was concurrently serving as the president of the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University). At the beginning of its establishment, Shulan Hospital was affiliated to Zhejiang University and named "Zhejiang University International Hospital", intending to have the reputable century-old university endorsing Zheng's own private enterprise. In 2018, the hospital was renamed "Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital" and became a branch of the Shulan Health Group⁶, which was founded by Zheng Shusen and his wife Li Lanjuan.

After the Chinese Communist Party announced in 2015 that it would stop using organs from death row inmates, some local hospitals were once strapped for organ donors, while Zheng Shusen's Shulan private hospital, which focuses on organ transplants, opened quickly and has been flourishing for several years, being called "Second Zhejiang First (Affiliated Hospital)" and "the largest liver transplant hospital in China. From preparation to opening, it only took 2 years for Shulan Hospital. Academician Qian Xu, an internationally renowned Chinese scientist who is originally from Hangzhou, once said, "The development speed of Shulan Hospital is so amazing that it is rare in the world, not to mention in China. Obviously, this is directly related to the official Communist Party status of Mr. and Mrs. Zheng Shusen.

According to the reports on December 6, 2015, Zhejiang University International Hospital was officially inaugurated and opened for business. The entire hospital was constructed in accordance with the Joint Commission International (JCI) standards. The initial investment was 500 million yuan, which also made it the largest and most comprehensive hospital with the highest standard run by "social forces" in Zhejiang Province. At the time of its establishment, the hospital had 512 beds, more than 500 medical staff, 41 clinical departments and eight medical technology departments. It also had 13 operating rooms with a full range of world-class equipment, such as PET-CT, MRI, DSA and CT scanners, as well as the da Vinci Surgical Systems.⁷

Shulan Hospital is located on Dongxin Road, which is a prime area of Xiacheng District, Hangzhou, with a construction area of approximately 63,000 square meters. Its new 20-story building has almost become a landmark in Hangzhou. On April 25, 2017, the International Organ Transplant Center of Zhejiang University International Hospital was inaugurated. At the same time, an "Organ Transplant Academic Committee" was also established. The number of ward beds in the hospital was also increased from 512 to 1,000.8

According to the official website of Shulan Hospital, the total number of doctors in Shulan Hospital is 37, including 20 staff members in the Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic Surgery Department, including Zheng Shusen as an academician, 5 chief physicians, 7 associate chief physicians, 4 attending physicians and 3 residents. There are 17 staff members in the Nephrology Department, including 1 chief physician, 3 associate chief physicians, 7 attending physicians and 6 residents.⁹

II. Telephone investigation: short wait times, large volumes of organ transplants, unknown donor organ sources

1. Zheng Shusen didn't deny the use of Falun Gong practitioners' organs¹⁰

Subject(s) of Investigation: Zheng Shusen, President of Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital

Summary: A liver transplant could be arranged within two weeks. Zheng Shusen did not answer the question of whether he was using the organs of Falun Gong practitioners or not, but he did not deny it, either.

2. Shulan Hospital conducted transplant operation unlawfully 11.

Zhejiang University International Hospital had already performed over 50 cases of liver transplants, while its organ transplant qualification was still being approved, but authorities had tacitly approved it.

Summary: Zheng Shusen established his own hospital, called Shulan Hospital (aka. Zhejiang University International Hospital) in 2016. They had already performed more than 50 cases of liver transplantation at the time of the investigation. Zheng Shusen's main focus was on liver transplants. The hospital was waiting for the authorities' approval of its transplant qualification, but the authorities had already tacitly approved it. Over 100 beds (3 wards x 39 beds = 117 beds) were used for their hepatobiliary and pancreatic surgeries. They had about 100 inpatients for liver transplants. They did transplants almost every day.

3. Very short waiting time, unknown organ source

It might take about two weeks to get a donor liver. Sometimes people could even do the operation on the second day of hospitalization. The liver procurement mainly depended on Zheng Shusen's connections.

Summary: "Generally speaking, it may take about two weeks (to get the liver). Sometimes it's very fast. Sometimes people can even do it on the second day. It depends on your situation. Critically ill patients can take priority." "We did over 120 cases last year (the year when the hospital was established)." "We would usually receive information on donor livers on the second day, (after we make an inquiry)." "Liver procurement mainly depends on President Zheng. He has established a reputation and has lots of connections on various aspects."

Summary: "If it is fast, a suitable organ can be found within a week or ten days. If it is slow, it may take one month or two months." "Compared with other hospitals, our hospital is relatively fast, with the fastest tissue typing." The hospital's president Zheng Shusen only sees patients for half a day per week at the outpatient clinic on Wednesday mornings. "President Zheng does all (liver transplant) operations himself."

4. Transplant volume was large, performed two to three operations every day. Never stopped for one day even during pandemic.

Shulan Hospital didn't stop doing transplantation due to the pandemic¹⁵.

Summary: "(Shulan) has been doing quite a lot. (Shulan) did not stop (doing organ transplants) due to the pandemic. No, Shulan has never stopped."

III. Official media reports proved huge number of transplantation

According to a mainland government official media report, from the afternoon of May 11 to noon on May 12, 2017, the eight operating rooms of Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital were brightly lit, and eight large organ transplants were completed within 20 hours. One of the patients surnamed Wu waited only two days before he received a "donated" liver. 16

According to the official website of the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University, as of July 10, 2015, Zheng Shusen had performed 1,741 cases of liver transplantation. According to a report published on *Qianjiang Evening News* on October 30, 2019, "Zheng Shusen, the president of Shulan Health, has completed more than 3,300 liver transplants so far." 18

According to the above two reports, from July 2015 to October 2019, a period of four years and three months, Zheng Shusen completed more than 1,559 liver transplant surgeries (more than 3,300 cases minus 1,741 cases), averaging more than 367 cases per year.

IV. One Special Investigation Revealed an Astonishing Number of Organ Transplant Cases

According to the data obtained from a WOIPFG special investigation, from December 12, 2017 to May 20, 2018, during a half-year period, Zheng Shusen's own surgical team alone at Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital performed 545 cases of organ transplantation (306 cases of liver transplantation and 239 cases of kidney transplantation) and used 560 organs (including 15 discarded organs). The percentage of emergency transplants in terms of total organ transplant cases was 10% to 20%. The organ wait times were one to two weeks, with the shortest wait time being only one day. Also, there were cases of the hospital seeking patients for existing organs and organ surplus. There were more than 400,000 kidney sources, and the hospital guaranteed to provide its patients with young organ donors within one month. There were seven cases of double transplantation on the same patients, and the recorded intervals between the first and second operations were only one to three days. In one liver transplant case, three donor livers were used within nine days. On February 10, 2018, four liver transplants and two kidney transplants were completed within one day. ¹⁹

Therefore, there should have been at least 1,000 transplant cases performed during the entire year. Moreover, this is only the number of operations performed by Zheng Shusen's surgical team alone within half a year. Judging from the scale of Shulan Hospital, where there are 37 doctors (including 16 directors and deputy

directors), there should be at least two surgical teams. So, according to conservative calculations, the volume should be no less than 2,000 cases of liver and kidney transplantation. (For details, please refer to the attached special investigation record.)

The cases collected in this special investigation have relatively complete patient personal information, such as their names, genders, ages, home addresses and personal ID numbers. In order to protect their privacy, some of the information is not shown in our published report.

Investigation Summary

(1) Original records of special investigation I:

1. Investigation period:

December 12, 2017 to May 20, 2018

2. Total organ transplant volume:

A total of 546 cases, including 306 cases of liver transplant, 239 cases of kidney transplant and one case of heart transplant.

3. Number of organs consumed:

More than 560 (15 organs were discarded). In some cases, there is no information on wasted organs.

4. Emergency transplantation: 10 ~ 20%

According to the case descriptions, eight cases are clearly recorded as emergency transplants, and the other cases are unspecified. On March 23, 2018, some description was written: "10-20% of the organ transplant recipients at Shulan Hospital are in a critical condition or terminally ill, with many cases of acute organ failures and emergency transplantation." Therefore, calculated according to the percentages, there should be about 55 to 110 cases of emergency transplantation.

5. Organ wait times:

In most cases, the organ wait times were within two weeks. In two cases with the shortest wait times, it took only one day to find a matching organ. And in the case with the longest wait time, it took 23 days. There were two cases, in which the wait times were three days each. And in two other cases, the wait times were four days each. In one case, the wait time was eight days. In another case, the wait time was 11 days. And in a third case, it was 12 days. The wait times in other cases were not indicated.

6. Available organs sought transplant organ recipients

"Organs looking for recipients is a customary rule in Shulan Hospital's Nephrology Department."

Examples:

- 1) A "donor" kidney was delivered to the hospital at 7:30 p.m. on February 13, 2018, and its pathology was good. Doctor Shou Zhangfei then contacted the organ recipient, and the surgery was performed at 8 a.m. on February 14, 2018.
- 2) The second organ transplant operation scheduled on February 15, 2018 was cancelled due to the fact that no patient was willing to undergo a surgery on the Chinese New Year's Eve, and the donor liver was transferred to the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University.

7. Liver and kidney sources could be selected by age

On February 15, 2018, the kidney source prices at Shulan Hospital rose to more than 400,000 yuan each, and the hospital guaranteed to find young donor organs for patients within one month.

On December 13, 2017, the liver and kidney sources could be selected by age, and the patients had a one-to-one contact with doctors in the organ transplant group. This will be investigated further.

8. Double organ transplantation cases

There were seven cases indicated to be double transplantation cases. The interval between the first and second operations in one case was one day, and it was three days in another case. The other cases did not specify the exact intervals.

Example: On December 12, 2017, only one day had passed between the first and second transplantation operations for one patient.

The patient was a 43-year-old female surnamed Zhong, who's from Shaoxing County, Zhejiang Province. On December 11, 2017, she was admitted to Shulan Hospital at 6 p.m. due to acute liver failure. It was a drug-induced hepatic failure. The patient suffered from an abdominal pain two months ago, and she took Chinese herbal medicine for 22 days at the Chinese Medicine Clinic of Jinyuetang in Shaoxing one month ago. She had yellow urine for two weeks, suffered from fatigue and vomited for two weeks. Three days before her first surgery, she was diagnosed with acute liver failure at the First Affiliated Hospital, Zhejiang University. She had been hospitalized four times so far, and her liver functions would increase from time to time. At 11:30 p.m., the donor liver was frozen and its pathology was good, but it was deemed unsuitable for transplantation for unknown reasons (the donor liver was discarded). On the afternoon of December 12, another donor liver was selected, and the second transplantation operation was completed at 8 p.m.

9. A case of liver transplantation used three donor livers within nine days

From February 18 to March 1, 2018, Shulan Hospital performed a liver transplant with three donor livers within nine days, and the third liver transplantation operation was successful.

On February 18, 2018, at 11 a.m., one liver transplantation operation took place (this was the time when the organ recipient was sent to the hospital). The recipient was surnamed Dang, who had liver cancer, and the donor organ blood type matched his. The doctors responsible for the surgery were Zheng Shusen, Zhang Wu, Wang Shuo and Dong Danjie. The doctors responsible for the liver excision and repair were Lin Guoling and Gao Sheng. Yuan Lei received the liver, and Zhao Xian was responsible for the anesthetization. 55% of the donor liver had coagulative necrosis, so it was not transplanted (the donor liver was discarded).

At 4 p.m. on February 28, another donor liver was sent to the organ recipient Dang, with 35% mixed steatosis and 10% coagulative necrosis, and the organ was not transplanted (the donor liver was also discarded).

One liver transplant was performed at 10 p.m. on March 1 (this was the time when the organ recipient was sent to the hospital). The organ recipient Dang suffered from hepatitis B liver cancer and had just undergone a TaCE surgery. The donor organ's blood type matched his. The doctors responsible for the surgery were Zheng Shusen, Yang Zhe, Fan Ning and Wu Weiqiang. The doctors responsible for the liver repair were Lin Guoling and Chen Xuliang. Yuan Lei received the liver, and Huang was responsible for the anesthetization. The third donor liver was excellent, and the organ transplant was completed.

10. Four liver transplants and two kidney transplants were performed in one day
On February 10, 2018, four liver transplants and two kidney transplants were completed on the same day. The organ recipients were all male. One liver transplant patient had a blood type of A+, and the rest were all B+. The oldest patient for the liver transplantation was 62 years old, and the oldest for the kidney transplantation was 73 years old.

From 1997 to 2015, for 18 years, Zheng Shusen served as the Dean of the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University. In 2015, some local hospitals were temperarily short of organ supplies, due to the CCP's declare of banning death penalty organ transplants. However, Shulan Private Hospital, which Zheng Shusen's main organ transplant project, quickly opened. It expended rapidly and known as "The mini First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University", "the country's largest liver transplant hospital". Even Academician Qian Xu, a well-known international Chinese scientist whose ancestry is from Hangzhou, said that the development speed of Shulan Hospital is so amazing, not to mention domestic, it is also rare worldwide.

From preparation to opening of Shulan Hospital, it only took 2 years. The rapid development of this private hospital is directly related to the official status of Zheng Shusen and his wife.

Zheng Shusen has more different identities and titles: Academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering, Professor of Surgery at Zhejiang University, Doctoral Supervisor, Director of the Key Laboratory of Multi-Organ Transplantation Research of the Ministry of Health, Vice President of the Chinese Medical Doctor Association, China Organ Procurement Organization Alliance (OPO) Chairman²¹. Former Dean of School of Medicine at the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University, and now director of the Organ Transplant Center of the First Affiliated Hospital of Zhejiang University and Shulan (Hangzhou) Hospital. In addition, Zheng Shusen is also the former chairman of Zhejiang Anti-Cult Association (2007-2017), an organization of the CCP to persecute solely Falun Gong. In the name of the association, Zheng himself actually participated in the brainwashing and transformation of Falun Gong practitioners²². In 2009, as the director of the editorial board, he was responsible for compiling books and slandering Falun Gong. ²³ Zheng Shusen's long-term massive organ transplantation coincides with the time when the CCP persecuted Falun Gong. In addition, evidence reveals that members and individuals of OPO during Zheng Shusen's tenure as the chairman of the China Organ Procurement Organization Alliance (OPO) are also suspected of harvesting organs from Falun Gong practitioners. As of 2021, Zheng Shusen has completed about 3,500 liver transplant operations.

A large amount of evidence suggests that Zheng Shusen is a crucial organizer of the CCP's large-scale live organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners and an executor of the systematic persecution of Falun Gong practitioners. The hospital where Zheng Shusen works is an important base for suspected organ harvesting of Falun Gong practitioners. Zheng Shusen is suspected of committing crimes against humanity of harvesting organs from Falun Gong practitioners.

WOIPFG's Investigative Report on the Alleged Organ Harvesting of Living Falun Gong Practitioners at Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University and Its Staff Members Suspected of Participation

Foreword

The Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University is one of the first hospitals in China to carry out kidney transplantation. In 2014, Zang Yunjin, the former deputy director of the Liver Transplantation Research Institute of the Beijing General Hospital of the Armed Police Force, was hired to take charge of the organ transplantation center of this hospital, and the number of liver and kidney transplants has since increased significantly. Telephone investigations in recent years have shown that the number of organ transplants in this hospital ranks the highest in Shandong Province; the waiting time is short, and the transplants can even be done right away; there are an excess of kidney donors, some of which are sent to hospitals in Shanghai. Donors are not from the Red Cross Society, and the hospital has its own channels for obtaining organs. In 2019, cases of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners were still occurring around Qingdao. In view of the background of the CCP's state crime of forced organ harvesting, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners and members of other groups.

L. Hospital Overview: The Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University is a provincial comprehensive tertiary Level-A instition integrating medical treatment, teaching, scientific research and other functions. At present, there are 4,978 open beds in the Shinan Compound and Laoshan Compound of the hospital. The hospital currently has 1,298 senior professional and technical personnel, including 962 doctors, 1,842 masters, and more than 200 returnees from overseas. There is one external academician and 12 people who enjoy the special government allowance of the State Council.

On December 28, 2022, the official website of the hospital stated: The hospital has built a first-class organ transplant center in China, and has completed 36 difficult heart transplants, 1008 liver transplants, 1801 kidney transplants, and 16 lung transplants. Both the number and level comfortably rank first in the province.²⁵

II. After Zang Yunjin became the leader of the organ transplant center, the number of transplants increased rapidly in China

In 2013, in the context of the hospital building an organ transplant center, the Kidney Transplant Department was established as a separate department, and the number of transplant cases increased year by year. ²⁶

In February 2014, the Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University announced the establishment of an Organ Transplant Center. Zang Yunjin, former executive deputy director of the Liver Transplant Research Institute of the General Hospital of the Armed Police Force, came to the hospital to lead the work of the organ transplant center, establishing an "elite transplant team of 20 or 30 people", setting up four departments of liver transplantation, heart transplantation, kidney transplantation, and planning to complete 100 cases of organ transplantation within the year. Previously, the hospital performed 40 kidney transplants and 3-5 liver transplants every year, and it was not able to perform heart transplants. ²⁷

After Zang Yunjin came to lead the Organ Transplant Center, the transplant volume of the Affiliated Hospital of Qingda University quickly became a leader in the field of organ transplantation, especially liver transplantation in China. ²⁸

III. The Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University has obtained qualifications for six types of organ transplantation, and the organ transplant center has 189 open beds.

The Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University is one of the earliest large-scale tertiary level A hospitals in China to carry out organ transplantation, and as early as 2000, it obtained national qualifications for liver and kidney transplantation. It is now one of the few hospitals in China that has the qualification to carry out six types of transplantation, including liver, kidney, pancreas, small intestine, heart and lung.²⁹

As of 2021, the number and quality of organ transplantation operations in the hospital had been among the top for six consecutive years in China, and ranked first in Shandong Province. As of October 2021, the Organ Transplantation Center of the Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University has opened a total of 189 beds, has multiple sub-disciplines such as pediatric organ transplantation, liver transplantation, kidney transplantation, liver surgery, hepatology, transplant intensive care unit, transplant follow-up and transplant special examination, etc., and has become a first-class in China and No.1 in the province, large-scale comprehensive organ transplantation center integrating clinical, scientific research and teaching. From the perspective of its bed usage, based on 189 transplants done a year, the turnover rate of beds is 100% (the average bed utilization rate of tertiary hospitals in China is as high as 103% 31), and viewed from the hospital stay of organ transplantation of 30 days, it has the potential of more than 2300 cases (189×365×100%/30=2300) organ transplants per year. (Calculation method: number of beds times number of days a year times bed turnover rate / average length of hospital stay for transplantation = annual number of transplant completions)

IV. The organ transplant center set a record of completing 6 operations in 24 hours

In August 2014, the official website of the Affiliated Hospital of Qingdao University reported that "less than half a year after the establishment of the center, 30 cases of liver transplantation and 38 cases of kidney transplantation have been carried out, ranking first in the province in terms of total number of cases. The stage is as big as the heart." Zang Yunjin served as the director of the center and the director of the liver

VI. According to the Minghui website, family members suspected that He Lifang, a Falun Gong practitioner in Qingdao, was tortured to death when his organs were removed.

According to a December 3, 2019 report on Minghui.com, on July 2, 2019, the "610 Office" in Qingdao City, Shandong Province, and the "610 Office" in Jimo City tortured 45-year-old Falun Gong practitioner He Lifang (male) to death. The family members suspected that He Lifang's organs were forcibly harvested. He Lifang's body had stitched incisions on his chest and incisions on his back. There were traces of pain on his face and his mouth was open.

Before He Lifang was tortured to death, he was sent to the Third People's Hospital of Chengyang (a township hospital in Xiazhuang), which shows the authorities didn't intend to save life, rather, they schemed to commit sins in a small hospital without drawing much attention. The international airport is less than ten minutes away by car, which is conducive to the rapid transport of organs after harvesting.⁴⁰

Foreword

In 2004, the Third Hospital of Peking University ranked first in Beijing in the number of kidney transplants. The Organ Transplant Center of Peking University to which it belongs has performed 4,000 liver and kidney transplants within a year. During WOIPFG telephone investigation, one hospital doctor said,"We have 11 medical teams for kidney transplantation, all of which can do it." In the context of the background of the CCP's state crime of living-donor organ harvesting, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of forced organ harvesting from living Falun Gong practitioners and members of other groups.

Hospital Overview

Founded in 1958, the Third Hospital of Peking University (abbreviated as "the Third Hospital") is a comprehensive tertiary level-A hospital managed by the National Health Commission that integrates

The hospital has 36 clinical departments and 10 medical technology departments. It has 27 doctoral programs and 1 clinical postdoctoral mobile station. There are 57 on-the-job doctoral supervisors, 1 academician of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, and 1 academician of the Chinese Academy of Engineering.⁶⁷

I. The Organ Transplant Center of Peking University performed 4,000 cases of liver and kidney transplants within one year

As the predecessor of the Institute of Organ Transplantation of Peking University (hereinafter referred to as the Institute), the Organ Transplantation Center of Peking University (hereinafter referred to as the Center), was established in October 2001 under the personal guidance of Han Qide, Vice Chairman of the Standing Committee of the Eleventh National People's Congress. The Institute is jointly formed by 5 medical institutions affiliated to Peking University, including the First Hospital of Peking University, People's Hospital, and the Third Hospital, with the aim to integrating advantages and promoting the development of medical and scientific research including liver transplantation, kidney transplantation, pancreas transplantation, heart transplantation, corneal transplantation and bone marrow transplantation. ⁶⁸ Zhu Jiye, Director of the Institute and Director of Hepatobiliary Surgery at Peking University People's Hospital, said in an interview with China Economic Weekly, "Our hospital has performed 4,000 liver and kidney transplants in one year". ⁶⁹

In May 2000, the third Hospital officially started clinical liver transplantation. Fifteen cases were completed that year. Subsequently, kidney transplantation and combined pancreas-kidney transplantation were carried out one after another, and organ transplantation became a routine operation in the hospital. The results and quantity of liver transplantation in the transplant center are among the best in Beijing and even in the whole country. ⁷⁰

In December 2005, the relocation of the new surgical building of the Third Hospital started. The new building has 470 beds.⁷¹ According to the hospital, the Liver Transplantation Center moved to the new surgical building, and the hospital provided more development space for liver transplantation. ⁷²

II. The team of the Liver and Kidney Transplantation Center of the hospital is strong

There are 12 liver surgeons, including 2 professors, 4 associate professors, and 6 attending surgeons, of whom 5 have received doctoral degrees from abroad or domestically, and 4 have obtained master's degrees from abroad or domestically; 6 full-time anesthesiologists for organ transplantation, including 2 with senior professional titles. ⁷³

The Department of Urology has two wards with 64 beds, 8 professors and chief surgeons (including 1 doctoral supervisor), 8 associate professors and deputy chief surgeons, and 5 attending surgeons. Under the department, there are multiple organ transplantation and other professional groups. ⁷⁴

Preface

WOIPFG investigation shows that Huashan Hospital Affiliated to Fudan University has been involved in a large number of organ transplant operations. The wait time for obtaining organ source for transplant operations in this hospital is extremely short. There are cases where the organ source was available the same day as the patient requested for it. The investigation shows that there are abundant donors of organs available, with some on demand. There are evidences showing that transplant operations take place on a daily basis in this hospital. There are a large number of liver transplant operations ongoing. There are occasions where this hospital provides liver organ at the demand from other hospitals.

Against the backdrop of a state crime for organ harvesting by the Chinese Communist Party, Huashan Hospital Affiliated to Fudan University is believed to have been involved in harvesting organs from living Falun Gong practitioners.

L. Overview of the Organ Transplant Center in Huashan Hospital Affiliated to Fudan University Huashan Hospital Affiliated to Fudan University, formerly known as General Hospital of China Red Cross, was established in 1907, with a good reputation within and outside of China¹⁰⁸. The Research Institute of Fudan University on Organ Transplant was founded in February 2002 and headed by academician Zheng Shusen, with academician Qiu Fazu among its senior consultants. The research is focused on clinical and basic research about large organ transplant¹⁰⁹. Ding Qiang, president of Huashan Hospital, specializes in kidney transplant operations¹¹⁰.

Wang Zhengxin, deputy director of the department of general surgery and director of Liver Transplant Center, has served as chief surgeon in more than 1,400 liver transplant operations and is among those

considered as most experienced experts on liver transplant operations in China. He has rich experience in the diagnosis and treatment of hepatobiliary diseases. He has treated thousands of patients with such disease. He has rich experience in the comprehensive treatment after a liver transplantation for liver cancer and in dealing with the complications after liver transplant operations. Since May 2014, additional personnel joined Huashan Hospital Affiliated to Fudan University. Thanks to the additional personnel, more than 800 liver transplant operations have been completed, in which about 120 liver transplant operations were performed for children. Currently, the average annual number of liver transplant operations completed stands between 180 and 230 cases¹¹¹.

II. The liver donor for transplant operation happened to be available on the day the patient was transferred to Huashan Hospital.

There was a case where a family desperately sought organ when the father in the family was hospitalized in No. 5 People's Hospital in Shanghai. It happened on April 24, 2016. Here is part of the conversation among the doctor and the family members.

- Doctor from No. 5 People's Hospital: "His father is in a critical situation due to hepatic failure. He must be hospitalized immediately otherwise he might lose his life. He must receive treatment right away and stay in the hospital. Don't bother to go home to bring personnel effects."
- The family member: "On April 28, 2016, thanks to some connections we have, we finally got the chance to transfer my father to Huashan Hospital after staying four days in No. 5 People's hospital. We were very lucky as we were informed by the doctor on that same day that there was a liver source suitable for my father 112.

III. Phone investigation found the following: The possibility to choose the organ needed, same day operation upon demand, having sufficient organ sources, the number of liver transplant operations being large, liver source available at request, operations taking place on a daily basis.

Preface

Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University (also known as Hubei General Hospital) is one of the first local hospitals in China to carry out organ transplants. Its number of kidney transplants has ranked first in Hubei Province for many years. Since 2003, the hospital has successively carried out Hubei's first combined liver-kidney, combined heart-kidney, and combined heart-lung transplants. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the hospital performed the first lung transplant on COVID-19 patient and the first second lung transplant in Hubei Province. The hospital is as famous as Wuhan Tongji Hospital and Wuhan Army General Hospital, which are all major organ transplant hospitals in Hubei Province. In October 2017, Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University claimed that it had performed 300 kidney transplants that year. From 2005 to March 2015, the hospital has performed dozens of heart transplant surgeries. In 2015, the wait time for a heart transplant in the hospital was only two weeks. In 2018, four heart transplants were completed in seven days. The hospital has performed dozens of lung transplants and the first second lung transplant in Hubei Province with only one month wait time for the organ. harvesting, the hospital is suspected of participating in the crime of live organ harvesting from Falun Gong practitioners and other groups.

I. Hospital Overview

Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University covers an area of 130,000 square meters and has a construction area of 310,000 square meters. There are more than 2,000 employees, including more than 500 professionals with senior professional titles. The hospital has 59 clinical medical and technical departments and 1,447 beds.

The hospital's medical services cover mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau, and some other countries in Asia and South America. The hospital is also responsible for the health care tasks of Chinese leaders, foreign dignitaries, and overseas Chinese while they are in Hubei ¹³³.

II. The hospital can perform multi-organ transplants and claims to rank first in Hubei Province in terms of the number of kidney transplants.

Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University is one of the first hospitals in China to carry out organ transplants, and various organ transplant surgeries have been performed there¹³⁴. Kidney transplantation is a specialty of its Urology Department, with the number of transplants ranking first in Hubei Province. Since 2003, its hepatobiliary endoscopic surgery department has also successively carried out liver and combined liver-kidney transplants and heart transplants¹³⁵.

III. The hospital is one of the largest hospitals engaged in organ transplants in Wuhan.

In 2006, a witnesses stated that Wuhan Tongji Hospital, Hubei General Hospital, and Wuhan Army General Hospital were the largest hospitals in Wuhan engaged in organ transplants, mainly kidney transplants ¹³⁶. In 2006, during a WOIPFG telephone investigation, both Wuhan Tongji Hospital and Wuhan Army General Hospital admitted to using organs from Falun Gong practitioners ¹³⁷.

On November 1, 2020, at the launch ceremony of the "Relay for Life" hosted by the China Organ Transplantation Development Foundation and executed by the Party Committee of Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University, Huang Jiefu said that China had become the second largest country in the world in organ transplantation and was expected to become the world's largest country in organ transplantation in two to three years. Zhang Dingyu, Deputy Director of the Hubei Provincial Health Commission, said that Hubei is the birthplace of organ transplantation in China.

Wan Honghui, Party Secretary of the Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University, said that the hospital has made breakthroughs in organ transplantation, including performing Hubei's first combined liver-kidney transplant, combined heart-lung transplant, "mirror man" lung transplant, and other difficult surgeries." In particular, the hospital successfully completed the first lung transplant on a severely ill patient with COVID-19 in Hubei. 138"

V. The wait time for organ transplants in this hospital is short, and multiple transplant surgeries were performed simultaneously.

From 2005 to March 2015, Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University has carried out dozens of heart transplants ¹⁴².

- 1. In March 2015, a patient with heart attack had a heart transplant after waiting two weeks ¹⁴³.
- 2. In June 2015, four organ transplant surgeries, including one liver transplant, two kidney transplants, and one heart transplant, were performed simultaneously¹⁴⁴.
- 3. From May 31 to June 6, 2018, the hospital performed four heart transplants in seven days ¹⁴⁵.

VI. The hospital performed the first second lung transplant in Hubei Province, and the wait time for the organ was one month.

As of September 3, 2022, the Thoracic Surgery Department of Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University (Hubei General Hospital) has successfully performed lung transplants on dozens of patients with chronic end-stage lung diseases since the lung transplant surgery was launched there in 2016¹⁴⁶.

On April 20, 2020, Chen Jingyu, Lin Huiqing, and other national experts in lung transplantation, together with the teams from the thoracic surgery, cardiac surgery, and anesthesiology departments of Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University, performed a double lung transplant on a patient with COVID-19. The donated organ was transported through the green channel for organ transportation, and the wait time for the organ was only one month¹⁴⁷.

On August 30, 2022, Geng Qing, leader of the lung transplant team and Director of the Thoracic Surgery Department of Renmin Hospital of Wuhan University (Hubei General Hospital), led Jiang Wenyang, Zhang Xinghua, Wang Wei, and others to form a lung transplant team. The team performed a second lung transplant on a patient from Liaoning Province, and the wait time for the organ was one month. This is also the first second lung transplant performed in Hubei¹⁴⁸.
