In September 2013, Director Zhao of the “610 office” in Ji County, Tianjin admitted that Bo Xilai’s wife, Gu Kailai, was involved in stealing and selling the organs and cadavers of Falun Gong practitioners.

#### Phone Investigation Recording

Investigator: Hello, is that the 610 Office?

Zhao: Ah?

Investigator: Is that the 610 office?

Zhao: Yes.

Investigator: Do you know...

Zhao: Who is speaking?

Investigator: Do you know that you guys are a criminal institution?

Zhao: This is (the 610 Office). Who are you?

Investigator: Once the persecution ends, have you ever thought about what will happen to you? See what has happened to Gu Kailai (the wife of Bo Xilai)? On the surface, she...

Zhao: Gu Kailai was selling organs of Falun Gong practitioners.

Investigator: What did you say?

Zhao: I said, you were talking about Gu Kailai, the one who sold organs of Falun Gong practitioners.

Investigator: Yes, she had two human cadaver plastination factories in Dalian. She sold plastinated full-body cadavers for one million U.S. dollars each; the cadavers without internal organs were sold for 800,000 U.S. dollars each.

Zhao: Oh.

Investigator: She is a devil.

Zhao: What she sold were not all from Falun Gong practitioners.

Investigator: Do you know they were not from just Falun Gong practitioners, right?

Zhao: Ah, ah.

Investigator: Were there (organs and cadavers) from the Tibetans and Mongolians, who went to petition?  
(Zhao hung up the phone.)
